RE SUSPECT LON R. HUMMEL:

During the morning of 4/23/68, SA WALLACE A. CROSSMON received a telephone call from SA COLIN DUNNIGAN of the Phoenix Office, at which time SA DUNNIGAN advised as follows:

IRENE FARR, Proprietor of the Farr Motel, 4450 Grand Avenue, Phoenix, Arizona, advised that an individual registered at the motel on the night of 4/22/68, under the name of L. R. HUMMEL, 5500 Martin Lane, El Paso, Texas. HUMMEL was driving a white Ford Bronco, 1968 Texas license CLB 94. Mrs. FARR indicated this individual checked out of the motel at 7:30 a.m. on 4/23/68. She said he fit the same general description of JAMES EARL RAY. She noted that his left ear protuded, that he was thin, and that he wore glasses.

SA CROSSMON ascertained that the white Ford Bronco with 1968 Texas license CLB 94 was registered to LON R. HUMMEL, 5939 Falcon Street, El Paso.

The 1967 City Directory reflected that the Crown Plastic Products, Inc., was located at 5939 Falcon Street in El Paso.

SA CROSSMON telephonically contacted the Crown Plastic Products, Inc., telephone 751-1239, at which time he was advised by the switchboard operator that LON R. HUMMEL resigned from the employ of Crown Plastic Products, Inc., about two weeks ago, and went to Wilcox, Arizona, where he planned to contact a Mr. TATE, an employee of a lumber company in Wilcox.

Noted Phoenix teletype to El Paso dated 4/24/68, indicated that the San Antonio Office had checked the records of the Texas DPS and had not been able to locate a Texas driver's license for LON R. HUMMEL.

Phoenix requested in the teletype that El Paso conduct credit and criminal checks and other appropriate checks to identify and locate LON R. HUMMEL and eliminate him as possibly identical with JAMES EARL RAY.

On 4/24/68, Mrs. LEE NOLAN, President, Crown Plastic Products, Inc., 5939 Falcon Street, El Paso, was interviewed regarding HUMMEL and a teletype has been sent to the Phoenix Office, air mail copy of same to Memphis, setting out the results of the information obtained from Mrs. NOLAN regarding HUMMEL.

BALDRIDGE HAS MAINTAINED CONTINUOUS CONTACT WITH INLAWS, WHO HAVE NOT SEEN WIFE AND CHILDREN. BALDRIDGE RECEIVED LETTER FROM WIFE THIS DATE, WHEREIN SHE STATED SHE WAS STAYING WITH HER PARENTS, MR. AND MRS. FAUCETT, AND WANTED HIM TO SEND HER MONEY CARE OF HER AUNT, RUTH JAMES, CALHOUN, GEORGIA. LETTER POSTMARKED APRIL TWENTYTWO LAST AT SALTVILLE, VIRGINIA.

BALDRIDGE JUST LEARNED HIS WIFE LIVED WITH ANOTHER MAN WHILE BALDRIDGE WAS IN VIETNAM IN SIXTY SIX AND SIXTY SEVEN AND PLANS DIVORCE. BALDRIDGE OF OPINION WIFE PROBABLY RAN OFF WITH SOME MAN. RECALLED THAT HE AND WIFE PLANNED TRIP TO TAMPA, FLORIDA IN NINETEEN SIXTYFOUR WHICH WAS CALLED OFF DUE TO OVERSEAS TRANSFER. WIFE REMARKED TO BALDRIDGE AT THE TIME THAT SHE MIGHT HAVE CHANCE TO SEE FRIEND NAMED EARL IF THEY WINT TO FLORIDA. WIFE AND CHILDREN FAILED TO ARRIVE AND SGT. BALDRIDGE LEARNED THROUGH RED CROSS WIFE LEFT HER EMPLOYMENT APRIL ONE LAST, STATING SHE WAS GOING TO PARENTS HOME, NAMELY MR. AND MRS. BILLY FAUCETT, BOX TWO FOUR ZERO, ROUTE ONE, CLARKSVILLE, VIRGINIA, TELEPHONE THREE SEVEN FOUR DASH EIGHT SEVEN ONE NINE.

BALDRIDGE HAS MAINTAINED CONTINUOUS CONTACT WITH INLAWS, WHO HAVE NOT SEEN WIFE AND CHILDREN. BALDRIDGE RECEIVED LETTER FROM WIFE THIS DATE, WHEREIN SHE STATED SHE WAS STAYING WITH HER PARENTS, MR. AND MRS. FAUCETT, AND WANTED HIM TO SEND HER MONEY CARE OF HER AUNT, RUTH JAMES, CALHOUN, GEORGIA. LETTER POSTMARKED APRIL TWENTYTWO LAST AT SALTVILLE, VIRGINIA.

BALDRIDGE JUST LEARNED HIS WIFE LIVED WITH ANOTHER MAN WHILE BALDRIDGE WAS IN VIETNAM IN SIXTY SIX AND SIXTYSEVEN AND PLANS DIVORCE. BALDRIDGE OF OPINION WIFE PROBABLY RAN OFF WITH SOME MAN. RECALLED THAT HE AND WIFE PLANNED TRIP TO TAMPA, FLORIDA IN NINETEEN SIXTYFOUR WHICH WAS CALLED OFF DUE TO OVERSEAS TRANSFER. WIFE REMARKED TO BALDRIDGE AT THE TIME THAT SHE MIGHT HAVE CHANCE TO SEE FRIEND NAMED EARL IF THEY WENT TO FLORIDA. BALDRIDGE SUBSEQUENTLY QUESTIONED HER MORE THOROUGHLY RE THIS, AT WHICH TIME WIFE SAID THAT, AFTER GRADUATING FROM HIGHT SCHOOL IN NINETEEN FIFTYSEVEN, SHE AND ~~PATSY~~ AND HER COUSIN PATSY MADE TRIP TO FLORIDA, WHERE SHE MET ONE ERIC RAY, WHOM SHE CALLED EARL. STOLEN CARS FROM THE STATE OF GEORGIA:

Noted that serial 101 is a communication from the Atlanta Office, wherein it was requested that appropriate checks be made in an effort to ascertain if any stolen automobiles with Georgia license plates had been recovered on any date in the El Paso Division subsequent to 4/4/68.

