Gentlemen:

I am Marrell M^c Callough, Male
Block 29 years old, U.S. Citizen, and
currently a detective with the
Memphis Police Dept, working in
the Metro-Narcotic Bureau.

This letter is a query as to
possible employment with your
Agency. Briefly I will out-
line my qualifications:

March 4, 1964, I enlisted
into the U.S. Army and was
trained as a Military police-
man at Fort Gordon, Ga.

During my tour of duty, I

perform both garrison and security duty; the latter which required a "Secret Security Clearance". My assignments were both stateside and overseas. While in Germany, I was trained in Demolition Warfare.

After being discharged from the Army I came back to Memphis and was trained for fourteen weeks at the police academy. Upon graduation, I was assigned to the uniform patrol division until the "Sanitation Strike" and "Memphis '68 riots."

During the "Strike" a militant Black organization, the Invaders, much like the Black Panthers, was formed and I was assigned to the Intelligence Bureau, of the Memphis Police Dept. in order to infiltrate this group.

For seventeen months, I was successful in my assignment, even to the point of rising to the position of one of the four highest ranking members. Through my efforts, we were able to control this group.

Gentlemen, perhaps you have seen the photo of Dr. Martin Luther King where he is lying dying on the balcony of the Lorraine Hotel. The

Black man holding his head is I. The preceding was included to offer some tangible proof of my existence and interest in your organization.

My under cover period extended from December 1967 to March 1969.

When I was brought from under cover, I was assigned to the Bureau of Narcotics to operate and train drug under cover agents.

Gentlemen, the foregoing was my practical experience, or at least part; because I also work on the streets for a Democratic Society (SOS) and others.

My theoretical experience includes a Bachelor of Arts degree in Law Enforcement from Memphis State University and several seminars from various drug abuse schools including the Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs.

While in college, I studied eighteen hours of Spanish and I love to travel in Spanish speaking countries.

a friend of mine, a well known Memphis, Doctor, and lawyer, advised me to contact your office since he was aware of my past experiences.
