Re request to verify whereabouts of bombing suspects in the Montgomery, area. Bombing suspects JAMES M. HALL, LEROY LAMAR DUCKER and ROBERT LAWRENCE MERROW, JR., have already been accounted for by SA CARMELO GRAFFAGNINI.

JAMES D. YORK (105-396)

HOUSTON WHITACHER, Letter Carrier, United States Post Office, Wetumpka, Alabama, advised that he is fairly certain that he observed JAMES YORK on 3/29/68. He stated that he definitely recalls seeing him on 4/4/68 inasmuch as he picked up a letter at the mailbox of YORK and had to re-contact him to obtain additional postage for the letter. He stated that this was a letter addressed to the Income Tax Service. He advised that in talking with YORK at that time, he had not indicated that he had made any trips anywhere, and as far as he knows, YORK is not able to drive any extended distance. It is to be noted that YORK does not in any way meet the description of the suspect in the MURKIN case. YORK is a retired city employee, approximately 64 or 65 years of age.

FRED PATTERSON MASSEY (157-69)

On 4/9/68, Mr. R. A. McPHAUL, Division Chief, Alabama Power Company, advised that MOSELEY was employed by the company on 3/29/68 and worked an 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. shift. He stated that MOSELEY was on vacation on April 3 and 4, 1968.

On 4/9/68, SA CARMELO GRAFFAGNINI conducted neighborhood investigation at the residence of MOSELEY which is 1720 West Third Street and of the neighbors contacted, no one could definitely state that they observed MOSELEY on 4/4/68.

On 4/11/68, SA CARMEIO GRAFFAGNINI and SA CLIFFORD A. ROWE, contacted MOSELEY at his residence and MOSELEY stated that he was off on 4/3 and 4/68, but that he did not leave the Montgomery, area. He stated that insofar as his whereabouts were for April 4, 1968, he recalls that he was with a JOYCE TATUM and that the two of them were at the Vogue Steak House on Wetumpka Highway near Gunter Air Base. He stated that he had tried to get TATUM a job at the Vogue Steak House as a waitress and that he talked with the owner who employed her. He stated that he departed the restaurant about 6:20 p.m. and while driving home he heard the announcement of the assassination of KING on his car radio.

He stated that he definitely recalls it as being on Thursday because TATUM worked the first shift on Thursday and again Friday, but did not report for work for him on Saturday. He stated that she only worked the two days which was Thursday and Friday. He stated that as a matter of fact, MOSELEY was also in the restaurant on Friday night and was there for an extended period of time.



Dear Mr. Hoover:

On Sunday afternoon, April 7, a white male was driving north on Interstate 71 in Ohio near the Ashland, Ohio exit. His car had an Alabama license plate 3-34652. The car, a very old model, was palest blue, almost white, with a top almost entirely red rust in color from rust. He attracted my attention when he drove around me with his face covered by his right hand. Very foolishly I followed him for about half an hour at speeds from 70-90 miles per hour. Each time he went around another car he placed his right hand over the right portion of his face, concealing his profile. From his haste and attempt to conceal his identity I had the uncanny feeling that he was in interstate flight and trying to avoid being recognized. Near the bottom of the rear car window were black letters and numbers about $2\frac{1}{2}$ to 3 inches high which said, KKK 2---. I was unable to catch the last three numbers of this four digit series.

On 4/11/68, CARLOR JOHNSON, who identified himself as a S/Sgt. at Gunter AFB, AFSN 44106490, residing at 186 East Salem Dr., Montgomery, Alabama, telephonically advised that he had just had a minor automobile accident with an individual who identified himself as WILLARD N. DEPUTY, JR., 104 Glen Oak Rd., Woodland Park, Wilmington, Delaware. He said this individual was driving a 1967 Chevrolet, which had been rented from the Hertz Drive-It-Yourself Co. at Dannelly Field and bore 1968 Alabama license 3-14047. He said that this individual was staying at the Holiday Inn, Midtown, Montgomery, Ala.

JOHNSON advised that after he arrived home and looked at a photograph which had appeared in the Montgomery paper of the suspect in the Murkin case, he felt that DEPUTY was a good-alike of the suspect. He said the reason for his calling is the fact that DEPUTY in talking with him, was asking questions about the racial situation in and around Montgomery, and how the local people felt about the assassination of MARTIN LUTHER KING. He said that he and DEPUTY made a settlement on the spot, and DEPUTY paid him \$50 for damages to his car.

He described DEPUTY as about 5'9", crewcut, blond hair, wearing sunglasses, appeared to be in his early forties, and weighing about 160-165 pounds. He said DEPUTY indicated he was employed by an aviation corporation out of Delaware. He indicated that he had been stationed at Maxwell AFB at one time. He told JOHNSON that he was in Montgomery on business.

Efforts to locate DEPUTY at the Holiday Inn on the night of 4/11/68 were negative; however, he was contacted the morning of 4/12/68 in room 318, and he advised that he is WILLARD N. DEPUTY, JR. and resides at 104 Glen Oak Rd., Woodland Park, Wilmingnam, Delaware. He stated that he is

He does not resemble the photograph of the individual who appeared in the local Montgomery papers.

He advised that on March 29, 1968, according to his diary, he was in Beaumont, Texas, Memphis, Tenn., and Wilmington, Delaware. He said that on 4/4/68 he was in Houston, Texas. He advised that if necessary to vouch for his whereabouts, Mr. LESTER SINESS, Vice President of Dupont Corp., could vouch for his whereabouts on 3/29/68. and that the co-pilot, JOE PHIELMANN, could account for his whereabouts on 4/4/68.

Inasmuch as the description of DEPUTY does not in any way compare with the description of the suspect, and in view of the fact that he does not resemble in any way the photograph of the suspect appearing in the papers, no further investigation is recommended in this matter at this time.

On 4/1/68, source was contacted, and he advised that he had learned of no activity underway in the Montgomery, Ala, area which would cause, or bring about, any type of racial activity. He said that, from all information he is able to determine, the racial situation in Montgomery, Ala. is rather calm. He advised if he learned of anything he would immediately contact the writer.

On 4/6/68, source advised that he had made some photographs of the picture of the suspect that appeared in the MONTGOMERY ADVERTISER on the morning of 4/6/68, which is an artist's conception, which appeared on the UPI Telephoto Service. These photographs were made available to the writer on the morning of 4/6/68.

On 4/9/68, at about 11:30 A.M., source advised that he had learned that some Magroes had applied for a permit on 4/8/68 to march in Wetumpka, Ala. on 4/9/68. He said that, according to his information, the permit was denied, and there were some indications that the Negroes would try to march anyway. He stated as of the time of his information there had been no activity in Wetumpka regarding any march.

At about 3:00 P.M., the writer checked with Mr. W. L. GLEMM, Postmaster, Wetumpka, Ala., which is located on the square in the city, and he stated there were no marches or demonstrations to his knowledge taking place in Wetumpka; however, he advised that he had heard that a group of Negroes had applied for a permit the day before to march on 4/9/68, but the permit had been denied.
