As Memphis and Houston are aware, CHARLES STEIN of Los Angeles, California, who accompanied JAMES EARL RAY on a trip from Los Angeles to New Orleans in December, 1967, has claimed that on one occasion, believed to be the evening of 12/16/67, he observed RAY making a phone call from a pay telephone believed in the Houston, Texas area.

As a result, the Houston Division furnished New Orleans the identities of approximately 350 telephone numbers located in Louisiana which were called during the period of 12/15 - 17/67, from pay telephones located in the Houston Division.

The subscribers of these Louisiana telephone numbers were determined and the subscribers located and interviewed. However, no pertinent information was developed.

There is set forth under appropriate sub-headings the identities of the Louisiana telephone numbers of persons residing in this state in which investigation determined that they presently reside in the Houston and Memphis Divisions.

New Orleans has conducted extensive investigation in an attempt to determine if JAMES EARL RAY was in contact with any resident of the New Orleans area, during the time that he was in New Orleans from December 17 - 19, 1967, and also when he passed through New Orleans on or about 3/21/68. To date, this investigation has met with negative results. According to CHARLES STEIN, who accompanied RAY on a trip from Los Angeles, California, to New Orleans in December, 1967, RAY alleged his purpose in coming to New Orleans was on business and to contact an individual.

Up to the time RAY escaped from the Missouri State Penitentiary (MSP), Jefferson City, Missouri, in April, 1967, he had spent the better part of the previous ten to twelve years incarcerated either at the MSP or the U. S. Penitentiary at Leavenworth, Kansas.

Working on the theory that possibly RAY, while in New Orleans, may have contacted a former fellow inmate that he knew at either of the above institutions, New Orleans contacted various state and Federal parole and probation officers as well as officers of the NOPD, in an attempt to determine if these persons knew the identities of any former inmates of the above institutions who might be residing in New Orleans. These inquiries met with negative results.

Kansas City is requested to advise New Orleans if it is known whether there are any persons who were inmates at the above institutions during the time RAY was incarcerated

On July 21, 1968, Mr. BURK C. ALLISON, JR., Assistant Trust Officer, National Bank of Commerce, Pine Bluff, Arkansas, telephonically contacted SA GEORGE A. BARRON, JR. at Pine Bluff, advising he had received a telephone call from Mrs. J. BURNETT from New Iberia, Louisiana. Mrs. BURNETT told Mr. ALLISON she understood the FBI desired to talk with her and she could be reached at that time at New Iberia, Louisiana, telephone 387-8214. Mr. ALLISON told Mrs. BURNETT that as he was personally acquainted with SA GEORGE A. BARRON, JR. and the fact that Mrs. BURNETT was also acquainted with SA BARRON, he would attempt to reach SA BARRON and have SA BARRON telephone Mrs. BURNETT.

On July 21, 1968, SA GEORGE A. BARRON, JR., from Pine Bluff, Arkansas, Resident Agency, telephonically contacted Mrs. J. BURNETT at telephone number 387-8214, New Iberia, Louisiana. Mrs. BURNETT stated she had heard through her cousin, JIM MUDGON, that the FBI wanted to talk with her and that was why she was trying to contact Agent BARRON. She and her former husband, CHARLES WYLLIE, owned a houseboat known as the "Wali Willie." After her former husband's death, she sold this houseboat to a Mr. CARTWRIGHT, owner and operator of Cartwright Nursery Company near Memphis, Tennessee, and delivered the boat to him about February 1966. She was not acquainted with anyone named BYRONED CURTIS or JAMES EARL RAY. She stated Mr. ALLISON could furnish the name and address of the party to whom she sold the boat.

On July 22, 1968, Mr. DUKE C. ALLISON, JR., Assistant Trust Officer, National Bank of Commerce, furnished SA GEORGE A. HANCOX, JR. the following information:

Mrs. BURNETT sold the houseboat "Wali Willie" to A. B. CARTWRIGHT, JR., owner of Cartwright Nursery Company, Collierville, Tennessee, and delivered the boat approximately February 3, 1966. Mr. CARTWRIGHT re-named the boat "The Fonderosa." The boat is believed to be presently docked out of Memphis, Tennessee.

