RE: JOSEPH M. PRITCHETT

On April 11, 1968, GILMER P. STAFFORD, United States Coast Guard, Alexandria, Virginia, advised that he had served in the United States Navy aboard the USS Alan M. Sumner with JOSEPH M. PRITCHETT who was described as 26-27 years of age at present, blond sandy hair, receding hairline, blue or green eyes, 5'9", 160 pounds, oval face and prominent ears. He reportedly is from Montgomery, Alabama. STAFFORD said that he feels that PRITCHETT resembles the artist's conception of the killer of MARTIN LUTHER KING.

On the date of April 13, 1968, the files of the Navy Personnel Records Center, St. Louis, Missouri, reflected that JOSEPH MALLOY PRITCHETT, Navy Serial Number 540-84-40, served on active duty with the United States Navy from November 17, 1959, to August 27, 1963, when honorably discharged. His parents were Mr. and Mrs. JOSEPH A. PRITCHETT, 261 South Boulevard, Montgomery, Alabama.

It is noted that JOSEPH MALLOY PRITCHETT, 261 South Boulevard, Montgomery, Alabama, was interviewed in connection with another matter on August 24, 1964. At that time it was determined that he was employed as a policeman with the Montgomery Police Department. In addition, the following descriptive and background data was obtained on him:

The Montgomery City Directories for the years 1964 to 1968 list only one JOSEPH M. PRITCHETT. The 1964 directory lists JOSEPH M. PRITCHETT, 261 South Boulevard, Montgomery, as being a police officer with the Montgomery Police Department. The 1968 directory lists JOSEPH M. PRITCHETT, 608 Belvedere Street, Montgomery, as being a Trooper, Alabama Highway Patrol.

Major JOHN CLOUD (National Academy), Chief, Alabama Highway Patrol, advised on April 12, 1968, that JOSEPH MALLOY PRITCHETT, 608 Belvedere Street, Montgomery, is still assigned to the Montgomery Station, Alabama Highway Patrol. He further advised that Trooper PRITCHETT was formerly employed by the Montgomery Police Department.

CLOUD stated that his records reflect that PRITCHETT was on duty March 29, 1968, from 3:00 p.m., to 11:00 p.m. and was not on duty March 30, 1968. He was on duty April 4, 1968, from 3:00 p.m. to 12:00 p.m.

On 4/16/68, NORMAN PHIPPS, Montgomery Music Co., Inc., Montgomery, Ala. telephonically advised as follows:

At noon 4/13/68, he was having lunch at Susie's Drive-in, West Fairview Ave., Montgomery, and he observed a white male sitting at the lunch counter who strongly resembled the artists conception drawing of the individual involved in captioned case. This individual was drinking coffee at that time. He appeared to be about 30-34 years old, 5'8", sandy hair, receding hair-line. He also bore a "silly" grin on his face most of the time.

When this individual left the drive-in, he was in a compact car, American make, not further identified, bearing 1968 Alabama license #3-41901.

He has never seen this individual before.

The following investigation was conducted telephonically by the writer at Montgomery, Ala. on same date.:

FRANCES JONES, Motor Vehicle Division, Ala. Dept. of Revenue, advised that 1968 license #3-41901 was issued 11/8/67 to JAMES A. DAVIS, 3702 Duquesne Dr., Montgomery, Ala. for a 1966 Valiant, 4 dr., VIN VH41D62503586.

VESTA GOINS, Driver's License Division, Ala. DPS, advised that she was unable to locate a record for above individual. She stated that a date of birth would be necessary before an accurate check could be completed.

Current Montgomery City Directory reflects that JAMES A. DAVIS, wife DIANA, resides 3702 Duquesne Dr., Montgomery, and that he is employed as sales manager, Kirby Vacuum Cleaner Co.,

On 4/18/68, PHIPPS telephonically advised that he has seen photo of GALT in local newspaper and that the man he observed 4/13/68 does not resemble him. He stated that the man he saw is definitely not identical with GALT.

In view of foregoing, no further investigation being conducted in this regard.

The FBI Laboratory advised that pillowcase and bed sheet were found in trunk of 1966 white Mustang registered to ERIC STARVO GALT, which was located at Atlanta 4/11/68. These items contain Thermo-Seal laundry tapes of approximately same size as tapes on items previously recovered, but are yellow in color and contain code, "20R-3." In opinion of Textile Marking Machine Company, Syracuse, New York, the tapes were produced by a different machine than previous tapes since the first three characters are 15 point type and the last two characters are 18 point type.

The Textile Marking Machine Company suggests the twenty in above code would be the lot number, the R may mean that this was a return of a batch of laundry, and the three is the bundle number.

At about 6 p.m. on 4/4/68, while standing on the second floor balcony outside Room 306 of the Lorraine Motel, 406 Mulberry Street, Memphis, Tennessee, Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. was struck in the right side of the face by a single bullet fired from a 30-06 rifle. The bullet severed KING's spinal cord and death was almost instantaneous.

