An intensive search of the files and indices of this Directorate has surfaced 12 documents pertaining to correspondence between the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) and the Central Intelligence Agency (CIA) concerning Dr. Martin Luther King. The time frame of this correspondence extends from before to after Dr. King's assassination. These documents, which are summarily capsulized below, indicate the extent and nature of contact between CIA and the FBI regarding Dr. King.

The context of the surfaced documents mentioned above concerns Dr. King's associations, discussions, travel and items possibly related to his assassination. subject matter, briefly, is as follows:
