

This will advise that, as per your request made to us on April 30, 1968, we have now compared the fingerprints of James Earl Ray, alias Eric Starvo Galt, FBI# 405 942 G, with all unidentified latent prints in our files received from crimes which occurred during the period from April 23, 1967 to the date of this writing, with negative results.

This includes all latent fingerprints from a total of 448 separate cases but does not include those cases for which we received only latent palm prints; since we do not have palm prints of subject in guestion for comparison purposes.

We have made copies of the fingerprints of James Earl Ray and have supplied one to each of our technicians at this bureau who work with latent prints. We intend that this subject's prints will, by regular procedure, be compared with all latent prints received here from this date on until he is apprehended.

Any positive results will be, of course, reported to you immediately.
