The following investigation was conducted on
4/5/68 at Columbus, Mississippi, by SA's BRENT W. WARBERG
and LAWRENCE W. GORMAN:

TOMMY HARROLSON, manager and owner, G and H
Liggett Rexall Drugstore, gave the following information:

HARROLSON stated that cash-register receipts
for cash purchases made in his drugstore are automatically
dated by the cash register. He stated that each cash-
register receipt carries the title

G & H
Rexall Drug
Columbus, Miss.

Following this heading is the date of the purchase and
below the date of the purchase is the amount of the pur-
chase.

He stated that each cash-register receipt has
a number; however, these numbers are immaterial to the
business of his store. He stated when the numbers reach
a level which he thinks is high he flips a switch on the
cash register and the numbers start over. Therefore, the
numbers mean nothing and no information concerning the
accounting procedures of the store is filed by these
numbers.

HARROLSON continued that the only other tickets handled by his drugstore are charge tickets, which carry the name G. & H. Liggett Rexall Drugstore, Columbus, Miss. He stated that the date has to be written in by a clerk and the numbers on these receipts go only to 50.

HARROLSON stated that his drugstore does put price tags on some articles. He stated that these price tags are labeled Liggett Rexall, and then the price of the article is written on the price tag and the price tag is put on the article.

He stated sacks in which merchandise is placed do not carry the name of his drugstore. He stated the only other label used by his drugstore is the label which is put on prescriptions and these contain the name G & H Rexall Drugs, Columbus, Mississippi; however, these are not placed on toilet articles.

HARROLSON continued that Liggett Rexall Drugs is a chain operation throughout the South. He stated his drugstore is the only Liggett Rexall Drugs in the state of Mississippi; however, other Liggett Drugs are predominant in Alabama, Georgia, and Florida.

HARROLSON was given a description of the unknown subject, and he stated he could not recall having sold any Head and Shoulders shampoo or Palmolive Rapid Shave to any individual answering this description.

SONNY SMITH, clerk, G & H Liggett Rexall Drug Company, stated he could not recall selling any articles to an individual answering the description of the unknown subject.

A female clerk is also employed in this store; however, she was presently at lunch and she will be contacted when she arrives back at the store.

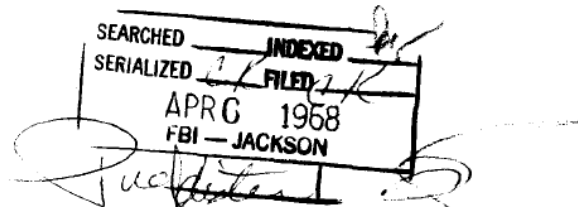

At 9:15 PM, 4-4-68, the Agent observed that the car of L. E. MATTHEWS, JR., was not at his home at RFD Florence, Miss. Two pickup trucks, believed to belong to MATTHEWS, were parked at the house, but no automobiles were observed on the premises.

An earlier telephone call to the home of MATTHEWS girl friend, ELAINE SMITH, reflected she was not at home and was not expected until later in the evening. Information previously received reflected that MATTHEWS planned to see his girl friend on the evening of 4-4-68.

At 10:10 PM a telephone call to MATTHEWS residence was answered by a person believed to be his son, who advised that MATTHEWS was not at home, but was expected shortly. The person said that MATTHEWS had been at home during the early part of the evening. It will be noted that information was received by SA KEUTZER on the evening of 4-4-68, that MATTHEWS was at home between six and seven PM.

BILLY CARR, rear of 601 East Leake Street, Clinton, Miss., was contacted at 11:10 PM, 4-4-68, and advised he was in the Clinton area during the afternoon of 4-4-68, had dinner during the early evening, and had been at his home the rest of the evening.

A telephone call to the residence of JAMES M. HOWARD, 2882 Terry Road, Jackson, Miss., telephone #372-8430, was answered by MIKE HOWARD, who advised that CHARLES ROBERT GREENE does not reside at that address, but visits there from time to time. HOWARD said GREENE never spends the night at that address. HOWARD said he did not know the whereabouts of GREENE, had not seen him during the evening, and had no idea where he might be contacted. He said he does not know where GREENE lives.

LEAD:

Contact CHARLES GREENE at McPHAIL'S Gulf Service Station, West Capitol and Ellis Avenue, and ascertain his whereabouts during the pertinent period of 4-4-68. Also definitely ascertain his present residence address.

PETER STATED HE HAS BEEN A MEMBER FOR THREE YEARS OF THE NATIONAL
CIVIL RIGHTS ADVISORY COMMITTEE, WHICH IS HEADED BY SECRETARY OF
AGRICULTURE ORVILLE FREEMAN. THE COMMITTEE HAS FIFTEEN MEMBERS COMPOSED
CHIEFLY OF VARIOUS COLLEGE PRESIDENTS AND REPUTABLE INDIVIDUALS, BOTH
NEGRO AND WHITE. THE COMMITTEE WHICH MEETS FOUR TIMES A YEAR IN
VARIOUS LOCALES, TAKES TESTIMONY MAINLY FROM VARIOUS CIVIL RIGHTS
LEADERS, WELFARE PEOPLE, AND THOSE PEOPLE INVOLVED IN THE EQUAL
OPPORTUNITIES PROGRAM.

