On 5/13/68, Mr. K. D. KAAZ,/Schlumberger Oil Field Equipment Company, advised that he does not know JAMES EARL RAY and has never received any calls from any person he does not know. He said that he was transferred to Laurel during the early part of February 1968, and his first phone was 428-8829. This number was formerly listed to WESLEY ARNOLD and the phone was ringing all times of the day and night. He had this phone changed and now has number 425-2226.

Mr. ARNOLD related that during the period of November and December 1967 he and his wife were having trouble and she was in Houston, Texas with her brother at 8602 Rayson Street. This address is just off Interstate 10 and is in a residential and sub shopping district. He recalls that his wife called him on or about 12/17/68 from Houston and he feels that she called collect. He does not recall receiving any other calls from Houston around this date.

Mr. ARNOLD states that he does not know any JAMES EARL RAY, JOHN WILLARD. HARVEY LOWMYER, HARVEY LOWMYER or ERIC STARVO GALT.

The following investigation was conducted by SA FRANCIS G. HONAN:

Mrs. A. D. (MARY IOU) CROMEANS, Route 2, Fulton, Mississippi, age thirty-seven years old, was advised of the nature of the inquiry and the identity of the interviewing Agent. She advised that concerning a conversation between herself and Mrs. JEAN BRITT EVANS, Houston, Mississippi, that she, CROMEANS, told Mrs. EVANS that on May 6, 1968, she made a telephone call from her residence in Fulton, Mississippi, to the residence of W. C. E. JOHNSON, Old Saltillo Road, Tupelo, Mississippi, telephone number 842-7879 to ascertain if CONSTANCE LAKE EVANS was at the residence.

Mrs. CROMEANS stated that she had left a painting with EVANS, while EVANS resided at the JOHNSON residence, and she wanted to pick up the painting, however, did not want to pick it up when EVANS was there.

Mrs. CROMEANS stated that when she telephoned the residence a male answered the phone and she (Mrs. CROMEANS) asked this individual who was speaking and this individual said "STAVO" or some similar name. Mrs. CROMEANS stated that she asked this individual again who was speaking and he stated it was "STAVO" or some similar name, however, continued that he was speaking from the JOHNSONS residence. Mrs. CROMEANS stated that she asked this individual if Mr. EVANS was there and this individual stated that EVANS had not been there in a week or two. Mrs. CROMEANS stated that she then hung up the telephone.

Mrs. CROMEANS stated that in thinking over the conversation and the names "STAVO", she stated that she had heard this name sometime in the past and after deep thinking connected this name with ERIC STARVO GALT, being

sought in the murder of Doctor MARTIN LUTHER KING.

Mrs. CROMEANS further stated that in reference to her association with CONSTANCE LAKE EVANS, that she first met EVANS approximately May of 1967, when she took her daughter to Mr. EVANS' residence, who is approximately sixty-eight years old, and is an art teacher, for art lessons for her daughter. Mrs. CROMEANS stated that on August 16, 1967, she together with Mr. EVANS left the Tupelo, Mississippi, area together, and went to Albuquerque, New Mexico, where she sat up housekeeping with EVANS. Mrs. CROMEANS stated that she came back home to her husband on November 1, 1967, and that EVANS followed her. She stated that since that time she has seen EVANS on two occasions, however, has had no association with him.

Mrs. CROMEANS stated that approximately one month ago EVANS told her that he had inherited \$40,000 from the death of a brother of his in Memphis, Tennessee, however, Mrs. CROMEANS stated that she has never seen this \$40,000.

Mrs. CROMEANS stated that during her association with EVANS in Albuquerque, New Mexico, he described himself as a religious person and continually handed out religious pamphlets and she had noticed that in the back of these pamphlets was stamped "INTERNATIONAL BUSINESSMAN'S ASSOCIATION". Mrs. CROMEANS stated that on numerous occasions EVANS told her that he was a businessman, however, she described him as a real confidence man and ""a real operator". Mrs. CROMEANS stated that she had heard that EVANS was a dope addict, however, she had no personal knowledge of that. She stated that EVANS consumed a lot of alcoholic beverages during her association with him.

Mrs. CROMEANS stated that she has read numerous articles in the newspaper concerning JAMES EARL RAY, also known as Eric Starvo Galt, and in particular mentioned one article concerning RAY making a statement in jail to the effect that if a group of businessmen were offering @

one million dollars for the assassination of Doctor KING that he would be interested in this.

