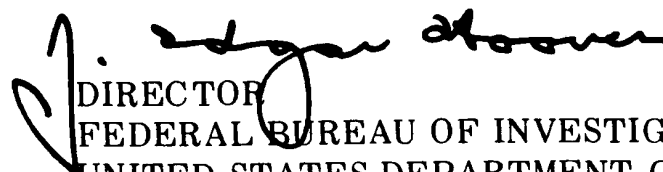

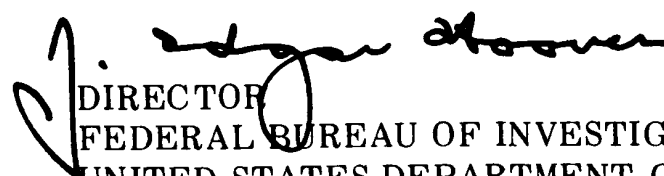

Sketch in King Case Matches Cab Patron

By JOE ZELLNER

ATLANTA, Ga. — (AP) — An Atlanta taxi driver says an FBI sketch matches a rude patron who rode with him two blocks in northeast Atlanta's "hippie" section a night after Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. was slain.

He said the man he identified to an FBI agent in a sketch Tuesday was in a hurry and rushed from his taxi, flinging the fare onto the seat.

The driver, who asked that his name not be used, said FBI agents have been checking taxi trip sheets since a white Mustang, matching the description of a car seen leaving the assassination scene in Memphis, was found abandoned in Atlanta last week.

'NO COMMENT'

The FBI continued its "no comment" policy. Atlanta police said they had received no information on the report.

In Birmingham Monday, the landlord of a boarding house said he was sure the description of Eric Starvo Galt fit that of a man sought by the FBI. "That's him, I'm sure," said Peter Cherpes, 72, referring to the drawings.

The Atlanta taxi driver said the name Galt was not mentioned to him by the FBI agent.

He said the agent questioned him first about a fare he had carried from a night club near Peachtree and 10th Streets, but the driver said he knew the patron "and he was not the same man."

However, the agent then disclosed the sketch which appeared to be a type of composite photograph, and the driver recognized him as a fare he had picked up between 10 p.m. and

midnight Friday, April 5, about four blocks away at Peachtree and 14th Streets in front of a "hippie" coffee house. He said the man appeared to be in a hurry.

"He told me to make a right-hand turn, and he'd let me know when to stop," the driver said. "I went about two blocks, and he told me he wanted to get out."

"When I stopped, he opened the door, and I turned around to make sure I got my fare. I got a good look at him. I put my hand out, but he threw the money on the seat, and it fell on the floor," the driver said. "That made me mad. That's the main reason I remember him so well."

He said the man left the taxi and started away. "I don't know where he went," the driver said. "I drove off."

The driver described the man as about 5 feet 11 and 28 to 30 years old with dark brown hair.

"He was very neatly dressed," he said, adding that the man wore a sport coat with a light-colored shirt without a tie. "He looked as if he had had acne. It looked like little scars on his face from pimples."

The driver said he had seen several sketches. "News reporters haven't shown me any sketches of anyone I've seen," he said. "The FBI has."

However, he then looked at a sketch drawn by an artist in Mexican police headquarters after authorities in that country were drawn into the probe and said it contained some features of the FBI picture "mainly around the eyes."

"The picture they have," he said of the FBI, "that's the man who was in my cab."

FBI agents have questioned hundreds of persons in search of the man named Galt who had

identified himself in Birmingham as an unemployed merchant seaman and as a shipyard worker.

Galt lived at the Cherpes place in Birmingham from Aug.

26 to Oct. 7, then dropped from sight.

The white Mustang found in Atlanta had an Alabama tag issued to him at the Birmingham boarding house address.

WASHINGTON, April 17 — (UPI) — The FBI Wednesday issued a warrant charging Eric Starvo Galt with conspiracy in the assassination of the Rev. Martin Luther King Jr.

It was the first official confirmation of a suspected conspiracy in the slaying of the civil rights leader in Memphis, Tenn., April 4.

Atty. Gen. Ramsey Clark announced that Galt was being sought as a fugitive on a federal charge of conspiracy to violate Dr. King's civil rights.

Wednesday night, Memphis Dist. Atty. Phil Canale filed a charge of murder against Galt, and a state warrant was issued.

The FBI issued two photographs of a man it identified as Galt, also known as Harvey Lowmyer and John Willard. His eyes were closed in one photograph.

The opened eyes were sketched in the photograph by the FBI artists.

The FBI complaint filed in Birmingham, Ala., charges that Galt and an individual "whom he alleged to be his brother entered into a conspiracy which continued until on or about April 5, 1968, to injure, oppress, threaten or intimidate Martin Luther King Jr."

