On this date ETHEL SCOTT, 61 Willow Avenue, Hempstead, NY, telephonically contacted Hempstead, NY, Police Department and advised that she had seen artist's conception of unknown subject and she felt quite certain that unknown subject was identical with an individual for whom she had previously worked in Marks, Mississippi.

SCOTT, upon interview, advised that between 1962 and 1965 she was employed as a maid for one JOE BARYS (PH), address unknown, Marks, Mississippi. She stated that 4/18/68 edition of Jet Magazine contained photograph of artist's conception of unknown subject, and she believes that photograph closely resembles BARYS mentioned above.

Miss SCOTT stated that BARYS during period 1962-65 was employed as a Mississippi highway patrolman and worked out of courthouse, Marks, Mississippi. She described BARYS as follows:





MR. CLAUDE BROWN, CAPE MAY, NJ, TELEPHONICALLY ADVISED TODAY THAT HE IS FORMER SALES MGR. FOR US OVERSEAS AIRLINES WHICH WAS FORMERLY BASED AT CAPE MAY BEFORE CEASING OPERATIONS ABOUT THREE YEARS AGO. HE STATED THE COMPANY HAD A SECURITY OFFICER BY THE NAME OF REX ARMSTEAD WHO WAS FROM MISS. AND WAS A VIOLENT RACIST. SUSPECT HAD BEEN A DEPUTY SHERIFF IN MISS. 


