OF THIS SUB FILE BECAME WHAT WAS THEN PD 100-6883, A SEPARATE INVESTIGATION ENTITLED "COMMUNIST PARTY, USA - NEGRO QUESTION." PD 100-6883 WAS OPENED FEBRUARY 28, 1948, AND INCORPORATED INTO PD 100-3952 SUB 13 ON OCTOBER 29, 1954, AS PREVIOUSLY MENTIONED, AND AT THAT TIME CONSISTED OF 318 SERIALS. PD 100-6883 CONTAINS ROUTINE CORRESPONDENCE BUT ALSO CONTAINS MANY LOGS OF WHAT APPEARS TO BE A HIGHLY SENSITIVE SOURCE COVERING A PERIOD OF MARCH 6, 1948, THROUGH MARCH 23, 1950. THESE LOGS APPARENTLY CONCERN INFORMATION RELATIVE TO THE ACTIVITIES OF THE CPUSA, AND WHEN THE NEGRO QUESTION WAS MENTIONED, A COPY APPARENTLY WAS DESIGNATED TO THIS FILE WHICH WAS USED PRIOR TO THE TIME SUB FILES WERE DESIGNATED FOR THE CPUSA. TASK FORCE MEMBERS HAVE TRAVELED TO MEMPHIS, MILWAUKEE, KANSAS CITY, OMAHA, SAN FRANCISCO AND LOS ANGELES AND REVIEWED MURKIN AND INTELLIGENCE INVESTIGATION FILES OF THOSE OFFICES. FUTURE TRAVEL BY THE TASK FORCE IS PLANNED FOR ATLANTA, BIRMINGHAM, CHARLOTTE, CHICAGO, NEW ORLEANS, NEW YORK, SPRINGFIELD AND ST. LOUIS.

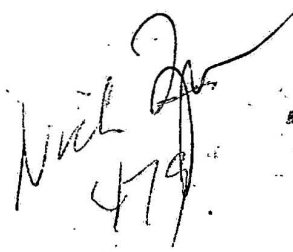

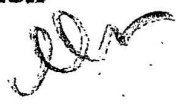

On 11/9/77 SA JAY ALDHIZER, Congressional Liaison Unit, FBIHQ, telephonically advised that the Congressional Committee on Assassinations requested the appearance of SAs WILLIAM KUSCH and RAMON STRATTON before investigators for the committee during the week of 11/14/77. SA ALDHIZER advised that SAs KUSCH and STRATTON should agree on a date when both would be available to come to Washington and should travel via GTR.

ALDHIZER advised that SA DAN COULSON, Legal Section, Extension 4515, was familiar with the testimony and would brief SAs prior to their meeting the investigators.

ALDHIZER further advised that the Director had cleared the testimony and released employees from their employment agreement.

ALDHIZER stated that the Agents were being interviewed by the investigators without access to appropriate files and would not be given an opportunity to review files concerning the KING assassination.

ALDHIZER advised that he should be advised on 11/9/77 as to the date SAs KUSCH and STRATTON would report to Washington, D.C.
