In connection with the captioned case there has been speculation that James Earl Ray concocted the alias of Eric Starvo Galt by combining the names of characters from books by Ian Fleming and from a book "Atlas Shrugged" by Ayn Rand. This speculation is based on the fact that in the James Bond books by Ian Fleming there is a character named Ernst Stavro Blofield and in "Atlas Shrugged" there is a character named John Galt, as well as one named Eric Starnes. Ernst Stavro Blofield is a formidable person, John Galt is a "social drop out" and Eric Starnes is described in the book as a "whiner" from a low-class family.

In view of the above and in order that Agents handling this investigation can be alert to the possibility of Ray's utilizing an alias based on characters in Fleming's books, there is set out as an attachment to this airtel a list of various characters in those books for your assistance.

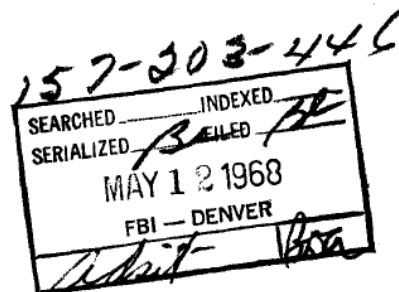

She related this Mustang had 1968 Colorado license TK 6894. She stated that they parked next to this individual for about 15 minutes and this individual did not get out of his car. She said he had brown hair, cut short with a balding area in the back of his head and he had a noticeable protruding left ear. She stated this person had several ~~tatto~~ tattoos on both arms and she would guess he weighed 170 lbs.

Some differences were noted between the "Carl Ray" signatures on Q325 when compared with the signatures in this name appearing on Q322 (Frontier Airlines temporary credit card), but the limited nature of the questioned signature precluded a definite opinion from being reached.

On 5/6/68 pursuant to telephone call by ROY BACHELOR, 1647 Gaylord, Denver, Colorado, advising that he might possibly have information re the whereabouts of JAMES EARL RAY, BACHELOR was interviewed at his residence on the same date by SA G. HOWARD CARTER, at which time he related the following information:

BACHELOR stated that he is a clairvoyant and that on very infrequent occasions he receives an intuitive feeling from the ether, which he describes as a nebulous source of information and that recently he received a message, the contents of which are as follows :

JAMES EARL RAY, who killed MARTIN LUTHER KING, has left the country on Flight 414, no particular date other than the fact it occurred in the past. BACHELOR stated that he has inquired at Stapleton Airport, Denver, Colorado and found that there are two Flight 414's in the U.S., one being the American Airlines Flight from Toronto to New York City; the other a Delta Flight from Shreveport, Louisiana to New Orleans.

On 4/25/68, Mr. EARL JOHNSON, 3191 Broadway, Boulder, Colorado, viewed photographs of JAMES EARL RAY, and stated the side view of RAY depicted in Wanted Flier 442-A bears a slight resemblance to an individual he knew as TAD KRUPPA, whom he met in the bar at the Laguna Dance Hall, east of Kentucky Avenue and Morrison Road, Denver, Colorado, sometime in 1966. JOHNSON stated he has always been interested in ballroom dancing and in conversation with KRUPPA determined that he was also a participant in this form of entertainment.

JOHNSON continued that he subsequently introduced KRUPPA to GLORIA HARRIGAN, manager of the Fred Astaire Dance School in Boulder, who became impressed with KRUPPA's ballroom dancing ability and actually hired him to give lessons for her on a part time basis. JOHNSON advised he has not seen KRUPPA for approximately one year, but is certain that it was during 1966 and 1967 that KRUPPA was employed at the Fred Astaire Dancing Studio.

JOHNSON advised he knew little of KRUPPA's background other than the fact that he was from the State of New York and at the time he met him at the Laguna Dance Hall was of the understanding that KRUPPA had just recently arrived in this area from New York.

He described KRUPPA as follows:

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at her studio sometime during the latter part of 1966 and the early part of 1967. She advised he only worked one or two days a month for her and that she was unable to locate any employment records to verify this, but is certain that his employment was during this period. Mrs. HERRIGAN viewed the photographs of JAMES EARL RAY as set forth in Wanted Flier 442-A and advised the individual she knew as TED KRUPPA is positively not identical with RAY. She stated she knows nothing of KRUPPA's background, but does recall that he surreptitiously dated another instructor by the name of JULIE BISDORF, 2215 Eldred Street, Golden, Colorado, wife of the golf professional BILL BISDORF at Green Gables Country Club, Morrison, Colorado. ||

In view of the fact that both JOHNSON and HERRIGAN can verify the fact that KRUPPA was in the Boulder, Colorado area during the period RAY was confined to the Missouri State Penitentiary no further inquiries were conducted in this regard.

