

Stamford, Connecticut; INFORMATION CONCERNING

Captioned individual called this office on Friday afternoon, 6/23/61, and it was obvious that he had been drinking. He said he was a native of Westchester County, having lived in Rye and White Plains, N. Y. He rembled about two young negro boys who came into a bar on Main Street, in Stamford, asking patrons to let them shine their shoes. He said he questioned the boys and felt, in his own mind, that they had stolen a 4-wheel scooter in Bridgeport, Conn., and had brought it to Stamford. He said he chased one of the boys out of the bar, caught him, and turned him over to a policeman, who disregarded his complaint.

Mr. Willard was informed that he should contact the Police Department in Stamford, Conn., in the event he felt the police officerhad acted improperly. Mr. Willard said he had ruined a suit of clothes and injured his hand in trying to run down the negro boy. He was vehement over the incident and threatened to go out and get a machine gun. He was told this would be improper; that, if he felt there had been a violation of the state law in Connecticut, he should report the matter to the Stamford Police. He was informed the matter was not within the jurisdiction of the FBI as he outlined it. Mr. Willard was unable to furnish the names, addresses, or any other pertinent or identifiable information concerning the boys.

It is to be noted in connection with the above captioned matter, that Unsub registered at the motel prior to the killing of KING, using the name JOHN WILLARD.

The indices of the NHO contain a reference with regard to JOHN WILLARD, NH 62-0-8126, in which this WILLARD was in contact with the NYO concerning a complaint he made regarding two young Negro boys, who purportedly stole a four wheel scooter in Bridgeport, Conn., and had brought same to Stamford, one of whom he had chased, caught, and turned over to a policeman.

WILLARD was advised to contact the Police Department in Stamford, Conn., with regard to this event.

In an effort to negate WILLARD as being identical with Unsub, it is suggested that Stamford Police Dept. records by checked consistent with the above information and enclosed reference NH 62-0-8126.

THIS MAN ASKED HER HOW TO GET OUT OF AIRPORT, SHE STATED SHE DREW HIM A MAP. SOLOMON AND WILFORD ADVISED THEY HAD NO IDEA AS TO HOW HE EITHER ARRIVED OR DEPARTED THE AIRPORT.

WILFORD ADVISED AFTER TALKING TO THIS MAN SHE WAS LOOKING AT SAN FRANCISCO EXAMINER AND ON PAGE ELEVEN THERE WAS A DRAWING OF THE UNSUB. SHE ADVISED IT WAS HER BELIEF REYES LOOKED LIKE THE MAN IN THE DRAWING. SHE ADVISED SHE FOLDED NEWSPAPER SO THAT THE DESCRIPTIVE DATA ABOUT THE UNSUB WAS NOT VISIBLE. SHE ADVISED SHE SHOWED THIS TO MISS SOLOMON WHO SAID THAT THE DRAWING LOOKED LIKE THE MAN WHO WAS JUST AT THE COUNTER.

At 2:00pm, 4/14/68, NHO was telephonically contacted by MR. COHAN, manager, Community Theater, Fairfield, Conn. He advised that two of his part-time personnel at the theater saw a person that resembled assassin of MARTIN LUTHER KING, on 4/7/68.

NHO telephonically talked to one of the personnel MR. THOMAS ANDERSON. He explained that the individual in question arrived by bus. He was from out of town for he asked cashier what there was to do in town. He acted extremely nervous and only remained at the show for a short period of time. Upon leaving he departed in a cab.

The reason that instant matter was not reported sooner is because this did not all come to light until ANDERSON and cashier saw artist conception on local newspaper on 4/13/68.

MH 157-818 For your assistance in handling this lead, the following information is set forth: GALT reportedly signed up for a one-year dancing course in New Orleans in 1964; took dancing lessons for several weeks in Birmingham, beginning in September, 1967; and took a \$499 dance course from December, 1967, to February 1968, at Long Beach, California. One dance instructor has stated that GALT is "crazy" about dancing but a poor dancer and difficult to teach because he does not remember instructions. He was described as an introvert, who volunteers no information and replies with yes or no answers when asked; did not mingle with other students and made no efforts to make friends or converse with anyone. Another dance instructor stated GALT is a good dancer, displayed slight Southern accent, rural characteristics of language and diction, teeth straight and clean, fingernails clean and neatly trimmed; wore gold ring with dark stone; always neatly dressed with suit and shiny slip-on type black alligator shoes with thin soles, black hose and wore tie tack and cuff links. 



CONSPIRING TO VIOLATE THE CIVIL RIGHTS OF DR. KING IN VIOLATION OF
TITLE 18, SECTION 241, OF THE UNITED STATES CODE.

