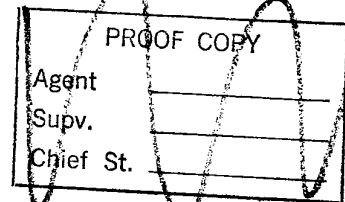
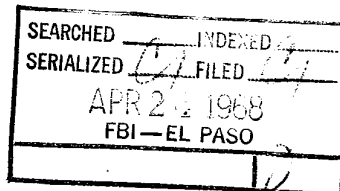
SUBJECT: MURKIN

At approximately 8:00 AM 4-23-68 WESLEY E. SHAVER, Ass't. Chief Clerk, received a call from an individual who gave his name as "PHILLIP WHITE". He stated that about a half an hour ago a man resembling ERIC STARVO GALT was in the Aztec Bar, 500 South Stanton, El Paso.

ROSA ONTEVEROS, Barmaid, Aztec Bar, advised that she was alone in the bar, that no customers had been in this morning, that no one used the pay telephone in the bar, and that she did not know anyone by the name of PHILIP WHITE.

A copy of the I.O. relating to GALT was shown to her and she could not identify it as resembling anyone she knew. A copy was left with her to place under the bar in the event someone resembling GALT did come in.

Noted that Butel dated 4/22/68, set out below, was read at an all Agents Conference on the morning of 4/23/68:

"You are reminded that all leads in this case must be covered within 24 hours, and all leads must be set forth by telephone or teletype. All border offices covering entry into Mexico and Canada and exit therefrom should insure that appropriate stops are maintained re subject and all names known to be used by him at respective offices of U. S. Immigration and Border Patrol. You should also insure that previous stops placed with any facility should include all names used by the subject."

"Distribute sufficient quantities of Wanted Flyers and IO's to narcotic investigative agencies (Customs Agency Service) in order that their informants may be contacted. You should contact all criminal informants and appropriate racial and security informants."

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SA ELLISON was given 10 copies of the blind memo, 20 copies of the Spanish language Wanted Flyer on JAMES EARL RAY and 5 copies of the photograph of WALTER TERRY RIFE on 4/23/68 for delivery to all appropriate agencies in Juarez, including Mexican Immigration and all police agencies, where stops should be logically placed regarding subject RAY.

In addition, 20 copies of the blind memo, 40 copies of the Wanted Flyer and 3 copies of the photo of WALTER TERRY RIFE were mailed to the Midland Resident Agency on the night of 4/22/68 for delivery to Regional Headquarters of DPS in Midland and to other appropriate police agencies in the Midland Resident Agency.

On the afternoon of 4/19/68, copies of the 4/19/68 press release (Serial 77) were delivered to the El Paso newspapers, radio and tv stations. SA PARSEK prepared a memo (Serial 79) regarding deliveries made by him. In addition, the following deliveries were made:

In addition, copies of the above-mentioned ~~blind~~ press release dated 4/19/68, along with a copy of the photograph of JAMES EARL RAY, taken in 1968, were mailed on the night of 4/19/68 to the 21 newspapers on the mailing list of the El Paso Office located in the El Paso Division.

Noted that the IOs and Wanted Flyers on JAMES EARL RAY were mailed by the Night Clerk (PETE MUNOZ) to the appropriate agencies on the mailing list on 4/23/68.

Noted that extra copies of the Wanted Flyer on ERIC STARVO GALT, WF 442, were delivered on the morning of 4/19/68 to the various police agencies in El Paso and Juarez, including the Mexican and United States Immigration authorities. Extra copies were mailed to the Midland RA for distribution to appropriate agencies. This Wanted Flyer, #442, was mailed by the Night Clerk to the appropriate agencies on the mailing list on 4/20/68.

APRIL 19, 1968

ATTORNEY GENERAL RAMSEY CLARK ANNOUNCED TODAY THAT THE FBI HAS IDENTIFIED JAMES EARL RAY, AN ESCAPEE FROM THE MISSOURI STATE PENITENTIARY, AS ERIC STARVO GALT, AGAINST WHOM A FEDERAL COMPLAINT WAS FILED LAST WEDNESDAY IN CONNECTION WITH THE FATAL SHOOTING OF THE REVEREND DR. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR.

DIRECTOR J. EDGAR HOOVER SAID THAT A SYSTEMATIC AND EXHAUSTIVE SEARCH OF LATENT FINGERPRINTS UNCOVERED IN THE DR. KING CASE AGAINST THE FINGERPRINTS OF THE OVER 53,000 PERSONS FROM WHOM "WANTED NOTICES" HAVE BEEN POSTED IN THE FILES OF THE FBI'S IDENTIFICATION DIVISION LED TO THE DETERMINATION THAT GALT AND RAY ARE IDENTICAL.

