Information was received from the New Orleans Office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation that Mrs. HENRY J. SHERRILL, 301 Woodland Avenue, Mobile, Alabama, had registered on December 17, 1967 at the Provincial Hotel, 1024 Chartres Street, New Orleans, Louisiana.

AT MOBILE, ALABAMA:

On May 10, 1968, Mr. ELMORE SONNIER, 301 Woodland Avenue, Mobile, advised that his daughter and son-in-law, Captain and Mrs. HENRY J. SHERRILL, stayed at the Provincial Hotel in New Orleans during December, 1967, and were currently residing at 2500 Nations Avenue, El Paso, Texas.

AT EL PASO, TEXAS:

The following investigation was conducted by SA PAUL S. PULLEN:

After viewing a photograph of subject JAMES EARL RAY, they advised that they did not recall seeing anyone who resembled RAY during the time that they stayed at the Provincial Hotel.

RE TELEPHONE CALLS BY JAMES EARL RAY BETWEEN LOS ANGELES AND NEW ORLEANS.

San Antonio airtel to the Director dated 5/21/68(See serial 318) set a lead out regarding a telephone call made on 12/16/67 from telephone number 278-9093 to telephone number 915-598-2010, El Paso, Texas.

The El Paso crisscross directory lists 598-2010 to PAUL WATSON, 419 St. Marys Drive, El Paso.

On 5/24/68, Mr. PAUL WATSON, mentioned above, advised that his in-laws made a trip from Houston, Texas, to Ed Paso, Texas, in the middle of December, 1967, and that, while enroute, they ran into some bad weather. He said they made a long distance call from somewhere along the route and that this telephone call was undoubtedly the call mentioned above.

Mr. WATSON was displayed photographs of JAMES EARL RAY, at which time he said he had never had any contact, either direct or indirect, with RAY and did not know him.

Noted that photographs of WALTER TERRY RIFE, FBI #455 876 6, were furnished to all offices and were disseminated to other law enforcement agencies in the El Paso Division. RIFE was an associate in crime along with JAMES EARL RAY in the 1950's and the Bureau was interested in locating RIFE to interview him regarding this matter.

The Kansas City Office has advised that WALTER TERRY RIFE has been located and interviewed. Therefore, there is no reason for continued efforts to be on the alert for RIFE.

All Agents are requested to return the photographs of RIFE to the CCO. In addition, all Agents in contact with law enforcement agencies should advise these agencies that the FBI is no longer interested in locating RIFE.