This investigation, predicated upon a specific request from the Attorney General of the United States, disclosed that the fatal shot had been fired from the bathroom of a cheap rooming house located at 422½ South Main Street, Memphis, which bathroom was located at the rear of the rooming house, and had a window overlooking the Lorraine Motel.

At about 3 p.m. on 4/4/68, an individual using the name JOHN WILLARD had rented Room 5-B in the rooming house at 422½ South Main Street and had paid one week's rent. After hearing the rifle shot at about 6 p.m. on that same day, other tenants in the rooming house observed a man presumably identical with WILLARD, fleeing from the rooming house carrying a large package which was subsequently abandoned by him on the sidewalk in front of the Canipe Amusement Co., 424 South Main Street, Memphis. A neighborhood investigation in the vicinity of 424 South Main Street disclosed that the subject had fled from the scene in a white Mustang.

Found abandoned in front of 424 South Main Street was a 30-06 Remington model 760 rifle which was determined to have been

sold to one HARVEY LOWMEYER on 3/30/68 by Aeromarine Supply Co., Birmingham, Alabama.

Investigation at Memphis disclosed that an individual had purchased a set of binoculars at the York Arms Company in Memphis on 4/4/68. These binoculars were among the material abandoned with the rifle and recovered in Memphis. Also recovered was a brown and green herringbone bedspread. The items abandoned in Memphis were all wrapped in this bedspread. The blue bag which was inside the bedspread contained numerous items, among which were the binoculars and a set of underwear consisting of a T-shirt and shorts. The T-shirt and shorts are those on which appears the laundry mark which has been a matter of interest in this case.

A search of motel records in the Memphis area disclosed that an individual using the name ERIC S. GALT had spent the night of 4/3/68 at the Rebel Motel, Memphis, Tennessee, and was driving a 1966 white Mustang bearing Alabama License 1-38993. Investigation at Birmingham disclosed that this automobile had been purchased by ERIC S. GALT on August 30, 1968, from a private person in response to a newspaper ad. He paid a total of \$1995 cash. While in Birmingham he furnished the address of 2608 South Highland Avenue, Birmingham. This is also the address which appeared on a driver's license issued to him by the State of Alabama. The driver's license identifying data listed his birth date as [redacted], his height as 5'11", his weight as 170 and his eyes blue and hair brown.

The automobile in question, the white Mustang bearing the Alabama tags mentioned above, was recovered in Atlanta on 4/11/68 and determined to have been abandoned there prior to 9 a.m. on 4/5/68.

In connection with the evidence submitted by Atlanta, Birmingham, and Memphis, identifiable latent prints were recovered. It was on the basis of these latents that identification was made of JAMES EARL RAY. In handling future leads, all offices should be particularly interested in securing an identifying number, military, police, or FBI, in connection with suspects so that the necessary check can be made through the Identification Division.

On 4/17/68, AUSA R. MACEY TAYLOR, Birmingham, authorized the filing of a complaint charging ERIC STARVO GALT with a conspiracy to violate Section 241, Title 18, U. S. Code, and

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recommended bond in the amount \$50,000. On that same date, SAC JOSEPH H. GAMBLE filed a complaint before USC MILDRED F. SPRAGUE, Birmingham, and warrant was issued that same date.

A Mystery Wrapped In An Enigma

Eric Galt's Duplicate State Driver License Being Checked

MONTGOMERY, Ala. (AP) — One of the mysteries surrounding the mysterious Eric Starvo Galt concerns his Alabama driver's license. A duplicate license was mailed to him at a Birmingham address at a time when he reportedly was in California.

Records in the driver license division of the state Public Safety Department show the duplicate was mailed March 1,

apparently in response to a telephoned request.

The FBI says Galt, who has been charged with murder and conspiracy in the killing of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., was graduated from a bartender school at Hollywood, Calif., March 2.

Driver's license officials theorized Thursday that Galt telephoned from California to ask for a duplicate permit. The rec-

ords indicate the request came by telephone, four or five days before March 1. There is no known evidence that the former Birmingham resident was away from California at that time.

The department often receives telephoned requests for duplicate license from motorists who have lost theirs. If it appears to be a legitimate request, the practice is to mail the license and ask the motorist to remit 25 cents to cover the cost of issuance.

In Galt's case, the money was received promptly, by mail. A spokesman said there would be no reason to keep a record of where the money was mailed from, and no such record was kept.

Galt's duplicate license apparently was delivered to the Birmingham address, the spokesman said, since it was not returned to the department here. The post office in Birmingham says it has no record of a change of address notice to forward Galt's mail.

The mysterious Galt apparently returned to Birmingham after leaving California, the FBI says. Director J. Edgar Hoover says the man bought a rifle in Birmingham, about March 30.

It is possible that someone else asked for the duplicate license in Galt's name, driver's license officials said, but it is difficult to get one that way.

Before a duplicate is issued, the caller must answer certain
