

- 1. Lewis National Corporation, Dorchester, concerning whom there is information in retel. He advised that the machine model H5L4, Serial No. 32290, was shipped to Lewis National Corp. April, 1962. Our investigation should ascertain where it was sold or if they still have such machine.
- 2. The Superior Laundry, 625 Concord Ave., Cambridge. He advised this laundry has one of five machines in the country with five characters that fits exactly what we are looking for. This is model H5K1 and Serial R 31762. (R indicates a reconditioned machine.)

It was advised that this machine we are looking for is unusual in that there are only about 20 made in total. It was pointed out that with regard to No. 1 Model, H5L4 the card at the factory shows it to be a 6-character machine but it is believed it could be a 5-character machine.

In any instance, where a machine is found, tapes should be red in color with the identical markings as set out in the photos received/should be obtained.

Immediately upon any such tapes being obtained or any similar machine, the SAC is to be advised immediately.

PAUL CAMPBELL, President and General Manager, Superior Laundry Company, Inc., 625 Concord, Avenue, Cambridge, Mass., advised that his company has four laundry marking machines, all obtained from Textile Marking Machine Co., Syracuse, New York. CAMPBELL advised that his machines print a six digit number. He said that prior to September or October, 1967, he used a code of one to three numbers (bundle number 1 through 250) followed by two digits followed by a letter (designate week of year).

CAMPBELL advised he presently uses a code of two numbers (this is the lot number 1 through 99), a digit, one number (shows bundle number), digit and a letter (show week of year).

CAMPBELL viewed a photograph of a laundry tape and said that this tape was not one of his markings. He explained that he uses various colored tape but red is lease used due to the fact it is the hardest to read. CAMPBELL made available a sample of the red tape which he would use. Also made available from his four machines samples of the code D2B-6. He pointed out that the printing on the tape in the photograph was different from the printing on his tape.

Above information submitted to Bureau, Memphis and Albany by teletype dated 4/8/68 and the samples of the tape were sent to the FBI Laboratory by airtel dated 4/8/68.

For the information of San Juan, the following is furnished:

Search of premises believed occupied by UNSUB who assassinated Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING on 4/4/68, disclosed suitcase in which was located tee-shirt and undershorts bearing laundry mark on red tape with black lettering believed to be Thermo-Seal type, manufactured by Textile Marking Machine Co., Inc., Syracuse, N.Y. The tape is  $\frac{1}{4}$ " wide and 1/16" long and bears letters and numbers C2B-6.

Experts at Textile Marking Machine Company advise type on this machine is unusual in that the first two characters are 15 point type and the last three characters are eighteen point type, with the middle character, the letter B, probably being narrow rather than regular type. The usual machine carries 15 point type for the first three characters and 18 point type for the last two characters.

Textile Marking Machine experts also stated this machine is defective in that it is producing a tape 1 1/16" long instead of 1 1/8" long and is not projecting the tape far enough resulting in cutting off a portion of the first letter. The code used in the Northeast part of the U.S. is as follows:

The first letter 0 stands for lot number; the first number 2 indicates the day of the week, two being Tuesday; the second letter indicates the first letter of the store name, this is the letter B; the last number is the bundle number, this is 6. Color coding of the tag may designate various things such as a different month or the identity of a store in a chain. Experts also state the use of this system on laundry items is unusual in that the system is normally used on garments being dry cleaned.

The Bureau has instructed that all textile machines using this type tape be located and machines using this code be identified.
