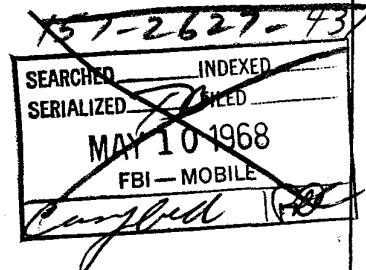
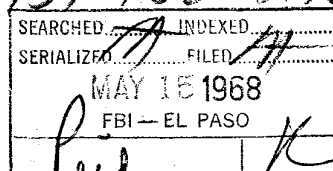
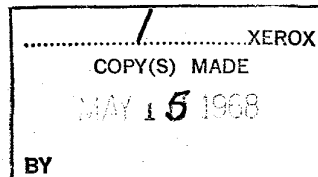

Other Offices receiving copies of this airtel were not furnished rerep and so the following background information is being set forth to assist these Offices in conducting the requested investigation:

Investigation has determined that the subject, using the name of ERIC GALT, left Los Angeles, Calif., on 12/15/67, driving his Mustang automobile, in the company of CHARLES J. STEIN, of Los Angeles. STEIN had formerly been a resident of New Orleans and the alleged purpose of this trip was for STEIN to pick up two children of his sister's who were residing in New Orleans and return them to California. According to STEIN, they arrived in New Orleans on 12/17/67 and left New Orleans on 12/19/67. STEIN stayed with relatives and investigation has determined that subject registered at the Provincial Motel, 1024 Chartres Street, New Orleans, on 12/17/67 as ERIC S. GALT and was assigned room 126. The registration card indicated GALT's automobile to be a Mustang bearing Alabama license 1-38993 and his address as 2608 Highland Avenue, Birmingham, Ala. The subject, as GALT, stayed at the motel until 12/19/67 when he checked out.

Interviews of motel employees in regards to the subject have been negative in that they cannot recall him.

There is set forth under a caption for each Office the identity or identities of persons staying at the Provincial Motel from 12/17 through 19/67. The identities of these persons were obtained from the motel registration cards as well as other information which is set forth under the name. The date listed under each name is the date the individual or individuals stayed at the motel. Each Office should locate and interview these individuals for any knowledge or contact they may have had with the subject. Various photographs of JAMES EARL RAY, which have been furnished to all Offices, should be displayed to these individuals to ascertain if they recall RAY.

In order to ~~assist~~ assist Memphis, the Office of Origin in this matter, each Office should set forth the results of this investigation in report form with copies of the reports designated for the Bureau and Memphis.

King Killing Wasn't Plot, Says Clark

United Press International

WASHINGTON, May 13. — The government, pressing one of the biggest manhunts in history, has rejected the theory that Dr. Martin Luther King's assassin was a heirling of conspirators.

Atty. Gen. Ramsey Clark, who heads the government forces looking for King's killer, also says he believes the prime suspect in the slaying—escaped convict James Earl Ray—is still alive and will be captured.

Clark said:

"Our evidence indicates a man acting alone. This does not negate other theories. It would be impossible to rule out a conspiracy of the right or the left or the middle or any other type of conspiracy. But at this time, our evidence is that this man was acting alone."

On 5/14/68, WILLIAM SULLIVAN, Naval Investigative Service Office, El Paso, Texas, advised that his office had just received a communication from his headquarters which stated that the FBI had requested the assistance of the Naval Intelligence Command in furnishing any information regarding JAMES EARL RAY to the FBI immediately. The communication added that if the local FBI should request the assistance of the Naval Investigative Service Office, that they should furnish any assistance requested and so advise their headquarters in New Orleans of the request.

Mr. SULLIVAN stated that he wished to offer the services of his office in El Paso to the El Paso FBI Office and to advise this office that he would be more than happy to cooperate in any way that he could. Mr. SULLIVAN added that in the event any information should come to his attention regarding RAY, he would, of course, immediately furnish it to the El Paso Office of the FBI.