Mrs. CROMEANS stated that the statement EVANS made about being a businessman and also the religious pamphlets bearing the stamp "INTERNATIONAL BUSINESSMEN'S ASSOCIATION" together with her telephone call to the JOHNSON residence at which time an individual answered giving his name as STAVO or some similar name, Mrs. CROMEANS suspects that possibly JAMES EARL RAY may be hiding out at the JOHNSON residence.

At this point Mrs. CROMEANS stated that she has a vague imagination, admitted seeking psychiatric treatment in Tupelo, Mississippi, as the result of her association with EVANS.

Mrs. CROMEANS was shown a photograph of JAMES EARL RAY and she advised that she has never seen this individual.

At the conclusion of the interview, Mrs. CROMEANS made inquiry about the \$40,000 reward being offered for information concerning the whereabouts of RAY and she wanted to know if RAY was caught whether she would receive the reward.

BLAYLOCK was advised that he did not have to furnish any information, that any information furnished by him could be used against him in a court of law, and that he was entitled to consult an attorney or anyone else prior to furnishing any information, by SA JAMES F. BODMAN, JR.

BLAYLOCK, who was interviewed at the Travel Inn Motel, advised as follows:

He formerly operated the Candlelite Lounge, Highway 82 West, Winona, Mississippi, during June and July, 1967. BLAYLOCK advised that he recalls an individual by the name of J. W. ROGERS, who is from and resides in the Winona area, coming into the lounge just about every day during June and July, 1967.

BLAYLOCK stated that ROGERS, who "got drunk every day," would after getting drunk boast that he would pay \$100,000 to anyone who would kill Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. BLAYLOCK stated that no one paid any serious attention to ROGERS, as ROGERS seldom had enough money to pay for his own drinks.

BLAYLOCK stated that ROGERS and his drinking became such a problem that he stopped ROGERS from coming into his place of business.

BLAYLOCK stated that he has never heard of anyone from the state of Florida offering \$100,000 to have Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING killed. He said that the

The following investigation was conducted by SA WILLIAM P. LAWLER on May 23, 1968, at Walls, Mississippi:

GLORIA VAUGHN was interviewed in an attempt to determine the identity of an unknown white man who had made the statement to the Reverend JAMES M. KOACH in the Country Boy Drop-In Restaurant to the effect "Nigger, we could kill you all just like we did MARTIN LUTHER KING."

GLORIA VAUGHN stated that their trade at the Country Boy Drop-In Restaurant consists primarily of transient individuals, and that although she does recall there were two white men sitting in back of Reverend ROACH, she does not recall ever having seen these two individuals before. VAUGHN stated that they had been drinking beer for about one hour, but she has no idea who they are or if she would recognize them were she to see them again.

GENE VAUGHN, the owner of the Country Boy Drop-In Restaurant, was interviewed in an attempt to determine the identity of an unknown white man who had made a statement to the Reverend JAMES M. ROACH to the effect "Nigger, we could kill you all just like we did MARTIN LUTHER KING."

CARL MURPHY, JR:

The following investigation was conducted by SA JOHN S. CASTLES at Tupelo, Mississippi, on the dates indicated:

On May 13, 1968, SAM H. ALLEN, JR., Consultant, City of Tupelo, advised that he is not acquainted with ROBERT WAYNE PHILLIPS. He stated that he is acquainted with CARL MURPHY, JR., and knows that MURPHY is a bootlegger and/a "hoodlum" in the Tupelo, Mississippi, area.

On May 13, 1968, MITCHELL MC WHIRTER, Officer, Mississippi/Highway Safety Patrol, Tupelø, Mississippi, advised that he is acquainted with ROBERT WAYNE PHILLIPS. whom he knew as BOB PHILLIPS. He stated that he has not seen PHILLIPS for a number of months but knows that PHILLIPS formerly operated a place known as Bob's Fish House near Shannon, Mississippi, for a Mr. SLOAN. He said to his knowledge PHILLIPS never owned a place by himself, and in his opinion was not capable of operating any place on his own. He said in his opinion PHILLIPS is a "no good" individual who will work for anyone who will pay him a few dollars. He said he had never heard and has no knowledge that PHILLIPS was ever employed or associated with CARL MURPHY, JR.

