CI states that so far there appears to be little concern on the part of the Negroes who regularly frequent the Five Points area, and these individuals will probably not become involved in any type of demonstration or even take any part in memorial services.

CI says he feels the average Negro in Denver at this time would resent interference from the whites, and particularly any interference by police officers in Negro affairs. CI explained that the one thing which could probably trigger some type of irresponsible action or riot would be some type of quasi-brutality or use of force by police officers in the ensuing days.

CI further stated that he feels trouble, if it starts, will probably begin at Either Dahlia Shopping Center, or the Holly Shopping Center, since both places are hangouts for the young, irresponsible Negro element.

As of time of contact, CI had heard of only one planned demonstration, which was to be a memorial service at the Civic Center on Sunday, which was being planned by the ministers, apparently with the cooperation of city and state officials. CI had heard nothing about any other marches or any rally. CI said Thursday night, April 4, was very quiet during his night tour of duty, and it appeared most people were at home. However, he noted on Friday night's duty tour that there was a heavy concentration of police cars in the East Denver area, both marked and unmarked cars, but it was his impression most people stayed at home, presumably to avoid the proximity of any trouble.

CI will immediately advise if he obtains any information concerning any demonstration, march, rally, or any acts of vandalism he hears about.