THE FBI COMPLAINT CHARGES THAT "ON OR ABOUT MARCH 29,

1968, AT BIRMINGHAM, ALABAMA, ...ERIC STARVO GALT AND AN INDIVIDUAL

WHOM HE ALLEGED TO BE HIS BROTHER, ENTERED INTO A

CONSPIRACY WHICH CONTINUED UNTIL ON OR ABOUT APRIL 5, 1968, TO

INJURE, OPPRESS, THREATEN, OR INTIMIDATE MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR.,...

IN THE FREE EXERCISE OR ENJOYMENT OF A RIGHT SECURED TO HIM

BY THE CONSTITUTION OR LAWS OF THE UNITED STATES; NAMELY, THE

RIGHT TO FREELY TRAVEL FROM STATE TO STATE. IN FURTHERANCE

OF THIS CONSPIRACY, ERIC STARVO GALT DID, ON OR ABOUT MARCH 30,

1968, PURCHASE A RIFLE AT BIRMINGHAM, ALABAMA..."

ACCORDING TO MR. HOOVER, A 30.06 RIFLE EQUIPPED WITH A TELESCOPIC SIGHT WAS FOUND NEAR A ROOMING HOUSE ON SOUTH MAIN STREET IN MEMPHIS IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE FATAL SHOOTING OF DR. KING OCCURRED. THE ROOMING HOUSE OVERLOOKS THE LORRAINE HOTEL AND MOTEL WHERE DR. KING WAS STAYING.

MR. HOOVER SAID THAT FBI AGENTS DETERMINED THAT THE 30.06 RIFLE HAD BEEN PURCHASED FROM A GUN DEALER IN BIRMINGHAM, ALABAMA, ON MARCH 30, 1968. THE TELESCOPIC SIGHT ALSO WAS PURCHASED FROM THIS DEALER.

THE FBI DIRECTOR SAID THAT GALT, WHO HAS USED THE NAMES OF JOHN WILLARD AND HARVEY LOWMYER IN THE PAST, IS THE OWNER OF A 1966 WHITE MUSTANG BEARING ALABAMA LICENSE PLATES WHICH WAS LOCATED ABANDONED IN ATLANTA, GEORGIA, ON APRIL 11, 1968. INVESTIGATION DISCLOSED THAT GALT PURCHASED THIS CAR FROM A PRIVATE CITIZEN IN BIRMINGHAM ON AUGUST 30, 1967. THE MUSTANG'S ODOMETER SHOWED THAT IT HAD BEEN DRIVEN MORE THAN 19,000 MILES BETWEEN LATE AUGUST, 1967, AND EARLY APRIL, 1968.

ACCORDING TO MR. HOOVER, GALT'S TRAVELS IN THE MUSTANG INCLUDED TRIPS TO LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA; NEW ORLEANS, LOUISIANA; BIRMINGHAM, ALABAMA; AND MEXICO, AS WELL AS TO MEMPHIS, TENNESSEE, AND ATLANTA, GEORGIA. GALT WAS REPORTED TO HAVE BEEN IN MEMPHIS ON APRIL 3 AND 4, 1968, AND TO HAVE DEPARTED FROM THERE FOR ATLANTA.

INTENSIVE INESTIGATION BY THE FBI HAS DISCLOSED THAT

IN BIRMINGHAM DURING SEPTEMBER AND OCTOBER, 1967; AND IN LONG

BEACH CALIFORNIA, FROM DECEMBER, 1967 TO FEBRUARY, 1968.

GALT LEFT LOS ANGELES ON DECEMBER 15, 1967, AND DROVE

HIS WHITE MUSTANG TO NEW ORLEANS, WHERE HE CLAIMED HE CONTACTED

EITHER AN ENGINEERING OR A CONTRACTING FIRM. HE LEFT NEW ORLEANS ON

DECEMBER 19TH AND ARRIVED BACK IN LOS ANGELES ON DECEMBER 21, 1967.

WHILE IN THE LOS ANGELES AREA EARLY THIS YEAR, GALT
TOOK A COURSE AT A SCHOOL OF BARTENDING AND WAS GRADUATED ON MARCH 2,

THE FUGITIVE IS DESCRIBED AS WHITE MALE. HE IS APPROXIMATELY 5 FEET 8 INCHES TO 5 FEET 11 INCHES TALL AND WEIGHS
BETWEEN 160 AND 175 POUNDS. HE S SAID TO BE A NEAT DRESSER AND
HAS A MEDIUM BUILD.