SA SICKLES advised on 4/24/68, that he had checked with the EPPD and the EPSO regarding this matter, and that no information had been developed regarding such vehicles.

On 4/24/68, SA PICKEN advised that he had made the appropriate checks in his road trip territory, and with Texas DPS, El Paso, and that no information had been developed regarding such vehicles.

On 4/25/68, SA MAURER telephonically advised that the three Midland Resident Agents had made the appropriate checks on 4/24/68, throughout the Midland Resident Agency, and that no information had been developed regarding any stolen vehicles which had been recovered subsequent to 4/4/68, bearing Georgia license plates.

On 4/24/68, SA LYONS advised that no stolen automobiles with Georgia license plates had been recovered in Juarez, Mexico, subsequent to 4/4/68. He said that

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he and SA ELLISON had checked the Chihuahua State Traffic Department Impound Lot in Juarez on 4/18/68, and that no such vehicles had been observed at the location. He said that EP 617-C, was alerted on 4/18/68, to immediately advise SAs ELLISON and LYONS of any vehicles recovered in Juarez and placed in the above mentioned impound lot. SA LYONS advised that no such information had been received from EP 617-C subsequent to 4/18/68.

At 9:55 a.m. on 4/25/68, SA SICKLES telephonically advised that he had been checking all of the automobiles located at the El Paso Wrecking Company and had determined that a 1966 Oldsmobile 98, four-door hardtop, VIN 384396M242814, 1967 Georgia license plates 56A471, had been impounded at the El Paso Wrecking Company Lot since 4/20/68. He said that the Airport Police at the El Paso International Airport had placed a ticket for over parking on this Oldsmobile on 4/20/68, and that the automobile had been removed from the parking lot at the airport, and taken to the wrecking company lot on that date. SA SICKLES advised that on the rear seat of the Oldsmobile was contained 1968 Georgia license plates 56A357.

At 10:05 a.m. on 4/25/68, the above information was furnished to ASAC JACK KEITH, of the Atlanta Office, who advised that a check would be made to ascertain if the Oldsmobile in question was stolen.

At 10:50 a.m. on 4/25/68, ASAC JACK KEITH, Atlanta Office, advised that the above mentioned Oldsmobile was registered to H. C. RAIFORD, Box 340, Vidalia, Georgia. He said the Atlanta Office had no information to indicate that this automobile had been stolen, and that a check had been made with NCIC regarding this automobile with negative results.

Mr. KEITH said that he had telephonically contacted the Savannah Office and had talked with SA STEPHENSON, who was on the ASAC's desk, and that he had been advised by SA STEPHENSON that the Savannah Office had no theft report on the Oldsmobile in question.

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Mr. KEITH said that SA STEPHENSON indicated that the Savannah Office would contact the El Paso Office after contact had been made with H. C. RAIFORD regarding the Oldsmobile in question.

Mr. WESTFALL was advised that information should be relayed to Mr. H. C. RAIFORD that his 1966 Oldsmobile was presently located on the Impound Lot of the El Paso Wrecking Company, telephone 778-6336.

SA SICKLES subsequently advised on 4/25/68, that the above mentioned 1966 Oldsmobile was the only automobile impounded at the lot of the El Paso Wrecking Company since 4/4/68, which had on it Georgia license plates.

Prison Buddy Tells About Man Sought

Says Suspect Ray
Said He Would
Collect Big Sum

DALTON, Ga., April 23.—A prison buddy of James Earl Ray said Tuesday that when Ray heard there was a "million-dollar bounty" on Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., he smiled and said "I'll collect it."

Ray, a 40-year-old fugitive from the Missouri State Prison, is accused by the FBI of assassinating King in Memphis on April 4.

In the Dalton jail, Raymond Curtis, 40, awaiting appeal on a murder sentence, said he has known Ray in the Kansas City jail, in Federal prison in Leavenworth, Kan., and in the state prison at Jefferson City, Mo.

He described Ray as likeable, addicted to "dope," a "loner" and a man concerned only with money.

ON THE DAY President Kennedy was ~~assassinated~~—Nov. 23, 1963—Curtis said he, Ray, and about 150 other prisoners were in an exercise yard when they heard the news.

He said Ray remarked "Well, somebody made a pretty penny on that."

About a week later, Curtis said, he and Ray were in the yard when "a new man just in off the street" told them "the Businessmen's Association has a million dollar bounty out for Martin Luther King."

Ray smiled, Curtis recalled, and said "If there's a million dollars out for King, I believe if I ever get out I'll collect it."

CURTIS SAID HE never figured out what the "new man" meant by the "Businessmen's Association." He said he couldn't remember who the man was.

"I didn't think much about it at the time. In prison, you hear all sorts of hellacious ideas," said Curtis, a tall, rawboned man.

Authorities in Jefferson City confirmed that Curtis and Ray were in prison at the same time. Authorities in Dalton said the FBI had interviewed Curtis on
