


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

# Gun Reported To Be One Used To Kill Dr. King

BIRMINGTON Alabama (P)—
The Birmingham, Alabama News said yesterday in a copyright story that a gun which the FBI said was purchased in Birmingham has been determined by ballistics tests to be the weapon used in the slaying of Dr. Martin Luther King.

The story said also that the search for Eric Starvo Galt, who is charged with conspiracy in King's death, has spread outside the United States.

Quoting an unidentified source, described only as an investigator, the News said it is believed that Galt has fled to Mexico or Cuba. The FBI has said previously that Galt, on or about March 30, bought a rifle in Birmingham.

The statement also said that a .30-06 rifle equipped with a telescopic sight, was found near the motel in Memphis, Tennessee where King was slain.

Galt resided in a Birmingham rodning house from Aug. 26 to Oct.

7, 967.

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# Hunt Pressed For King Murder Figure

April 18 (AP) — The nationwide hunt continues today for Eric Starvo Galt, identified by the FBI as one of the men involved in the assassination of Martin Luther King.

The FBI has charged Gall with conspiracy to violate the civil rights of King. And the state of Tennessee has charged Galt with first degree murder in the April 4 Memphis killing.





### L<u>o De</u>tienen En Sonora, Méjico

CABORCA (Méjico) (UPI)
—La Policía detuvo a un individuo bajo sospechas de que pudiera ser el presunto asesino del dirigente negro norteamericano Martin Luther King, Hijo, según anunciaron hoy las propias autoridades.

Los agentes del orden arrestaron ayer por la tarde al sospechoso en un café de esta localidad, situada en el estado de Sonora, y lo sometieron a interrogatorio durante 12 horas en su habitación del Hotel San Carlos. Según informó el propietario de dicho Hotel, Carlos Valencia Beltrán, al cabo de el interrogatorio, el de tenido fue llevado por la Policía en automóvil a Hermosillo, capital de Sonora.

Valencia Beltrán afirmó a la United Press International que él había avisado ayer a la Policía para que comprobaran la identidad de un norteamericano que se había alojado en su hotel en la noche del martes. Explicó que el individuo se parecía mucho a las fotografías que han circulado del supuesto asesino de King, James Earl Ray, quien está reclamado por la Oficina Federal de Investigaciones (FBI) de Estados Unidos.

El huésped dijo llamarse Daniel David Kennedy y tener 42 años. Aseguró que su domicilio está en Baltimore (Maryland) y que había venido a Méjico como turista con el propósito de dirigirse al Desierto de Altar, en Sonora. Añadió Kennedy que tiene una hija en Baltimore y que está divorciado, de acuerdo con Valencia Beltrán.

El teniente Roberto Fletcher, perteneciente al Departamento de Investigaciones de la Policía de Caborca, declaró por su parte que había observado al sospechoso antes de entablar conversación con él. Hecho esto, lo lleyó a la habitación que odipaba en el Hotel citado y all lo mantuvo en calidad de detenido. El Hotel que rodiado simultáneamente por varios agentes. No se hallaron armas en la habitación aludida.

Informó la Policia que se ocupó al detenido el pasaporte número 8527475. No se sabe si han sido formulados (Continúa en la página 27)

(Entre tanto, en Washington, un vocero de la FBI dijo que no se había hecho arresto alguno en el caso de Ray).

Valencia Beltrán dijo que Kennedy manifestó que había venido a pie desde Sarich de Nogales (Sonora), por donde entró en Méjico, y que llevaba en la espalda una mochila militar. Vestía partire camisa azul, con botas, y tenía barba.

Agregó que sospechó de

Kennedy cuando éste trato de comunicarse por teléfono con una persona no identificada en Baltimore, por razón de su parecido con las fotos de Ray. Siguió diciendo que el huésped detenido tenía un tatuaje en el brazo izquierdo que parecía ser la figura de un mono.

(Entre tanto, en Baltimore la madre de Kennedy llamada Pearl, se sorprendió ante la noticia de la detención y exclamó: "Eso es imposible, eso es imposible".

(Aclaró que su hijo es delgado y que sólo un ciego podría confundirlo con el hombre que busca la FBI. Agregó que Kennedy había sido herido en la Segunda Guerra Mundial y que lo condecoraron con el Corazón de Púrpura.



James Earl Ray, a Missouri prison escapee who has been sought under the alias Eric Starvo Galt in connection with the gunshot slaying of civil rights leader Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., has been added to the FBI's list of "Ten Most Wanted Fugitives."

FBI Director J. Edgar Hoover ordered the special addition of Ray to the "Ten Most Wanted Fugitives" list, which already contains ten fugitives, to insure the widest possible dissemination of Ray's photograph and description to help effect his earliest possible location.

Ray has been the subject of a massive and intensive search since the brutal gunshot slaying of Dr. King on April 4, 1968, as he stood on the balcony of a Memphis, Tennessee, motel. One rifle bullet, believed fired from the window of a nearby rooming house, felled the victim.

APR 29 1968 FBI — SAN JUAN An exhaustive FBI fingerprint search, comparing latent fingerprints uncovered in the Dr. King case against fingerprints of over 53,000 persons on whom wanted notices have been posted in the FBI's Identification Division, succeeded in determining that Galt and Ray are identical.

A Federal warrant, issued at Birmingham, Alabama, on April 17, 1968, charges Ray, under the alias Eric Starvo Galt, with conspiring to interfere with a Constitutional Right of a United States citizen. Ray is also sought for unlawful interstate flight to avoid confinement after conviction for armed robbery, based on a Federal warrant issued on July 20, 1967, at Jefferson City, Missouri. He had been confined at the Missouri State Penitentiary, Jefferson City, Missouri, in March, 1960, with a 20-year sentence following conviction for armed robbery and operating a motor vehicle without permission of the owner. In September, 1966, while serving the sentence, he was confined for a time in the maximum security ward at the State Hospital, Fulton, Missouri. He was reported missing from the Missouri State Penitentiary since April 23, 1967.

Ray, who has an arrest record dating back to 1949 and has been convicted of burglary, armed robbery and forging United States Postal Money Orders, has also been confined in the Los Angeles County Jail, the Joliet and Pontiac, Illinois, State Prisons and the United States Penitentiary, Leavenworth, Kansas.

He served in the Army between February, 1946, and December, 1948, received a three-month sentence at hard labor for being drunk and breaking arrest and was given a General Discharge due to ineptness and lack of adaptability for military service.

Ray is a 40-year-old white male, reportedly born in Illinois on He is approximately 5'10" inches tall, weighs from 163 to 174 pounds, has blue eyes and brown hair which he has worn cut short. He has a small scar on the center of his forehead and a scar on the palm of his right hand. He has been described as having a straight, narrow nose and straight and even teeth and to have a nervous habit of occasionally tugging at an ear lobe. His left ear protrudes noticeably.

Acquaintances describe him as a "loner" and "drifter" whose language and diction reflect a "rural" quality and indicate he has had limited education.

He is reportedly a fan of western and country music, drinks vodka and beer, dresses neatly and claims past employment as a merchant seaman and cook on Mississippi River vessels. He is known to have worked as a baker, laborer and color matcher.

He is known as an avid dancer who has taken dancing lessons.

He also completed a course at a school of bartending in the Los Angeles area early in 1968.

Ray should be considered armed and extremely dangerous.

Ray likes western and country music, drinks vodka and beer and has worked as a baker, laborer and color matcher.