Authorities did not further identify the "brother" and announced no more information about him.

The FBI charged that the conspiracy began at Birmingham on or about March 29, 1968.

In furtherance of the conspiracy, the FBI charged that Galt on or about March 30 purchased a rifle in Birmingham.

FBI Director J. Edgar Hoover said a 30.06-caliber rifle equipped with a telescopic sight was found near a rooming house on South Main st. in Memphis immediately after Dr. King was shot. The rooming house overlooks the Lorraine Motel where Dr. King was staying.

Hoover said FBI agents had determined that the rifle and telescopic sight had been purchased from an unidentified gun dealer in Birmingham on March 30. The FBI did not say that the gun was the murder weapon.

Hoover did identify Galt as the owner of a 1966 white Mustang bearing Alabama license plates which was found abandoned in Atlanta April 11.

Galt purchased the car from a citizen in Birmingham Aug. 30, 1967, the FBI said. The Mustang's odometer showed that it had been driven more than 19,000 miles between late August and early April of this year.

Hoover said Galt had driven the car to Los Angeles, New Orleans, Birmingham and Mexico, as well as to Memphis and to Atlanta. He was reported to have been in Memphis April 3-4 and to have left there for Atlanta.

Galt was described as a white male between 5 feet 8 inches and 5 feet 11 inches tall and weighing 160 to 170 pounds. He was described as a neat dresser with a medium build.

The FBI said its investigation has disclosed that Galt claimed to have been employed as a cook on Mississippi River vessels and as a merchant seaman. He was described as an

avid dancer who took lessons in New Orleans in 1964 and 1965; in Birmingham during September and October 1967, and in Long Beach, Calif., from December 1967, to last February.

Galt left Los Angeles last Dec. 15, the FBI said, and drove the white Mustang to New Orleans, where he claimed he contacted either an engineering or a contracting company. The FBI did not explain why he had done so.

It said Galt went to New Orleans Dec. 19 and returned to Los Angeles last Dec. 21. While in Los Angeles early this year, the FBI said, Galt took a course at a school of bartending and was graduated on March 2.

The FBI refused to say where it obtained Galt's photograph. It said he had brown hair which he wore in a brush cut, blue eyes, a straight and narrow nose, and straight and clean teeth. It said he had given his birth date as July 20, 1931.

The fugitive was further described as having a nervous habit of occasionally pulling at an earlobe with his hand. His left ear protrudes farther from his head than his right, the FBI said.

Hoover said persons who have met Galt said he was a "loner" whose language and diction suggest "he probably does not have a high degree of education. He is said to drink alcoholic beverages with a preference for vodka and beer.

Galt is a fan of Western and country music. The FBI said he should be considered armed and dangerous.

The federal charge of conspiracy to violate Dr. King's civil rights does not preclude the

possibility that the state of Tennessee would charge Dr. King's assassin with murder.

Earlier information in the case suggested strongly that Galt's identity was carefully contrived seven months before Dr. King's murder to help disguise the real killer.

In Birmingham, Peter cherpes, Galt's former landlord who earlier said sketches of the man seen running from the vicinity of where King was slain were definitely Galt said: "I don't think so," when asked if the FBI photographs were of his former tenant.

Others in Birmingham who had identified the sketches as Galt said they were not satisfied the photograph was that of the man named in the conspiracy warrant.

In Memphis, Mrs. Bessie Brewer, who rented a room to Dr. King's killer, said: "I just don't know, I just don't know if it's him," when she was shown the FBI picture. "All I noticed was that he was a neat dresser."

Charlie Stevens, who lives in the flophouse and saw the killer, said the photograph "doesn't register."

(An Atlanta taxicab driver told the Associated Press that an FBI picture he identified as a man he hauled two blocks the night after Dr. King was assassinated was different from the picture of Eric Galt released by the FBI Wednesday.

("The one the FBI showed me was much younger. The face was much thinner. The cheeks weren't as fleshy," said the driver, who has asked that he not be identified.)

Still Is Much Mystery About King Case Suspect

WASHINGTON, April 17 — The FBI has fleshed in the phantom figure of Eric Starvo Galt and charged him with conspiracy in the assassination of the Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.

But in filing a warrant for Galt's arrest in Birmingham, Ala., the FBI left unanswered these key questions in the case: Where is Galt?

Who is the mysterious suspected conspirator and what role did he play? The FBI complaint says only that Galt "and an individual whom he alleged to be his brother" entered into a conspiracy against Dr. King. Where did the FBI obtain its information about Galt and where did it get the pictures of him it released Wednesday night?

In what appeared to be the first big break in the murder of Dr. King two weeks ago, Atty. Gen. Ramsey Clark described Galt as 36 years old, white, a neat dresser, a man of apparently limited education with a preference for vodka and beer, Country and Western music.

