#### MARTIN LUTHER KING

On April 4, 1968, Reverend Martin Luther King was assassinated at Memphis, Tennessee, and his funeral was scheduled to be held on April 9, 1968, at Atlanta, Georgia.

On April 6, 1968, Mr. Robert Kalna, Assistant Superintendent, Eastern Greyhound, Cleveland, Ohio, advised that his office is the control center for all Greyhound operations in the Eastern division of the United States from Montreal, Canada, and the New England States in the North, to Norfolk and Richmond, Virginia, in the South, and St. Louis, Missouri, and Chicago, Illinois, in the West.

Mr. Kalna learned that twelve buses had been chartered in Detroit, Michigan, in the name of Robert Kendall, scheduled to leave from Great Lakes Mutual, Woodward Avenue, Detroit, at 5:00 PM, April 8, 1968, and arrive at Ebenezer Baptist Church, Atlanta, Georgia, at 9:15 AM, April 9, 1968. The people making this trip reportedly were to attend the funeral of Reverend Martin Luther King on April 9, 1968, and then the buses would depart Atlanta at 5:00 PM, April 9, 1968, for the return trip to Detroit.

Mr. Kalna also learned that Public Employees District Council 77, Detroit, had chartered one bus scheduled to leave Detroit, April 7, 1968, for Clayborn Temple, Memphis, Tennessee, and return April 9, 1968. Kalna had no further details regarding this and did not know if it was in connection with the death of Reverend King.

Mr. Kalna also advised that the Inner City Christian Council, Cleveland, Ohio, had chartered two buses scheduled to leave Cleveland, 12:01 AM, April 8, 1968, for Atlanta, Georgia, for the funeral and leave Atlanta for the return trip at 6:00 PM, April 9, 1968. This group made a \$100 deposit and was attempting to fill additional buses.

On April 7, 1968, Mr. Kalna advised that his office had been notified that the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People (NAACP), Wilmington, Delaware, had chartered one Greyhound bus to depart Wilmington, 6:00 AM, April 8, 1968, for Atlanta, Georgia; also two buses were chartered at Boston, Massachusetts, by Radio Station WILD to depart Boston at 9:00 AM, April 8, 1968, to attend the funeral of Reverend King in Atlanta.

On April 8, 1968, Mr. Kalna was recontacted regarding any additional charter service to Atlanta to attend Reverend King's funeral on April 9, 1968. Mr. Kalna mentioned that the following additions and changes had been made in the chartering of Greyhound buses for the funeral:

- (1) Twelve buses from Detroit in name of Robert Kendall -- No changes.
- (2) One bus from Detroit in name of Public Employees District Council 77 -- No change.
- (3) Two buses were originally chartered by Radio Station WILD, Boston, but this was changed to one bus to make the Atlanta trip.
- (4) One bus chartered by NAACP, Wilmington -- No change.
- (5) Two buses were chartered by the Inner City Christian Council, Cleveland, for the trip but both were cancelled as only fifteen people signed up and these people made the trip on regular Greyhound service to Atlanta.
- (6) One bus was chartered by the City Wide Welfare Group, New York City, New York, scheduled to leave New York, 9:30 AM, April 8, 1968; return trip leave Atlanta, 5:00 PM, April 9, 1968.
- (7) One bus was chartered by Mr. Simms, Ecumenical Institute, Chicago, Illinois, scheduled to depart Chicago, 12:00 noon, April 8, 1968; return trip leave Atlanta, Wednesday, April 10, 1968, at 5:00 AM.

- (8) Three buses were chartered by the Southern Christian Leadership Conference (SCIC), Chicago, Illinois, leaving Chicago, 3:00 PM, April 8, 1968; return trip leave Atlanta, 6:00 PM, April 9, 1968.
- (9) Mr. Kalna also learned that the Central United States Control area of Greyhound notified his office that five chartered Greyhound buses would leave St. Boniface Church, Milwaukee, Wisconsin, at 2:30 PM, April 8, 1968, en route to Atlanta and would be going through the Greyhound Eastern Control Division. These five buses would depart Atlanta at 6:00 PM, April 9, 1968, for the return trip.