MR. HOOVER SAID THAT RAY, WHO IS 40 YEARS OF AGE, WAS REPORTED MISSING FROM THE MISSOURI STATE PENITENTIARY AT JEFFERSON CITY, MISSOURI, SINCE APRIL 23, 1967. HE HAD BEEN RECEIVED AT THAT INSTITUTION ON MARCH 17, 1960, TO SERVE A 20-YEAR SENTENCE FOLLOWING CONVICTION IN ST. LOUIS FOR ARMED ROBBERY AND FOR OPERATING A MOTOR VEHICLE WITHOUT PERMISSION OF THE OWNER.

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IN SEPTEMBER, 1966, WHILE SERVING THIS SENTENCE, HE WAS CONFINED FOR A TIME IN THE MAXIMUM SECURITY WARD AT THE STATE HOSPITAL AT FULTON, MISSOURI.

ACCORDING TO MR. HOOVER, RAY HAS A KNOWN ARREST RECORD DATING BACK TO 1949. PRIOR TO THE 1960 CONVICTION FOR WHICH HE RECEIVED THE 20-YEAR TERM, RAY HAD BEEN CONVICTED OF BURGLARY IN LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA, IN 1949; ARMED ROBBERY IN CHICAGO, ILLINOIS, IN 1952; AND FORGING UNITED STATES POSTAL MONEY ORDERS IN MISSOURI IN 1955.

HE HAS SERVED TERMS IN THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY JAIL IN 1949; IN STATE PRISONS AT JOLIET AND PONTIAC, ILLINOIS, IN 1952-54; AND IN THE FEDERAL PENITENTIARY AT LEAVENWORTH, KANSAS, IN 1955-58.

RAY WAS AN ENLISTED MAN IN THE UNITED STATES ARMY FROM FEBRUARY, 1946, TO DECEMBER, 1948, AT WHICH TIME HE WAS GIVEN A GENERAL DISCHARGE DUE TO INEPTNESS AND LACK OF ADAPTABILITY FOR MILITARY SERVICE. WHILE IN THE ARMY, HE RECEIVED A THREE-MONTH SENTENCE AT HARD LABOR FOR BEING DRUNK AND BREAKING ARREST.

MR. HOOVER SAID THAT DURING HIS CRIMINAL CAREER, RAY HAS ALSO USED THE NAMES OF JAMES MCBRIDE, JAMES WALTON, W. C. HERRON AND JAMES O'CONNER. HE IS A WHITE MALE; CLAIMS TO HAVE

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BEEN BORN [REDACTED], IN ILLINOIS; IS APPROXIMATELY 5 FEET 10 INCHES TALL AND WEIGHS ABOUT 163 TO 174 POUNDS. HE HAS BLUE EYES AND BROWN HAIR. THERE IS A SMALL SCAR ON THE CENTER OF HIS FOREHEAD AND A SCAR ON THE PALM OF HIS RIGHT HAND.

RAY HAS CLAIMED THAT HE ATTENDED SCHOOL THROUGH THE 10TH GRADE IN ALTON, ILLINOIS. HE HAS HAD THE REPUTATION OF BEING A "DRIFTER" SINCE LEAVING SCHOOL. HIS VOCATIONAL EXPERIENCE INCLUDES WORKING AS A BAKER, LABORER AND COLOR MATCHER.

IN CONNECTION WITH HIS ESCAPE FROM THE MISSOURI STATE PENITENTIARY, AN FBI COMPLAINT WAS FILED IN JEFFERSON CITY, MISSOURI, ON JULY 20, 1967, CHARGING RAY WITH UNLAWFULLY FLEEING FROM THE STATE OF MISSOURI TO AVOID CONFINEMENT. HE HAS BEEN A FEDERAL FUGITIVE SINCE THEN.

JAMES EARL RAY AND WALTER TERRY RIFE ON MARCH 7, 1955, BURGLARIZED THE U.S. POST OFFICE AT KELLERVILLE, ILLINOIS, AND STOLE 66 BLANK U.S. POSTAL MONEY ORDERS WHICH THEY PASSED DURING MARCH, 1955, IN NUMEROUS STATES, WITH THE RESULT THAT BOTH WERE SENTENCED IN U.S. DISTRICT COURT, KANSAS CITY, MISSOURI, ON JULY 1, 1955, TO THE U.S. PENITENTIARY, LEAVENWORTH, KANSAS. SUBJECT RAY HAS BEEN DESCRIBED AS A LONER AND RIFE APPARENTLY IS ONE OF HIS FEW CLOSE ASSOCIATES.

RAY UNDER FBI NO. 306443A:
