Re suspect EUGENE SMITH MANSFIELD

I received a telephone call from SAC ROY MOORE at Jackson advising Birmingham had requested a check of EUGENE SMITH MANSFIELD, white male, born [REDACTED] Elmore County, Alabama; 5' 9", 170 lbs., brown hair, blue eyes, FBI Number [REDACTED]

MOORE requested that MANSFIELD be located and interviewed at Buras, La., as to his whereabouts on the pertinent dates (3/29, 3/30 and 4/4/68). MOORE stated they had received a teletype lead to the effect that MANSFIELD was located in Florence, Miss., care of L. E. MATTHEWS, who is a Province Giant, White Knights of the KKK, and their informant had advised that EUGENE SMITH MANSFIELD as of the night of 4/9/68 was in Buras, La.; that we had background information on MATTHEWS in our file "UNSUBS; Gretna, La., Police Department, Grand Isle; EUGENE SMITH MANSFIELD - VICTIM, CR".

SAC MOORE stated in addition to interviewing MANSFIELD concerning his whereabouts on the pertinent period it would be of considerable assistance to them if he was interviewed concerning his association with L. E. MATTHEWS without blowing Jackson's informant as apparently MATTHEWS was trying to hire MANSFIELD for a "hit".

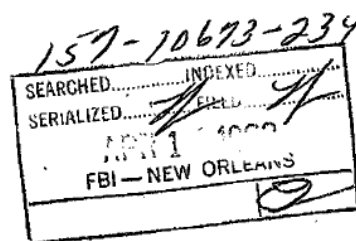

On 4/12/68, ALVIN LLOYD PERRIE, JR., was contacted at his residence at 1601 Burdette at which time he advised that he has been unemployed since he was arrested by the local police department a year ago. PERRIE stated that he has occasionally done spot labor jobs, but that he has had nothing of a permanent nature in employment.

PERRIE stated that he could not remember specifically exactly where he was on 3/28, 2/29 and 4/4, but he advised that he has not left New Orleans since his arrest. He stated that he has been at home every day during the past month. He willingly furnished the name of a neighbor who could verify his presence at home.

Mrs. BETTY LANDRY, 1601 Burdette, Apartment #2 advised that she is very well acquainted with ALVIN LLOYD PERRIE, and that she goes to the local school to walk home with his children each afternoon. She stated that PERRIE has been at home each afternoon that she has arrived with the children during the past month.

In the process of attempting to locate PERRIE and his employment, it was determined that the case is still pending in the local courts, and that the attorney for the defense has made a motion to suppress the evidence in the matter. The docket number is 199-763, Section A.

Capt. Jennings advised that he will attempt to determine an address for National Carrier and advise SA CALLENDER.

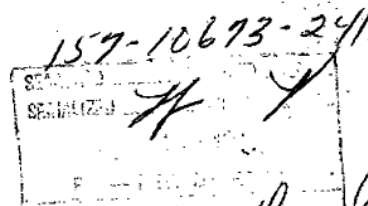

She commented that on the evening of April 4, 1968, at approximately 9:00 p.m., she noticed that the outside lights of LeBOUEF's house were being turned on periodically to enable him to check his vegetable garden. She stated that LeBOUEF has not been away from his residence for an appreciative length of time.

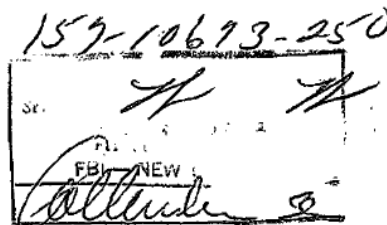

On 3/31/68 he paid the second week's rent and the landlord has not seen him since that date.

GALT placed laundry in the Piedmont Cleaners, within a short distance of the rooming house, on 4/1/68, and according to Atlanta, abandoned the Mustang at 8:30 a.m., 4/5/68 in Atlanta, and picked up his laundry at the Cleaners at 9:00 a.m., 4/5/68.

C. L. McGOWAN of the Bureau advised in reference to the Montreal address that a check with the Locksmith Ledger in New Jersey who sells correspondence courses in locksmith, GALT had first written to them from Montreal, Canada, giving a return address, and apparently there was correspondence back to Montreal to GALT from the Locksmith Ledger.
