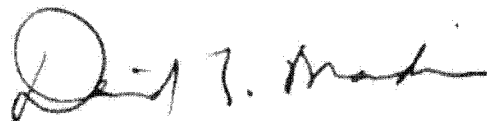

Although the 19 November Justice Department letter clarifies its earlier request, it stands that any document on Dr. King would be indexed by ER under his name; we have therefore not repeated the earlier search.