ACCORDING TO PETER, A SOURCE WHOM HE DID NOT WISH TO IDENTIFY BUT
WHO ACCORDING TO PETER, IS ABSOLUTELY RELIABLE, ADVISED THAT ON THURSDAY
PRIOR TO THE RECENT ELECTIONS HELD IN MISSISSIPPI IN WHICH NEGRO NAACP

LEADER CHARLES EVERS WAS A CANDIDATE FOR NATIONAL OFFICE, A ROMAN CATHOLIC PRIEST IN LOUISIANA, NOT FURTHER IDENTIFIED, RECEIVED A CONFESSION FROM A YOUNG WHITE MALE THAT A GROUP OF INDIVIDUALS HAD GIVEN THIS PERSON TWENTYFIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS TO ASSASSINATE EVERS. ACCORDING TO PETER, THE PRIEST WAS TORN BETWEEN HIS LOYALTY AND DUTY TO THE CHURCH TO MAINTAIN THIS INFORMATION IN STRICTEST CONFIDENCE OR TO TAKE THIS INFORMATION TO THE PROPER OFFICIALS IN ORDER TO POSSIBLY AVERT THIS ASSASSINATION ATTEMPT. PETER STATED IT WAS RESOLVED TO MAKE THIS INFORMATION KNOWN AND HE BELIEVES THAT BOTH EVERS AND THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES IN MISSISSIPPI WERE NOTIFIED.

PETER ADVISED THAT FATHER LOUIS TOOMEY, PRESIDENT, LOYOLA UNIVERSITY OF THE SOUTH, NEW ORLEANS, AND ONE AARON HENRY, NEGRO DRUGGIST, CLARKSDALE, MISS., BOTH OF WHOM ARE MEMBERS OF THE COMMITTEE, ARE AWARE OF THIS PLOT AND SHOULD KNOW THE IDENTITY OF THE PRIEST INVOLVED. ACCORDING TO PETER, HENRY IS THE LEADER OF THE NAACP IN CLARKSDALE.

PETER STATED HE BELIEVES EITHER PERSON WOULD BE RECEPTIVE TO INTERVIEW, HOWEVER, SUCH INTERVIEW SHOULD BE MOST CIRCUMSPECT SINCE THIS INVOLVED A BREACH OF PRIEST AND WORSHIPER RELATIONSHIP SINCE THE INFORMATION WAS OSTENSIBLY OBTAINED BY THE PRIEST IN THE FORM OF A CONFESSION DURING A CONFESSIONAL PERIOD.

PETER ADVISED HE DOES NOT KNOW IF THIS REPORTED PLOT HAS ANY CONNECTION WITH THE MARTIN LUTHER KING ASSASSINATION, BUT HE FELT THAT THIS COULD BE A POSSIBILITY AND SHOULD BE REPORTED TO THE FBI.

PETER STATED IN THE EVENT HE RECEIVES ANY ADDITIONAL INFORMATION, HE WOULD IMMEDIATELY CONTACT THE OCALA RESIDENT AGENCY AND MAKE THIS KNOWN.

JACKSON AT CLARKSDALE, MISS., DETERMINE IF INFORMATION CONCERNING THE PLOT ON THE LIFE OF CHARLES EVERS WAS MADE KNOWN TO LOCAL AUTHORITIES. IF NOT AND IF NO REASON EXISTS NOT TO CONTACT AARON HENRY, JACKSON SHOULD INTERVIEW HIM FOR PERTINENT DETAILS CONCERNING THE INFORMATION FURNISHED BY EMMETT PETER AND THEN ADVISE NEW ORLEANS WHETHER OR NOT FATHER TOOMEY SHOULD BE INTERVIEWED CONCERNING THIS MATTER.

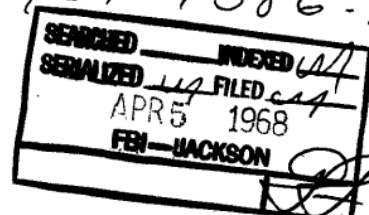

WILLIE JAMES BURNS, Route 2, Box 141, Tchula, Miss., who operates a country store two miles south of Mileston, Miss., in Holmes County, telephonically contacted the FBI Office, Jackson, Miss., on 4/5/68 and advised SA SAMUEL N. JENNINGS as follows:

BURNS stated that two unidentified white men, driving an old model medium green Plymouth sedan, 1968 Miss. license H-22212, stopped at Mileston, Miss., about 11:30 A.M. today, 4/5/68, and attempted to trade a large sledge hammer for a tank of gasoline. They were not successful and drove on two miles south to BURNS' store where they attempted to trade this sledge hammer to BURNS' wife for ten gallons of gasoline. They were unsuccessful and drove on to the service station of JOHN LIBERTO, Thornton, Miss., where they were successful in trading the sledge hammer to LIBERTO for some gas for their car. They continued driving south on Highway 49 East toward Yazoo City.

BURNS advised these two white men acted very suspicious and he believes they could have something to do with the assassination of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING. He could furnish nothing specific to tie them in with the assassination however.

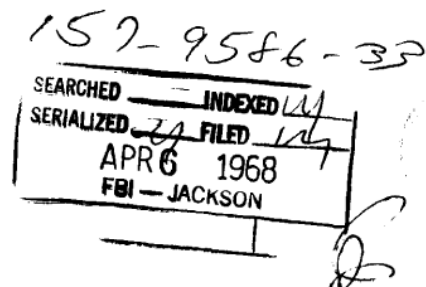

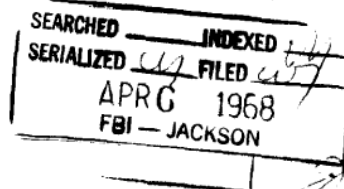