On May 13, 1968, Mrs. JOAN EDWARDS, Secretary, Credit Bureau of Tupelo, Mississippi, advised SA DONALD H. GREENE that credit/bureau records reveal that ROBERT WAYNE PHILLIPS, a white male, born May 5, 1935, at Belden, Mississippi, is 6 feet 1 inch tall, weight 185 pounds, is a dirty blond who was blue eyes and at one time was married to BETTY CANNON, Route 2, Shannon, Mississippi. She said at one time he had a mailing address of Box 181, Shannon, Mississippi, and his father, who is now deceased, file and (Memo), styled of Indul as marked was named HARVEY PHILLIPS.

Mrs. EDWARDS said that records indicate that at one time PHILLIPS dealt in illegal liquor traffic and operated Bob's Fish House in 1965 and was formerly employed by a RUSSELL PATTERSON, and in 1966 was arrested for assault and battery for shooting at his wife. She said records indicate that his mother is JETTIE L. KEY, Route 1, Guntown, Miss., and that a relative is BETTY JOE MEEK, Route 2, Baldwyn, Miss.

Mrs. EDWARDS said that records indicate that PHILLIPS' former wife is currently residing in the Brewer Community of Lee Co., Miss., with her father, ERSKINE LOWERY. She also said that the last information that the credit bureau had concerning PHILLIPS was certain information that a car which was registered in his name was located abandoned on 3/10/66, in Dallas, Texas.

On 5/14/68, CARL MURPHY, JR., was interviewed by SA JOHN S. CASTLES and SA DONALD H. GREENE at his residence located on Highway 78 West, between Belden, Miss., and Sherman, Miss.

MURPHY advised that he has no information concerning the identity of the murderer of MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., and has never made any comment that he knew who the killer was and has never offered anyone any amount of money to "take care of KING". MURPHY further stated that he is not acquainted with anyone by the name of JAMES EARL RAY and has never been in any jail or penitentiary with anyone by that name.

MURPHY further said that he is not now and has never been associated with any Ku Klux Klan group and has never met ROBERT SHELTON of Tuscaloosa, Ala., who he understands to be a Klan leader. He stated that he is still engaged in some illegal liquor traffic and currently operates a night club known as the Ranch House, located just off Highway 78 near Sherman, Miss.

The following investigation was conducted by SA ROBERT P. WOMACK on May 13, 1968, to determine who and under what circumstances a call from Houston, Texas, on December 15, 1967, pay phone 453-9611, to Seminary, Mississippi, phone 722-4497, was made. It was determined that this phone number was assigned to FAIRLEY INGRAM, Ingram's Store on State Highway 590, approximately four miles west of the Covington - Jones County line.

Mrs. FAIRLEY INGRAM reported that her husband was ill. She advised after questions asked as follows:

JIM KNOTTS, a resident of their neighborhood, had for many years been employed on boats and land for Morrison's Construction Company, located at 12714 Market Street, Houston, Texas. He and his wife had been divorced for years and some of his relatives, including WILLY KNOTTS, had also worked for the same company with him.

In late November or early December, 1967, a nephew of JAMES and WILLY KNOTTS had died and a number of telephone calls were made from Texas to her phone asking that they speak with members of the family. Also, JIM KNOTTS often called and talked with her, finding out how members of his family were and to advise her if he wanted his mail forwarded to a different address. She did not know for certain what occasioned the call on December 15, 1967, but was positive it would be related to the KNOTTS family.

She stated after viewing a photograph of JAMES EARL RAY, she had never seen the person depicted thereon and did not know anyone by the name of JAMES EARL RAY.

Re Miami teletype to the Bureau, 8/2/68, setting forth information to Miami by WILLIAM SOMERSETT concerning MARGARET CAPOMACCHIA.

Mobile was requested to be alert as to activities of SIDNEY C. BARNES who reportedly was leaving for Jackson, Miss., 8/2/68.

SIDNEY CROCKETTE BARNES, 1379 East Rivera Drive, Mobile, Ala., is a bombing suspect of the Mobile Office and his activity has been covered in the past month by four different neighborhood sources. No information has been reported by these sources to indicate that BARNES was away from his residence just prior to or subsequent to the murder of MARTIN LUTHER KING. These sources have furnished no information indicating that THOMAS A. TARRANTS, III or KATHLEEN AINSWORTH had stayed at the BARNES' residence.

In the late afternoon of 8/2/68, neighborhood source, Mrs. MARY LONGCRIER, 1382 East Riviera Drive, telephonically advised that at about 5:20 PM that date she had observed BARNES in his stationwagon which vehicle appeared to be packed as if BARNES was moving from the residence. She did not see Mrs. BARNES on that occasion.