Mrs. **HILL BURNETT**, Apartment 3, Layton Castle, 1133 South Grand Street, Monroe, Louisiana, furnished the following information:

Mrs. **BURNETT** was formerly the wife of the late **CHARLES C. WILLEY**, who died three years ago. She and her late husband owned plantations and farm properties near Altheimer, and Bohannon, Arkansas, and he was formerly President of the First National Bank of Altheimer, Arkansas; in 1958 they bought a boat, a fifty-eight foot steel hull boat, which they named "The Nell Willey," and they spent a great deal of time on the boat from 1958, to 1966. During that period of time, the boat was often docked for long periods of time at Greenville, Mississippi; Monroe, Louisiana; and New Orleans, Louisiana. In January, 1966, Mrs. **HILL BURNETT**, then Mrs. **CHARLES C. WILLEY**, sold the boat to Cartwright Nurseries, Collierville, Tennessee, and delivered it to Memphis, Tennessee.

Mrs. **BURNETT** stated that she had never heard of **RAYMOND CURTIS** (now an inmate of Whitfield County Jail, Dalton, Georgia), and she was reasonably sure that her late husband, **CHARLES C. WILLEY**, did not know him. She stated that he was not a crewman or passenger on "The Nell Willey" during the period 1958, to 1966, when she and her late husband owned it, and she was sure that no arrangements were made to use the boat during that period to transport any criminal along the Mississippi River. Mrs. **BURNETT** stated that she had never heard of **JAMES EARL RAY** until his name appeared in the news in connection with the assassination of Dr. **MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR.**

1. Further to para #2 of PCR dated 4 JULY 68, the name of the Lawyer is **Barnie HORTON** of New Orleans La USA Area code 504-288-9541.
2. Further to para #4 of PCR dated 28 JUNE 68, investigations were conducted to obtain all Toll Tickets concerning the long distance calls, however, same proved negative as all Toll Tickets in this case were destroyed after the 60 day holding period.
3. Further to para #5 of PCR dated 28 JUNE 68, it was established through the BELL that KIMBLE had phone #525-9567 whilst residing under the name J.R. KIMBLE at 3420 St. Germain St Montreal Apt #4 during the month of SEPT 67.
4. All documents concerning KIMBLE'S phone were examined and initialed by myself and Mr. Vollen HASTINGS Security Officer for BELL TELEPHONE Montreal, Que. Photostats of all documents are attached hereto. The originals are held on file this point and are shown on Exhibit Report #68/51. Copies of C246 are attached hereto.
5. As the BELL Security have no means of holding these documents in a safe place same are being held by this Force for possible use as evidence at a later date. A search warrant will be obtained in order to hold these documents in consideration of the BELL policy. A further report will be submitted concerning this search warrant.
6. Continuing with para #4 above the following documents were obtained and are explained in part starting with the original request by KIMBLE for a phone:

PHOTOSTAT marked "A" -

This is a form referred to as a 515 which is completed by the BELL at time of request for a phone:

- a) phone #525-9567 is KIMBLE'S
- b) phone #522-6530 is registered to John SUZ landlord at 3420 St. Germain St., Montreal
- c) Phone #842-1251 is registered to ROYAL VICTORIA HOSPITAL 687 Pine Ave., Montreal.

It will be noted that there is no way to identify the BELL employee who had taken this request over the phone or in person. Before contacting SUZ or ROYAL VICTORIA HOSPITAL to further this investigation, the photo of KIMBLE as requested in para #12 of PCR dated 28 JUNE 68 is awaited.

The only information available from this card is that the exchange the call was made from was New Orleans #944-7777; last four digits unknown. The reverse of this card shows the date and time the card was received in Montreal.

PHOTOSTAT marked "I" -

This is an IBM card advising of a phone call made from New Orleans on the 24 SEPT (note upper left corner) in the amount of \$21.35. This card is in reference to long distance call shown in PHOTOSTAT "D" under date 24 SEPT 67 in the amount of \$21.35. The only information available from this card is that the exchange the call was made from was New Orleans #944-7777, last four digits unknown. The reverse of this card shows the date and time the card was received in Montreal.

PHOTOSTAT marked "J" -

This is the form made up upon the request that a phone be disconnected. Same was given out-order #135922. It was established that Mrs. R. DALLAIRE of the BELL TELEPHONE 2100 Papineau Office was the person who had taken the request and filled out the document. DALLAIRE's initials appear at the top of the form in the space "EMP". At present DALLAIRE is on 1 year leave of absence from the BELL. The phone numbers appearing on this form are registered to:
