3. FERNANDEZ receives special instructions and requests for special articles direct from Ernesto "Che" GUEVARA, president of the Banco Nacional de Cuba.

Source Comment. In 1944 FERNANDEZ was the director of Alma Mater, a publication of the University of Habana.
