Enclosed herewith are tape samples from the Thermo-Seal Machines which operate at the Walpole Laundry, 3375 Washington Avenue, Jamaica Plain, Boston, Mass.

On 4/29/68, inquiry by SA GERALD T. MAHONEY at Station 3, Boston Police Department, Morton Street, Mattapan, Boston, Mass., revealed that the Henrici Laundry Machinery Company, which was located at one time on Henrici Street, Mattapan, Boston, no longer exists, having been torn down by recent urban renewal in the area.

On 4/29/68, EDWARD HAYWARD, Manager, Walpole Laundry, 3375 Washington Avenue, Jamaica Plain, Boston, Mass., advised SA GERALD T. MAHONEY that this laundry currently employs three Thermo-Seal machines in its laundering processes. These machines feature the following numbers: 32563, R32532 and R32531. HAYWARD also stated that this laundry also makes use of the following tape colors in its laundering:

HAYWARD made available samples of the tapes from the respective machines and then stated that under a number such as 20R-3, and the code used by this laundry, the following determination could be made: the first two numbers (20) would constitute the lot number; the letter would constitute the week, under an A-Z system; and the last number would be the customer number. Under this system, HAYWARD stated, there would be no way to trace a specific seal to a specific customer because no records are retained after payment and no customer is given a permanent number. If further information were to become necessary in this regard, HAYWARD stated that he could be reached at telephone JA-2-7282.

At about 6 p.m. on 4/4/68, while standing on the second floor balcony outside Room 306 of the Lorraine Motel, 406 Mulberry Street, Memphis, Tennessee, Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. was struck in the right side of the face by a single bullet fired from a 30-06 rifle. The bullet severed KING's spinal cord and death was almost instantaneous.

This investigation, predicated upon a specific request from the Attorney General of the United States, disclosed that the fatal shot had been fired from the bathroom of a cheap rooming house located at 422 1/2 South Main Street, Memphis, which bathroom was located at the rear of the rooming house, and had a window overlooking the Lorraine Motel.

At about 3 p.m. on 4/4/68, an individual using the name JOHN WILLARD had rented Room 5-B in the rooming house at 422 1/2 South Main Street and had paid one week's rent. After hearing the rifle shot at about 6 p.m. on that same day, other tenants in the rooming house observed a man presumably identical with WILLARD, fleeing from the rooming house carrying a large package which was subsequently abandoned by him on the sidewalk in front of the Canipe Amusement Co., 424 South Main Street, Memphis. A neighborhood investigation in the vicinity of 424 South Main Street disclosed that the subject had fled from the scene in a white Mustang.

Found abandoned in front of 424 South Main Street was a 30-06 Remington model 760 rifle which was determined to have been

sold to one HARVEY LOWMEYER on 3/30/68 by Aeromarine Supply Co., Birmingham, Alabama.

Investigation at Memphis disclosed that an individual had purchased a set of binoculars at the York Arms Company in Memphis on 4/4/68. These binoculars were among the material abandoned with the rifle and recovered in Memphis. Also recovered was a brown and green herringbone bedspread. The items abandoned in Memphis were all wrapped in this bedspread. The blue bag which was inside the bedspread contained numerous items, among which were the binoculars and a set of underwear consisting of a T-shirt and shorts. The T-shirt and shorts are those on which appears the laundry mark which has been a matter of interest in this case.

A search of motel records in the Memphis area disclosed that an individual using the name ERIC S. GALT had spent the night of 4/3/68 at the Rebel Motel, Memphis, Tennessee, and was driving a 1966 white Mustang bearing Alabama License 1-38993. Investigation at Birmingham disclosed that this automobile had been purchased by ERIC S. GALT on August 30, 1968, from a private person in response to a newspaper ad. He paid a total of \$1995 cash. While in Birmingham he furnished the address of 2608 South Highland Avenue, Birmingham. This is also the address which appeared on a driver's license issued to him by the State of Alabama. The driver's license identifying data listed his birth date as [redacted] his height as 5'11", his weight as 170 and his eyes blue and hair brown.

The automobile in question, the white Mustang bearing the Alabama tags mentioned above, was recovered in Atlanta on 4/11/68 and determined to have been abandoned there prior to 9 a.m. on 4/5/68.