On 5/13/68, Mrs. MOSELLE DROLLINGER, 12300 East Nevada Avenue, Aurora, Colorado (telephone number 343-0665), telephoned and advised that she had information concerning an individual who might possibly be responsible for the murder of Reverend MARTIN LUTHER KING.

Mrs. DROLLINGER was reluctant to discuss the matter over the telephone and stated emphatically that she did not wish her identity or the fact that she was furnishing the information to the FBI to become known to anyone, not even to her husband, VICTOR.

Mrs. DROLLINGER requested to be contacted, but stated that such contact would have to be arranged by telephone. She promised to call back and contact the writer later on 5/13/68, and arrange this contact.

Mrs. DROLLINGER did state that she had recently returned from Alabama, where she attended her mother's funeral. She indicated she had heard certain of her relatives talking while she was in Alabama and they were discussing an individual who was believed to be hiding out in a small town in Alabama. She stated that this individual was supposed to bear a striking resemblance to the sketch of the individual who appeared in the newspaper who was reportedly responsible for Reverend MARTIN LUTHER KING's murder.

Mrs. DROLLINGER stated she knew the name of this individual but she would not furnish it over the telephone. She also declined to discuss the matter further over the telephone.

Sgt. PIERCE, Cortez, Colo. PD was contacted on 4/25/68 from Denver at which time he advised that Colo. 1968 License XL 936 was issued in Montezuma County, Colo. to RAMONA AND ELVIN J. BEECHER, Box 783, Dolores, Colo. on a 1963 Chrysler 4 door. The 1967 tag #XL0936 was issued to DEAN L. STANLEY, Dolores, Colo. on a 1966 Chevrolet sedan. On 4/25/68 CLARENCE WILLIAMS, Town Marshal, Dolores, Colo., advised that he had observed the 1967 License Plate in a dump on the Stanley farm on that date. He further advised that BEECHER had the license plates on his 1963 Chrysler in Dolores, Colo. and is a long time resident of the area. 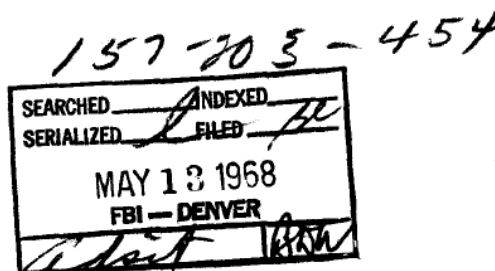

Clark Believes Ray Still Alive

WASHINGTON, May 12—(UPI)—Atty. Gen. Ramsey Clark expressed the belief Sunday that escaped convict James Earl Ray, accused of slaying the Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., remains alive. He said he was "very optimistic" that Ray would be captured.

Clark said he found no evidence to support theories that Ray had been hired by conspirators to kill the Rev. Dr. King and then himself was killed. "We have no evidence to believe that he is not still alive," he said.

"I believe we will find him," Clark said. Citing the "massive manhunt" under way for Ray, he said, "It is awfully difficult for an individual, and particularly an individual about whom so much is known, to remain at large in the United States under these circumstances."

Clark also said the investigation was still operating on

the assumption that the Rev. Dr. King's killer was not the agent of conspirators.

"Our evidence indicates a man acting alone," he said.

"This does not negate other theories. It would be impossible to rule out a conspiracy on the right or the left or the middle or any other type of conspiracy."

Clark, who predicted that the Rev. Dr. King's killer would be apprehended within a few days of his assassination in Memphis, Tenn., on April 4, said he was "disappointed" that his prediction was wrong.

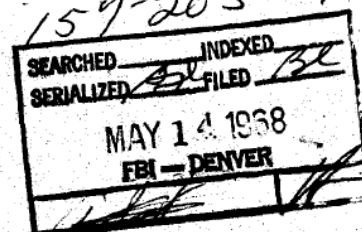

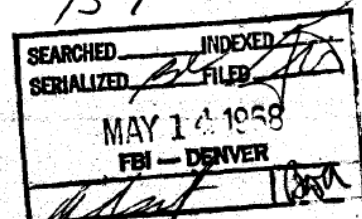
