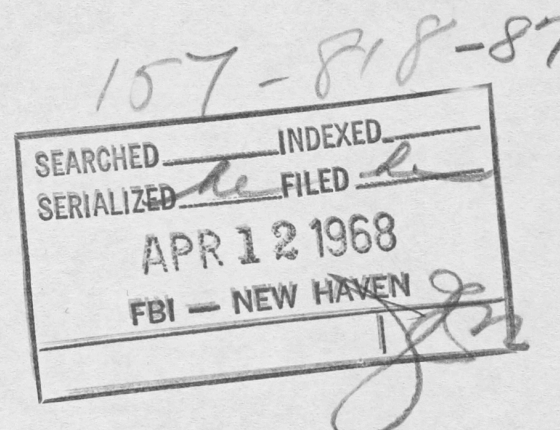

On 4/10/68 Mr. ~~LOWDER~~, 134 Westville rd., Danbury, Conn telephonically contacted Hartford RA and advised that on Sunday 4/7/68 he had occasion to pick up a hitchhiker by the Bear Mountain Bridge, NY. This individual he described as a white male, 150 lbs., 35 years old about 5' 8" tall. He was dressed in a dark olive drab raincoat, dark black shoes, white shirt and was smoking a brand new pipe. He also rolled his own cigarettes. He was carrying a straw colored suitcase with dark edges. He indicated that he was from Tacoma Washington and was going to Binghamton, Vermont. He had a good suntan and said he worked in a restaurant.

In conversation with him he questioned the fact that he came from Tacoma, Washington since he himself is from Virginia and recognized his accent as possibly being from that section of the country. This individual admitted that he had been born in Lynchburg, Virginia. He also asked him why he was going the back road to Vermont since he indicated that he wanted to go to Vermont via route 7 and it appeared he would have a better chance to get rides if he went via interstate route 91 and he replied that he was more familiar with route ~~91~~ 7 since he had gone this way before.

LOWDER advised that he dropped this individual off at a gas station in Danbury, Conn near route 7 about 3:30 or 4 PM on 4/7/68 and he felt this was the man we were looking for for the murder of MARTIN LUTHER KING.

He stated he is employed by the Railway Express, at Hartford, 110 Brainard Road and that he recalls, rather vaguely, a shipment, possibly personal effects, going out of Hartford on the 9:00 PM trailer, last night, 4/11, to a individual named GALT, to either Brooklyn, NY or some other place in New York. DAVIS wasn't sure of the destination in New York and thought the name was GALT, but says another man thought it was SALT.

The records of all outgoing shipments are at REA, 110 Brainard Road, with Mr. DANIEL GOODELL, manager. The place is closed until Monday morning, April 15.

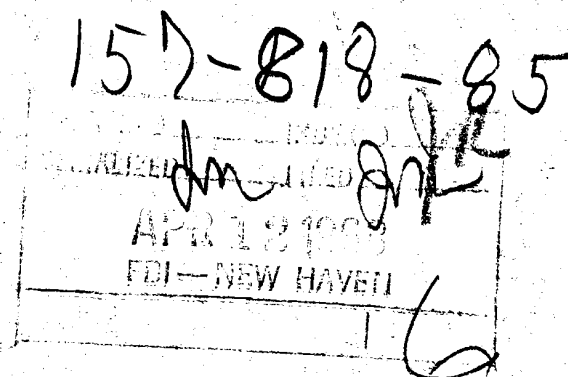

Enclosed for Memphis is one centerfold photograph from the book "The Committee" which contains photograph of ROBERT SHELTON and unknown white male. Also enclosed for Memphis is one copy of an artist's sketch of UNSUB as it appeared in April 11, 1968, issue of "New York Times".

On April 11, 1968, Mrs. WILLIAM SHENTON, Editor, The History Book Club Review, Stamford, Connecticut, advised she had located a photograph of an individual who closely resembles an artist's sketch of UNSUB which appeared on page 35 of the April 11 issue of the "New York Times."

Mrs. SHENTON advised the photograph appears in a recently published book, "The Committee" which was published by Farrar, Straus, and Giroux, 19 Union Square West, New York, N.Y., on March 25, 1968. Photograph is of unknown individual standing behind ROBERT SHELTON, head of the Ku Klux Klan, as SHELTON dressed for a Klan rally in South Carolina in 1965.

Mrs. SHENTON advised the original of the above photograph is in the possession of Wide World Photos, Inc., (Associated Press) 50 Rockefeller Plaza, New York, N.Y., 10020.

An information copy is being provided for New York in the event further investigation is requested by Memphis.

Inasmuch as the New Haven Office is unaware of the extent of investigation being conducted by Memphis, the above is submitted for whatever action is deemed appropriate by Memphis.

Search of premises believed occupied by Unsub who assassinated Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING on 4/4/68, disclosed suitcase in which was located tee-shirt and undershorts bearing laundry mark on red tape with black lettering believed to be thermo-seal type, manufactured by Textile Marking Machine Co., Inc., Syracuse, N. Y. The tape is $\frac{1}{4}$ " wide and $1 \frac{1}{16}$ " long and bears letters and numbers 02B-6.

Experts at Textile Marking Machine Company advise type on this machine is unusual in that the first two characters are 15 point type and the last three characters are 18 point type, with the middle character, the letter B, probably being narrow rather than regular type. The usual machine carries 15 point type for the first three characters and 18 point type for the last two characters.

Textile Marking Machine experts also stated this machine is defective in that it is producing a tape $1 \frac{1}{16}$ " long instead of $1 \frac{1}{8}$ " long and is not projecting the tape far enough resulting in cutting off a portion of the first letter. The code used in the Northeast part of the U. S. is as follows:

The first letter O stands for lot number; the first number 2 indicates the day of the week, two being Tuesday; the second letter indicates the first letter of the store name, this is the letter B; the last number is the bundle number, this is 6. Color coding of the tag may designate various things such as a different month or the identity of a store in a chain. Experts also state the use of this system on laundry items is unusual in that the system is normally used on garments being dry cleaned.

The Bureau has instructed that all textile machines using this type tape be located and machines using this code be identified.