In connection with the evidence submitted by Atlanta, Birmingham, and Memphis, identifiable latent prints were recovered. It was on the basis of these latents that identification was made of JAMES EARL RAY. In handling future leads, all offices should be particularly interested in securing an identifying number, military, police, or FBI, in connection with suspects so that the necessary check can be made through the Identification Division.

On 4/17/68, AUSA R. MACEY TAYLOR, Birmingham, authorized the filing of a complaint charging ERIC STARVO GALT with a conspiracy to violate Section 241, Title 18, U. S. Code, and

'\$1M King 'Bounty' Interested Ray'

DALTON, Ga. — A prison buddy of James Earl Ray said yesterday that when Ray heard there was a "million-dollar bounty" on Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., he smiled and said, "I'll collect it."

Ray, a 40-year-old fugitive from the Missouri State Prison, is accused by the FBI of assassinating King in Memphis on April 4.

In Atlanta, it was learned yesterday that the FBI had investigated reports that Ray, masquerading as Eric Starvo Galt, met two women in a hotel the weekend after the slaying.

The FBI impounded three water glasses from the Briarcliff Hotel the week King was buried and showed a desk clerk pictures of Galt. The clerk said he recognized the picture as the man who rented the room the Sunday after the slaying.

The next day an attractive young brunette arrived at the room and the following day another young woman, wearing steel-rimmed glasses and dressed like a hippie, joined the other two, the clerk said.

The FBI has interviewed two Atlanta cab drivers who said they drove a man resembling Galt around the hippie district about the same time.

In the Dalton jail, Raymond Curtis, 40, awaiting appeal on a murder sentence, said he knew Ray in the Kansas City jail, in federal prison at Leavenworth, Kan., and in the state prison at Jefferson City, Mo.

He described Ray as likeable, addicted to dope, a loner and a man concerned only with money.

'I'LL COLLECT IT'

On the day President Kennedy was assassinated—Nov. 23, 1963—Curtis said he, Ray, and about 150 other prisoners were in an exercise yard when they learned the news.

He said Ray remarked, "Well, somebody made a pretty penny on that."

About a week later, Curtis said, he and Ray were in the yard when "a new man just in off the street" told them "the businessmen's association has a million dollar bounty out for Martin Luther King."

Ray smiled, Curtis recalled,

and said, "If there's a million dollars out for King, I believe if I ever get out I'll collect it."

Curtis said he never figured out what the "new man" meant by the "businessmen's association." He said he couldn't remember who the man was.

"I didn't think much about it at the time. In prison, you hear all sorts of hellacious ideas," said Curtis, a tall, rawboned man.

Authorities in Jefferson City confirmed that Curtis and Ray were in prison at the same time. Authorities in Dalton said the FBI had interviewed Curtis on Sunday and again Monday night. It refused comment on the matter.

Curtis said Ray told him "he always carried a gun. He was always interested in money," Curtis said, but never mentioned racial matters.

"HE never made no state-

ments of any kind in a group," Curtis said. "He was aloner."

Ray couldn't "make a long conversation unless he was planning something," said Curtis. "If he was planning something, you could bet they'd be thorough plans." Ray, he said, masterminded things "that would be small things outside, but were pretty big jobs in prison" — such as the theft of eggs and drugs and cigarettis.

He said Ray told him that if he ever wanted to kill someone, he would buy a gun under a false name, and have everthing ready for an escape. "He used to talk a lot about escaping to New Zealand, Brazil and Argentina," Curtis said.

These binoculars were among the material abandoned with the rifle and recovered in Memphis. Also recovered was a brown and green herringbone bedspread. The items abandoned in Memphis were all wrapped in this bedspread. The blue bag which was inside the bedspread contained numerous items, among which were the binoculars and a set of underwear consisting of a T-shirt and shorts. The T-shirt and shorts are those on which appears the laundry mark which has been a matter of interest in this case.

A search of motel records in the Memphis area disclosed that an individual using the name ERIC S. GALT had spent the night of 4/3/68 at the Rebel Motel, Memphis, Tennessee, and was driving a 1966 white Mustang bearing Alabama License 1-36993. Investigation at Birmingham disclosed that this automobile had been purchased by ERIC S. GALT on August 30, 1963, from a private person in response to a newspaper ad. He paid a total of \$1995 cash. While in Birmingham he furnished the address of 2608 South Highland Avenue, Birmingham. This is also the address which appeared on a driver's license issued to him by the State of Alabama. The driver's license identifying data listed his birth date as [REDACTED], his height as 5'11", his weight as 170 and his eyes blue and hair brown.