He has a nervous habit of occasionally pulling at an ear lobe with his hand, Clark reported, and persons who have met Galt described him as a loner.

Active Dancer

He wears his brown hair in a brush cut, has a "straight and narrow" nose. He's said to be an avid dancer and took dancing lessons in New Orleans, Birmingham and Long Beach, Calif., at intervals between 1964

and February of this year.

He has told people he has been employed as a cook on Mississippi River vessels and as a merchant seaman. He had attended a school for bartenders in Los Angeles early this year and was graduated March 2.

The FBI charges the conspiracy against Dr. King began in Birmingham March 29 and that the next day Galt purchased a rifle and a telescopic sight there.

The complaint also says the conspiracy continued until "on or about" April 5—the day after Dr. King was gunned down on a Memphis motel balcony. This appeared to suggest that Galt's unidentified "brother" may have assisted in his getaway by acting as a decoy or leaving false leads for police after Dr. King was shot.

While FBI director J. Edgar Hoover said a rifle with telescopic sight was found near the rooming house from which Dr. King's assassin fired the fatal shot, the FBI did not specifically identify the rifle as the murder weapon.

Hoover did identify Galt as the owner of a 1966 white Mustang bearing Alabama license plates found abandoned in Atlanta April 11. A white Mustang was spotted leaving the murder scene.

The Mustang found in Atlanta

had been driven more than 19,000 miles since last August when Galt bought it in Birmingham, Hoover said. It had been to Los Angeles, New Orleans, Birmingham and Mexico, as well as Memphis and Atlanta, he said.

Viewed as the most intriguing aspect of the case now was the emergence of the suspected conspirator Galt obviously told someone was his brother.

Soon after Dr. King's murder, Clark said it appeared to be the work of one man and virtually ruled out a conspiracy.

The complaint against Galt specifically charges Galt and the "brother" with conspiring to injure, oppress, threaten, or intimidate Dr. King in his right to travel freely from state to state.

Murder Charge

Justice Department officials said this law carries only a 10-year prison sentence and \$5000 fine on conviction, but noted Clark has indicated that when Dr. King's slayer is found he would be turned over to Tennessee authorities for trial on a murder charge.

The new civil rights law, had it been enacted before Dr. King's slaying, would have permitted the Justice Department to bring a federal murder charge against Dr. King's assassin. As it turned out it was the King assassination that spurred Congress to pass the law.

The FBI said Galt has used the names of Harvey Lowmyer and John Willard—the latter name was used by the suspected killer when he checked into the rooming house across from Dr. King's motel.

Galt's birthplace was not revealed.

State, Federal Papers Name Galt, 'Brother'

MEMPHIS, Tenn. —(AP)— The mysterious Eric Starvo Galt has been charged with conspiracy and murder in the assassination of the Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.

The FBI said in a fugitive warrant issued Wednesday night in Birmingham, Ala., that Galt, 36, conspired with a man "whom he alleged to be his brother" to violate King's civil rights.

The state charge of first-degree murder was filed against Galt in Memphis where King, 39, Nobel Prize-winning civil rights leader, was shot to death on a hotel balcony April 4 by a sniper who hid from a nearby rooming house.

First-degree murder in Tennessee carries the death penalty.

Federal Penalty

The maximum penalty under the federal charge of conspiracy to violate a person's civil rights is a \$5,000 fine and 10-year prison sentence.

The state charge against Galt is contained in a warrant. Before he could stand trial, he must be indicted by a grand jury.

There was no further mention in the FBI statement of the alleged brother and no charge was filed against him.

FBI Director J. Edgar Hoover announced in Washington that the conspiracy to "injure, oppress, threaten or intimidate" King began "on or about March 30" in Birmingham.

The FBI statement said a 30.06 rifle with a telescopic sight, found near the rooming house shortly after King was slain, was purchased March 30 in Birmingham.

The statement did not connect Galt directly with the rifle.

Public Help Asked

The FBI released a photograph of Galt and solicited public aid in finding him. Whether this appeal meant the trail had become cold was unclear, but U.S. Atty. Gen. Ramsey Clark told a reporter in Washington that he felt this was not the situation.

The FBI started hunting Galt a week ago. Agents even contacted persons named Galt in several states in an attempt to find him.

The picture — which had to have the eyes "opened" by an artist — brought uncertain responses from witnesses who were acquainted with Galt or saw the identification.

"Does he not wear a wig or had something like that? It's not the

"I don't really know," Charles Q. Stevens, who lives at the Main Street rooming house from which the fatal shot apparently was fired.

"The hair is too full and the face is too young," he said. But Stevens said he only got a side view of the fleeing figure.

A source in Birmingham said the photograph was taken within the past three months, although the FBI did not specify when it was made.

