The following investigation was conducted by SAS John E. Dailey and Paul S. Pullen at El Paso, Texas:

On 5/1/68, Paul Bishop, Asst. Office Mgr., O.K. Van and Storage Co., advised that his company is an agent for American Engign Van Service at 5950 E. Paisano St. He advised that American Ensign Co. handles only shipments of household goods of military dependents.

His company makes no record of long distance calls by date and would not record the location from which the calls were made. He stated if an individual had called his office from Van Horn or Sierra Blanca, Texas in December, 1967 it would most likely have been a service man calling to check on his household goods. He was furnished an IO of Ray to post on his employee bulletin board, and he stated he had no information regarding Ray.

On 5/1/68, Ted J. Higdon, office manager, AAA Auto Association, 5036 E. Paisana St., advised that his office handles trouble calls from clients and members, and also makes hotel and motel reservations. He stated that if a call had been made to his office from Van Horn, Texas in December, 1967, it most likely was a member of the association calling before arrival in El Paso for a reservation, and no record would be kept of such request. He was furnished a copy of the IO regarding Ray, but he advised he had no information about him.

On 5/1/68, James Belabert, manager, Chamizal Trading Co., 333 West San Antonio St., advised that he made a long distance call to his office from Van Horn, Texas on approximately 12/16/67 to report difficulty with one of his trucks then in that area, and made such from a ~~telephone booth~~ public telephone there. He had no information regarding Ray and was furnished a copy of the IO regarding Ray.