The automobile in question, the white Mustang bearing the Alabama tags mentioned above, was recovered in Atlanta on 4/11/68 and determined to have been abandoned there prior to 9 a.m. on 4/5/68.

In connection with the evidence submitted by Atlanta, Birmingham, and Memphis, identifiable latent prints were recovered. It was on the basis of these latents that identification was made of JAMES EARL RAY. In handling future leads, all offices should be particularly interested in securing an identifying number, military, police, or FBI, in connection with suspects so that the necessary check can be made through the Identification Division.

On 4/17/68, AUSA R. MACEY TAYLOR, Birmingham, authorized the filing of a complaint charging ERIC STARVO GALT with a conspiracy to violate Section 241, Title 18, U. S. Code, and

recommended bond in the amount \$50,000. On that same date, SAC JOSEPH H. GAMBLE filed a complaint before USC MILDRED F. SPRAGUE, Birmingham, and warrant was issued that same date.

The leads set out below are derived from articles of clothing and bedding which have been located either in the suspect's hotel room at Memphis, Tennessee, or in his 1966 Mustang which was located abandoned in Atlanta, Ga.

All leads set out below should be covered within 24 hours from receipt of this memo.

In the coverage of the lead, the Agent assigned should note the following:

1. Every laundry or cleaning establishment listed has been in possession of a Thermo seal laundry marking machine according to the records of the Textile Marking Machine Company of Syracuse, N. Y.
2. These machines produce a piece of cloth tape one quarter inch wide which will bear letters and numbers making up a laundry mark.
3. The laundry marks in question are as follows:
 - a. 02B-6 -- In this laundry mark the first two characters are fifteen point type and the last three are eighteen point type with the letter, B, probably being narrower than the regular type.

It is pointed out that the usual Thermo seal machine carries fifteen point type for the first three characters and eighteen point type for the last two characters. This makes the machine we are looking for unusual. Another point which would make the machine easily recognizable is the fact that the machine apparently produces a tape one and one-sixteenth inch long instead of the usual one and one-eighth inch long and is not projecting the tape

far enough which results in cutting off a portion of the first letter, which in the case of the T-shirt and under-
shorts is O.

The pillow case and bed sheet found in the 1966 white Mustang registered to ERIC STARVO GALT which was located in Atlanta, 4/11/68, bore Thermo seal laundry tapes of approximately the same size as those listed above. The tapes are yellow in color and contain the code, "2OR-3." In the opinion of the Textile Marking Machine Company, the tapes were produced by a different machine than the previous tapes since the first three characters are fifteen point type and the last two are eighteen point type.

Agents covering leads should attempt to obtain samples of Thermo seal laundry marks from the laundries or cleaners contacted in the same letter and number combinations which are set out above.

The samples of tape and the memoranda recording the coverage of leads should be expeditiously furnished to SA RICHARD M. KIRBY for forwarding to the Bureau.

It is noted that on 4/10/68, in response to a telephone from the Boston Office, all laundries in the four county area covered by this R/A (Hampden, Hampshire, Berkshire and Franklin counties) were contacted by SAs ~~XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX~~ WALTER F. BRADY, MICHAEL W. STUART, EDWARD V. DAILEY and JACK W. SULLIVAN respectively. These inquiries concerned the Thermo-Seal laundry tape (red) with black lettering bearing the numbers 02B-6. No positive information was developed as a result of these contacts although it is noted that SA STUART submitted sample tapes used by Sentry Cleaners, Inc, Fairview, Mass. and by Warren Cleaners & Laundry, Warren, Mass. (in Worcester County covered by Worcester R/A)

Concerning re airtel of 4/11/68, the laundries listed in this airtel were previously contacted on 4/10/68 with the exception of the Fairview Laundry, Fairview, Mass. and the Woodlawn Laundry, Pittsfield, Mass., which are no longer in business.

Concerning re airtel of 4/19/68, the laundries within the R/A territory which utilize Textile Marking Machines were recontacted on 4-26-68 but no pertinent information concerning the yellow Thermo-Seal bearing code "20R-3" was obtained. Several laundry owners pointed out that many laundries use a different color tape on a daily basis and that the code "20R-3" which would be only a temporary code for which there would be no permanent record of the customer involved.
