On 4/26/68, **PATTY GUNN**, P. O. Box 641, Clarksville, Va., advised she is a cousin to **SHIRLEY JEAN BALMORICH**, nee **Fausett**. She stated that she never traveled to the State of Fla. with her cousin, **SHIRLEY JEAN**, and, in fact, has never left the State of Va. She also advised that to her knowledge **SHIRLEY JEAN** has never traveled to Fla. She stated that **SHIRLEY JEAN** has had some difficulty with men and her marriage to **ELMER BALMORICH** is her second. She further stated that while **BALMORICH** was in Vietnam **SHIRLEY JEAN** lived with another man in Texas. She said it is her opinion that **SHIRLEY JEAN** is trying to get away from **BALMORICH**. She stated she does not know anyone named **ERIC RAY** or **RALPH RAY** and never heard **SHIRLEY JEAN** mention anyone by that name. She observed photographs of **JAMES EARL RAY** and advised she has never seen anyone who resembles the photo nor does she know this man.

She stated that to her knowledge SHIRLEY JEAN has never traveled to Fla. at any time and she has never heard her mention an ERIC RAY or EARL RAY. She stated her daughter is having some marital difficulties with her husband, KIMBERT BALDRIDGE. She said SHIRLEY JEAN visited her in December, 1967, and left in January, 1968, to return to Texas but she has not heard from her since that time. She said she had no idea of her whereabouts until BALDRIDGE called her about 4/23/68 and told her he received a letter from SHIRLEY JEAN postmarked Saltville, Va. Mrs. FAUCETT advised she has no people in Saltville, Va., and did not know why her daughter would be in that section of the state. Mrs. FAUCETT further advised that Sgt. BALDRIDGE told her not to worry about SHIRLEY JEAN because he had the FBI and Red Cross looking for her and they would find her soon. Mrs. FAUCETT observed pictures of JAMES EARL RAY and advised she did not know him nor did she recognize any of the photographs. Mrs. FAUCETT advised that should she learn the whereabouts of her daughter, SHIRLEY JEAN, she would advise this office.
