Chief PIERCE stated that JOHN PIERCE told him that the call seemed to be a local call.

Chief PIERCE stated that he had talked to Mayor THOMPSON about this matter, and he was furnishing him with protection.

Jackson indices were checked, and found to be negative concerning JOHN KIMBROUGH.

CHARLES MARX, Administrative Assistant,
MHSP, Jackson, Miss., was contacted later on this date
and asked the writer if he had heard about this threat
to Mayor THOMPSON. MARX then stated that the MHSP
had a fingerprint card on JOHN ELLIS KIMBROUGH, date
of birth who was admitted to Whitfield State
Mental Hospital on 4/7/59 from Union, Mississippi.
MARX stated that he could not tell from his fingerprint
card if this individual was still in the mental
institution.

MYRTLE CALDWELL, 319 Lynn Street, Clarksdale, Mississippi, registration clerk, Downtowner Motor Inn, Clarksdale, furnished the following information:

She recalled that she registered a guest using the name BILLY RAY KING in room 225 at the Downtowner Motor Inn, Clarksdale, at about 10:12 PM on April 4, 1968. She recalled that he paid for the room, cash in advance, in the amount of \$7.84. He claimed to be from Lake Providence, Louisiana.

He claimed that he had been put off the bus at Clarksdale and that he was trying to meet a boat. He did not say where he was to meet the boat. He stated that buses were not being allowed to enter Memphis, Tennessee.

Just after he registered he placed a long-distance collect telephone call through the pay telephone located in the lobby of the motel. He advised her that he was expecting the party whom he called to return his call. He did receive a long-distance person-to-person call shortly thereafter in his room, before 11:00 PM.

She described KING as a white male, in his twenties, six feet tall or slightly taller, 170 pounds, slender or medium build, dark hair, wearing a light shirt, open at the neck and several buttons open, exposing a portion of his chest and revealing no undershirt.

She stated that KING was a stranger to her, and she did not know of anyone who visited him in his room. She went off duty at 11:00 PM and stayed at the motel until midnight.

He did not observe KING leave the motel, and KING did not check out at the desk while PITTS was on duty. He did not observe a blue Mustang with Louisiana license in the vicinity of the motel during the above period. He added that Room 225 is in the rear of the motel and is not visible from the lobby.

The Bureau has furnished above caption for the Civil Rights investigation to identify person or persons responsible for the assassination of MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., in Memphis, Tenn., on 4/4/68. Code name to remain confidential and not disseminated as a code name for this investigation.

### BACKGROUND

Alleged murder weapon described as 30.06 Game Master, Remington Model 760 Pump, with Redfield Scope, has been traced to Birmingham, Ala. Gun was purchased on 3/30/68, from Weberly-Thomas Hardware, Birmingham, by one HARVEY LOWMEYER who furnished address, but investigation has proven address in Birmingham fictitious. Clerk who sold gun described unknown subject as age 36, 5'8", 150-170 pounds, dark brown hair, ruddy complexion, well dressed in dark business suit. Clerk described unsub as meek and shy. No information re car unsub could have been traveling in.

Unsub was seen running out of rooming house described as a flophouse directly across from Lorraine Hotel where KING was residing. He dropped a blanket which was carrying a small overnight case and a box containing above described gun. Person seen running from flophouse was described as white male between 20-40, 5'11" to 6', 170-200 pounds, dark hair combed straight back, very neat, well dressed in dark suit.

Above gun is at FBI Laboratory for test.

Unsub purchased pair of binoculars at York's,

### CONFIDENTIAL

The foregoing information should be treated highly confidential. The Latent Fingerprint Section, FBI Identification Division, developed latent fingerprints on the above-described rifle and binoculars. The latents on the binoculars are identical with latents on the rifle. Additionally, five latents were developed on toilet articles.

The Bureau has advised that all investigation must be handled under the personal direction of the SAC. Leads are to be afforded immediate, thorough, imaginative attention. All possibilities must be exhausted from any leads developed as any one lead could result in the solution of this most important investigation. SAC will be held personally responsible for failure to promptly, thoroughly handle investigation in this matter.

In event any data developed re suspects, if interested offices can establish whereabouts of suspects between the period March 29-30 in Birmingham, Ala. (purchase of rifle) and April 4, 1968, in Memphis, Tenn. (date of assassination), this may eliminate suspects. If this cannot be done, efforts should be made to secure photographs of suspects in question and forward photographs to Memphis and Birmingham for possible elimination.

Pertinent descriptive data should be included on all photographs.

If unable to eliminate on basis of established whereabouts in pertinent periods, interested offices should make every effort to secure fingerprints of suspects and submit same to Bureau for elimination.
