Source advised on 4/17/68, that SAM BOWERS continues to frequent John's Cafe, Laurel, Miss. Source advised that BOWERS was in John's Cafe on the evening of 4/16/68, talking to an individual unknown to the source.

On 4/24/68, source advised as follows re SAM BOWERS and DEAVOURS NIX meeting with two unknown individuals on the night before the assassination of MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR.:

Source stated that these two individuals, described as: 1) 6'2" to 6'4" tall, 45-50 years old, heavy set, bald headed, light tan summer suit, no glasses or hat, 2) 5'9" to 5'10" tall, 35 years old, stocky build, wearing gray sport clothes, were at John's Cafe at approximately 8:30 p.m. Source stated they stayed approximately one hour and spent most of their time in DEAVOURS NIX's office. Source stated that at one point, individual number two sat in a booth in front of the cafe with SAM BOWERS and BOWERS made the comment to him, "You are the only one that has enough sense to do this."

Source viewed a photo of L. E. MATTHEWS and advised that he was identical with individual number one. Source was shown numerous photos of klansmen known to associate with L. E. MATTHEWS from the Jackson area but advised none of them were identical with individual number two.

Source also advised individual number two was not identical with BILLY CARR.

Source advised that at no time was a weapon ever displayed nor did either of the individuals enter or leave with a package. Source advised he did not observe the vehicle the two individuals came in.

Source advised that the following are the cooks at John's Cafe during the evening shift and all are Negroes:

MINNIE BLACKWELL  
LELA MIMS  
FLORASTINE POSEY

Source advised that there are two Negro female cooks working during the day, names unknown.

Source advised that on the night of 4/3/68, any one of the following waitresses could have been working:

now employed by the Seafood Cafe next to  
the Delmar Motel  
BETTY CARROLL, approximately 18 years old, who

Reference is made to Jackson letterhead memorandum dated April 15, 1968.

Aaron E. Henry, President of the Mississippi NAACP, advised a Special Agent of the FBI on April 30, 1968, that he had not had any further contact with W. O. Dismuke, who last contacted him telephonically on April 13, 1968. He also advised that he has not had any contact with Theodore Allison Carr and there has been no evidence that Carr was attempting to intimidate Mr. Henry in any manner. He further advised that he did not consider Dismuke's call a threat but a reminder to be cautious in view of the recent murder of Martin Luther King.