"It's very near, but I'm not sure," was the reaction of Peter Cherpes, owner of a Birmingham boarding house where an Eric Galt stayed from Aug. 26 to Oct. 7 last year.

"I don't really know," Cherpes

said. "It's so hard to tell. His hair seemed to be lighter."

The FBI, apparently relying on witnesses, said the fugitive had been described as a white man, 5-3 to 5-11, weighing 160 to 175 pounds, with brown hair in a brush cut, blue eyes, straight nose.

'RURAL' SPEECH

Persons who have met Galt, the FBI reported, described him as a loner with a "rural" speech and little schooling, fond of vodka, beer and hillbilly music.

The FBI statement also said, "The fugitive is said to have a nervous habit of occasionally pulling at an ear lobe with his left hand. His left ear protrudes further from his head than his right ear."

"Galt should be considered armed and dangerous," the FBI release warned.

Galt has used the names of John Willard and Harvey Lowmeyer, the FBI said. The assassin registered at the Memphis rooming house under the name of John Willard.

Details of the alleged conspiracy were missing from the FBI release, as were vital statistics, such as Galt's birthplace, formal schooling, employment.

The statement said Galt

claimed to have been a cook on Mississippi riverboats, a merchant seaman and "is said to be an avid dancer."

Galt, the FBI said, is the owner of a 1966 white Mustang with Alabama license plates abandoned in Atlanta the day after King was shot to death. The vehicle was left in the parking lot of an apartment project near the Georgia Capitol.

Two white Mustangs were parked near the rooming house shortly before the shooting, wit-

nesses have said, and both disappeared minutes later.

Some witnesses told of a man in a black business suit, neatly dressed, walking down the rooming house steps to the street, dropping a rifle and getting into a Mustang with either Alabama or Arkansas tags.

A businessman said Wednesday night he was certain the Mustang parked farthest from the shooting scene had an Arkansas tag. "I'm clear in my own mind," he said.

The FBI said Galt's car traveled more than 19,000 miles between Aug. 30, 1967, when he bought it in Birmingham and its abandonment last week in Atlanta. There were trips to Los Angeles, New Orleans and Mexico, the FBI said.

ATLANTA TRIP

"Galt was reported to have been in Memphis April 3 and 4, 1968, and to have departed from there for Atlanta," the FBI said.

Galt was said to have taken dancing lessons in New Orleans in 1964 or 1965, in Birmingham during 1967 and in Long Beach, Calif., in recent months.

While in the Los Angeles area early this year, Galt took a course in bartending and graduated March 2, the FBI said.

In Hollywood, director Tomas Reyes Lau of the International

School of Bartending said Galt took a four-week course but refused a job.

Lau said Galt turned down the job because he wanted to visit his brother.

"He never said anything about Negroes," Lau said. Similarly, residents of the Birmingham boarding house did not recall Galt talking about racial issues.

Galt told his landlord in Birmingham he was on vacation and had worked at Ingalls Shipyards in Pascagoula, Miss.

The company had no record of him.

Likewise, Galt put "merchant seaman, unemployed," on his application for an Alabama driver's license last year, but no record has been found of his name on maritime union rolls.

He also claimed to have had a 1962 Louisiana license, but there is no record of it.

(United Press International)

said an FBI source indicated the "alleged brother" of Galt may be in FBI custody, helping them search for Galt.

(UPI reported the FBI source said that after Galt purchased a gun at a Birmingham sporting goods store about a week before King was killed, he took it to the man he said was his brother.

(His brother, the FBI source

said, told him "that's not the gun we need," according to UPI. The source refused to say, UPI reported, whether the knowledge of this conversation meant that the unnamed second man in the alleged conspiracy was in FBI custody.)

An FBI spokesman said "the FBI has no one in custody in connection with Dr. King's slaying."

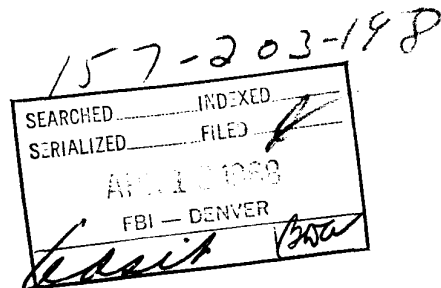

Mr. DARMOPRAY stated that he had talked with SMITH when he had applied for the license and during this conversation SMITH had stated that in late December, 1967, he had completed three years with the U. S. Marine Corps and had been discharged at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina. SMITH also stated that he was from Lincoln, Nebraska, and had had in the past a Nebraska license. 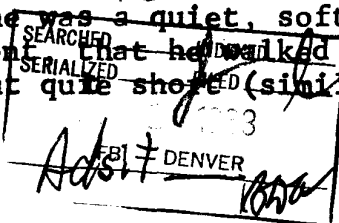
