MINUTEMEN HAD GENERAL PLAN TO FOMENT CIVIL STRIFE BY
KILLING NEGRO LEADERS, MARTIN LUTHER KING, RAP BROWN, AND
STOKELY CARMICHAEL AND THEREAFTER TO SEIZE POWER IN CONFUSION.
NO SPECIFIC TIME TABLE SET AND CARMICHAEL HAD LEAST PRIORITY
