1. A complete management review of all items in the Committee request has been completed by all divisions and staffs within the Office of Logistics (OL). This search included previous submissions to the Senate Select Committee.

2. Our files produced two documents which pertained to item 36; both are attached. One of the documents is an unclassified memorandum for the record, which refers to the Wackenhut Corporation. The second document, also unclassified, was taken from our Senate Select Committee file, and it too makes reference to contract actions with the Wackenhut Corporation. The Science and Technology Evaluation Planning System (STEPS) from which this information was obtained is a DDS&T management information system. We note that you have requested DDS&T to provide any information they may have on item 36. You may wish to refer this document to them to facilitate their contracts files search if they have not already provided such documentation.

3. Reference item 32, we understand that you have received copies of all cable transmissions to and from Mexico City for

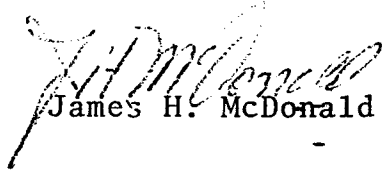

1. (U) Attached please find a copy of a request for information from the House Select Committee on Assassinations dated 14 February 1978.

2. (U) Please assemble all material in your office responsive to this request and advise me by telephone as material becomes available to you. Please note that on the last page of Mr. Blakey's letter that he requests priority consideration to items #5, 6 and 8 in the processing of items #1-25. I shall then advise the Committee that material is ready for their review at your offices. Notes taken from your material by Committee staff should be classified at the highest level of the material being reviewed and each staffer should sign a log sheet indicating access to the material. Notes and copies of your log sheet will be retained in OLC. No classified notes will leave the Headquarters Building.

3. (U) Committee staff will generate summary reports based upon their file review and notes. You will be asked to sanitize these reports to protect intelligence sources and methods prior to transmittal to the Committee. After sanitization, the reports will be transmitted to the Committee, classified, if necessary, at the highest level of classification appropriate.

4. (U) Advise me if you are unable to respond within a reasonable time or if you have any questions regarding our procedures for dealing with the Committee.

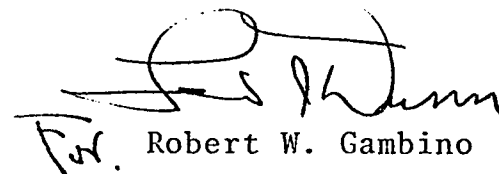

1. (U) Action Requested: None; for information only.

2. (U/AIUO) Background: Reference is made to your memorandum of 16 February 1978 (OLC 78-0588/1) which requested information on various individuals of interest to the House Select Committee on Assassinations (HSCA). Further reference is made to our previous response to your request dated 9 March 1978. At that time you were advised that this Office did not have sufficient identifying data to identify the documents requested by the HSCA in the second portion of their 14 February 1978 request. On 14 July 1978 Mr. Norbert Shepanek, DDO/PCS/LOC, provided information to the Office of Security which enabled us to identify items 1 and 2 in the second portion of the HSCA's request.

(U/AIUO) Forwarded with this memorandum are documents dated 30 October 1963 and 18 November 1963. These documents are memoranda forwarded to the Department of Justice by the Office of Security and contain the results of Agency traces on various individuals believed to be connected with organized crime and racketeering. The 18 November 1963 document has been sanitized in order to protect the identity of an official liaison service.

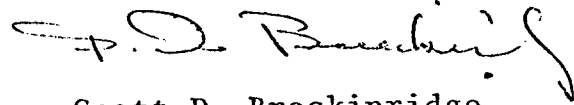
