A meeting of Unit 557 was scheduled for the night of April 4, 1968, at the residence of HUGH MERRON, 7733 Haney Drive, New Orleans, Louisiana. Attending this meeting were the following members:

JOE OVERSTREET - EC

AL COLLIER

BILL ROBESON

BERNARD OVERSTREET - Kleagle

OLD MAN PITTS

HUGH MERRON - KLOKAN

A formal meeting of the unit was not held due to the interest generated by the death of MARTIN LUTHER KING and most of the meeting was taken up by watching news reports on TV.

It was noted that COLLIER and ROBESON, who were traveling together, arrived at 8:10 p.m. shortly after the meeting was supposed to start. Neither COLLIER nor ROBESON had heard about KING being killed and ROBESON did a little "dance of joy" when he heard KING was dead.

MANNY HORRIDGE was supposed to meet JOE OVERSTREET at Martin Brothers Restaurant and then come to the meeting, but he did not show up.

JOE OVERSTREET was wearing a .38 Caliber revolver and holster. BERNARD OVERSTREET had something under his shirt and although he did not show what it was, it gave the appearances of a gun.

AL COLLIER was heard to suggest that they should get some dynamite and "blow up these n[redacted]s."

JOE OVERSTREET asked if everyone "had protection." MERRON said he had a shotgun. ROBESON said he had a rifle and pistol. PITTS said he had a shotgun and a pistol. COLLIER, who is usually silent, indicated he had some kind of gun. JOE OVERSTREET gave out his telephone number and said if any of the members had any kind of trouble, they should call him at any time of the day or night and he would come to their assistance.

JOE OVERSTREET suggested strongly that all the members equip their automobiles with citizens band radio equipment. He said that his "A and B channels are CB channels 9 and 11."

During the meeting JOE OVERSTREET tried to call his brother at Memphis, Tennessee, but could not get through. BERNARD OVERSTREET took the phone and told the operator it was a life or death emergency. He finally got the call through and JOE talked to his brother. It appears this

brother is also BERNARD OVERSTREET's father. JOE and BERNARD OVERSTREET discussed the possibilities of traveling to Memphis to help protect their relatives. It was not clear when the meeting ended whether the OVERSTREETs would actually make this trip, but they indicated that they were considering going at once.

JOE OVERSTREET announced that the next meeting would be at BILL ROBESON's house on April 18, 1968. He also announced a change in plans for state meetings of the UKA in which they would alternate between Baton Rouge and Alexandria. He stated that BERNARD OVERSTREET, MERRON and PITTS, as well as himself, would go to the state meeting at Alexandria on April 7, 1968, to represent Unit 557.

Members paid their dues during this meeting. It was noted that MERRON owed for both March and April and paid the sum of \$10.00.

Informant stated there was a rumor that MONTALBANO received his financing from CARLOS MARCELLO; however, he would further attempt to verify this.

On 4/23/68 contact informant advised that he had noticed some prostitutes and pimps who used to work in the Biloxi, Mississippi area in the Maison Bourbon. He stated he has since forgotten their names but will attempt to identify them. He stated it is his understanding that these girls will not hustle out of the Maison Bourbon but will use it as a place to receive phone calls on a call-girl basis. He stated these are all strange prostitutes to the area, and he felt MONTALBANO would not allow any locally-known prostitute on the premises, at least in any employment capacity. Informant states this is a perfect setup for a place for a prostitute to hang out, inasmuch as it is currently a very respectable establishment and caters to all types of customers, particularly tourists.

At approximately 1:30 AM on 4/26/68, this agent received a telephone call from Clerk WILLIAM DEILY of this office relating he had been called by Miss KATHY QUILTER, a supervisor at Delta Airlines, who requested this agent be contacted by the office and call her back.

Miss QUILTER is a friend of this agent.

Miss QUILTER was then contacted by this agent and advised him Miss RITA REHKOPF, a Delta stewardess, 6805 Veterans Highway, Apartment 14-G, Metairie, La., was very distraught after having been interviewed by FBI Agents concerning MURKIN. Miss QUILTER thought it would be appreciated if this agent would contact Miss REHKOPF as she lived a short distance from his apartment.

Subsequently, this agent walked to Miss REHKOPF's apartment and was admitted by her.

Miss REHKOPF advised she and her roommate, who was then present but stayed in the bedroom and was never introduced to this agent, had been receiving crank calls on the telephone and Miss REHKOPF advised she was upset after being interviewed by the FBI. Miss REHKOPF also stated she has [REDACTED] and has had trouble sleeping lately.

She stated she would like to get protection from the FBI.

Miss REHKOPF was advised the FBI could not give citizens protection and that was a function of the local police. She was also told that there was no reason for her to be apprehensive about having been interviewed by the FBI as she was only one of many people to have had that experience.

It should be noted Miss REHKOPF appeared to be very flighty, often interrupting herself and this agent with conversation that was very spontaneous and not relevant to what was being discussed.

SAIC RODRIGUEZ advised that RITA REHKOPF was to meet her parents in California when they returned from overseas and she had advised them that she could not meet them in California until "after the trial", referring to the trial of RAY, and that she was flying to Florida. The reason for going to Florida was not given.

SAIC RODRIGUEZ was advised that Miss REHKOPF, who is a Delta Airlines stewardess, had been interviewed by Agents of this office in reference to the fugitive investigation being conducted concerning RAY along with numerous other stewardesses and crew members of other Delta Airlines flights; that she was not in the protective custody of the FBI and this office had no information to indicate she would be involved in any trial.

He was further advised that the Supervisor of Stewardesses of Delta had contacted an Agent of the FBI in the early morning hours of 4/26/68 and stated that Miss RITA REHKOPF wanted to see an Agent.

Miss REHKOPF was contacted to determine whether she had any pertinent information at which time Miss REHKOPF stated she had [REDACTED], was having trouble sleeping lately, and had become nervous after being interviewed and stated she would like to have protection by the FBI. Miss REHKOPF was advised the FBI could not give her protection, that this was the function of the local authorities. It was explained to her that she had no reason for feeling apprehensive as she was only one of many persons that had been

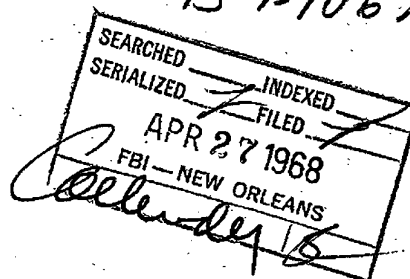

JAMES L. GATTEN, 1005 Metker, Apartment 41, Irving, Texas, furnished the following information to date.

He is a bellhop at a Ramada Inn, Lovefield, Dallas, Texas, and delivers cars for Hertz throughout the United States.

On April 6, 1968, GATTEN left Atlanta, Georgia, en route to Dallas in a Hertz car. On early a.m. April 7, 1968, GATTEN picked up a hitchhiker on Interstate 59, about ten miles west of intersection of Interstate 59 and State Route 49. Miss REAHKOPF stated that relative of hers who also has information pertaining to the MURKIN matter was presently staying with her, but she would not furnish the individual's name over the telephone.

Miss REAHKOPF advised that she has spoken with SA ~~KENNETH C. OERTEL~~ on this matter on previous occasions and would want to speak to him again but that Monday would be soon enough.
