This is to advise that on 4-6-68 Mr. MIKE RAMIREZ, owner, El Paso Pharmacy, called this office to be certain that this office and U.S. Secret Service did not overlook ROBERT MOLL as a possible suspect in the captioned matter.

He related that MOLL was in his drugstore on 8-28-67 and advised RAMIREZ that he "would assassinate President L.B. JOHNSON and MARTIN LUTHER KING as soon as he gets close to them" and seemed very sincere. MOLL was later arrested by Secret Service during the visit of President JOHNSON to El Paso in connection with the Chamizal Settlement.

SA PRASEK, after thanking Mr. RAMIREZ for his reminding this office of a suspect, contacted SAIC GEORGE WEISHEIT of USSS and WEISHEIT advised that MOLL has been undergoing psychiatric examinations at the U. S. Medical Center, St. Louis, Missouri, and that he has been found suitable to stand trial and a court order has been executed for his return to El Paso.

WEISHEIT further advised that he will be notified in the event MOLL were to be released on bail.

RECOMMENDATION

In view of the fact that MOLL is in custody, no further action is recommended in this matter.

FBI Inadvertantly Tells King Suspect

MIAMI, Fla. (AP) — The FBI distributed a teletype pickup order to Florida police Thursday for Eric Starvo Galt, then withdrew the message four hours later because it had been released by mistake.

The message gave a description for Galt matching the description they circulated for the killer of Martin Luther King and said he was driving a white Mustang similar to that believed driven by King's assassin.

When asked by The Associated Press if they were releasing the identity of the suspect in the King murder, FBI Special Agent John Hanlon said, "I cannot comment."

Hanlon issued a bulletin on the police teletypes about 9:35 p.m. withdrawing the message.

The original message, signed by Special Agent Charles Bell, described Galt as a white man, born July 20, 1931, about 5'11", 175 pounds, with blue eyes and brown hair.

The message was originally put on statewide police teletypes at 5:22 p.m. Thursday.

The message said Galt was driving a white Mustang with 1968 Alabama license tags, 1-38993.

No warrant had been issued for Galt, the message said.

In Washington, an aide to Atty. Gen. Ramsey Clark said the Justice Department chief would have no comment on the matter.

In Atlanta Thursday, federal agents impounded a white Mustang, the Atlanta Constitution reported in Friday editions.

The license number of that car matched the number given by the Miami FBI in its pickup order, WSB television Atlanta reported. The station said that two Atlanta residents wrote down the number of the car before it was impounded. The station reported that number as Alabama 1-38 993.

In Birmingham, Ala., police said that license tag had been issued to Eric S. Galt, 2608 Highland Ave., Birmingham.

Residents at that address, which was Galt's last known address in Birmingham,

confirmed they had been questioned by the FBI concerning Galt, the Post-Herald reported.

The newspapers said the residents reported that they had not seen Galt for about three months and did not recall what type of car he owned.

The Post-Herald said the man has no record of arrest in Birmingham.

Earlier, the FBI reportedly checked Birmingham gun dealers apparently trying to determine if a rifle found near the scene of the shooting was purchased in the Alabama city.

The Memphis getaway car was thought to have Arkansas tags. Both Arkansas and Alabama have red and white tags.

Meanwhile, the Atlanta Constitution said the car picked up had been parked since last Friday at a public housing project near the Georgia State Capitol. King was murdered the night before that in Memphis, Tenn.

FBI agents would not comment on that report but residents of the project were questioned closely by agents. Other agents swarmed around the car photographing it and dusting for fingerprints, said the story by Duane Riner.

The newspaper said the car was taken to a federal building and locked up.

The Constitution said Mrs. Ernest Payne saw the car arrive in the lot last Friday evening. The newspaper said she described the man who stepped out of the car as between 25 and 30 years, 5-feet-9 or -10 and weighing 165 to 170 pounds.

In Miami, the head of the Dade Public Safety Dept. communications department, Lt. Charles Wells, explained that the message circulated for Galt was received from the FBI. "All we did is put it out for them," Wells said.

The department shift commander, H. O. Smith, said under new rules applied earlier this month all statewide messages must originate with the Dade County communications system.

Search of premises believed occupied by Unsub who assassinated Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING on 4/4/68, disclosed suitcase in which was located tee-shirt and undershorts bearing laundry mark on red tape with black lettering believed to be thermo-seal type, manufactured by Textile Marking Machine Co., Inc., Syracuse, N. Y. The tape is 1/4" wide and 1 1/16" long and bears letters and numbers 02B-6.

Experts at Textile Marking Machine Co. advise type on this machine is unusual in that the first two characters are 15 point type and the last three characters are 18 point type, with the middle character, the letter B, probably being narrow rather than regular type. The usual machine carries 15 point type for the first three characters and 18 point type for the last two characters.

Textile Marking Machine experts also stated this machine is defective in that it is producing a tape 1 1/16" long instead of 1 1/8" long and is not projecting the tape far enough resulting in cutting off a portion of the first letter. The code used in the Northeast part of the U. S. is as follows:

The first letter O stands for lot number; the first number 2 indicates the day of the week, two being Tuesday; the second letter indicates the first letter of the store name, this is the letter B; the last number is the bundle number, this is 6. Color coding of the tag may designate various things such as a different month or the identity of a store in a chain. Experts also state the use of this system on laundry items is unusual in that the system is normally used on garments being dry cleaned.

The Bureau has instructed that all textile machines using this type tape be located and machines using this code be identified.
