

RACIAL INCIDENTS, TAMPA DIVISION
APRIL 5-10, 1968

Officials in the Tampa Police Department Command Room stated at 6:00 p.m., April 9, 1968, that although action planned by them was not based on any specific set of facts indicating an outbreak of disturbances in Tampa during the evening, the Police Department and Hillsborough County Sheriff's Office, Tampa, had scheduled a general preparatory alert for 6:00 p.m., and reserve police officers and sheriff's office deputies were to assemble and stand by at 7:00 p.m. at an area Command Post located near the intersection of Interstate Highway 4 and 22nd Street to be ready in event they were needed on the evening of April 9, 1968.

As of 10:00 p.m., April 9, 1968, no significant incidents of racial violence in the City of Tampa were reported to the Police Department.

Deputy Chief of Police NEIL G. BROWN, Tampa, advised at 2:50 a.m., April 10, 1968, that the racial situation in Tampa was quiet, and no significant incidents of racial violence had been reported.

As of 6:30 a.m., April 10, 1968, the Command Post at Tampa Police Department was reported to be secured, and the Police Department had gone back to operating their normal shifts.

Search of premises believed occupied by Unsub who assassinated Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING on 4/4/68, disclosed suitcase in which was located tee-shirt and undershorts bearing laundry mark on red tape with black lettering believed to be thermo-seal type, manufactured by Textile Marking Machine Co., Inc., Syracuse, N. Y. The tape is $\frac{1}{4}$ " wide and $1 \frac{1}{16}$ " long and bears letters and numbers 02B-6.

Experts at Textile Marking Machine Company advise type on this machine is unusual in that the first two characters are 15 point type and the last three characters are 18 point type, with the middle character, the letter B, probably being narrow rather than regular type. The usual machine carries 15 point type for the first three characters and 18 point type for the last two characters.

Textile Marking Machine experts also stated this machine is defective in that it is producing a tape $1 \frac{1}{16}$ " long instead of $1 \frac{1}{8}$ " long and is not projecting the tape far enough resulting in cutting off a portion of the first letter. The code used in the Northeast part of the U. S. is as follows:

The first letter O stands for lot number; the first number 2 indicates the day of the week, two being Tuesday; the second letter indicates the first letter of the store name, this is the letter B; the last number is the bundle number, this is 6. Color coding of the tag may designate various things such as a different month or the identity of a store in a chain. Experts also state the use of this system on laundry items is unusual in that the system is normally used on garments being dry cleaned.

The Bureau has instructed that all textile machines using this type tape be located and machines using this code be identified.

On 4/5/68, Mr. HAWKINS, the Director of Community Relations, St. Petersburg, was contacted early during the day, and he informed that the death of MARTIN LUTHER KING had come as a profound shock to, not only him, but the rest of the Negro community. He said that he had not been able to assess the damage done to race relations as a result of the death of KING, but that he was going to make a personal survey throughout the day in the Negro areas to make his own determination.

He did comment, on this occasion, that he did not believe that JOSEPH WALLER would precipitate any difficulty during the Festival of States Parade in St. Petersburg on 4/5/68. He said that he had recently communicated with WALLER and spoken to him at length concerning race problems in the U.S. He said that WALLER still is volatile, emotional, and militant concerning the solution to these problems, but that he does not believe that he will chance returning to jail by participating in a riot. He said that he has a fairly good relationship with WALLER since he has been instrumental in the employment of WALLER's sister with the General Telephone Co., in St. Petersburg, and that WALLER has been appreciative of this.

Later on during the day on 4/5/68, Mr. HAWKINS was again spoken to, and he informed that he has determined that the majority of Negroes in the area manifest some bitterness concerning the death of KING, but he did not think that the bitterness would take an irrational avenue. He said that he still does not expect violence to occur in St. Petersburg, but informed that he thinks the critical day in connection with this possibility would be Mon., 4/8/68, when the funeral of MARTIN LUTHER KING is expected to take place.

Mr. HAWKINS said that he does not think that race violence can be anticipated, as almost all of the

incidents throughout the U. S. have been a spontaneous nature. He said that he thinks that should the Negro communities in near-by areas, like Tampa, Clearwater or Orlando experience racial difficulty that perhaps this discord could spread and infect the Negro area of St. Petersburg. He is of the opinion that serious racial incidents are contagious from one community to the other and spread rapidly, as occurred in a number of northern communities during the summer, 1967.

He said that he does not know of any specific information indicating that violence will occur in St. Petersburg, but did say that some of the ingredients which make for bitterness and strife do exist here. He described these conditions as ones that are prevalent in almost any area where large concentrations of Negroes are, and some of them are poverty, sub-standard housing discrimination, unemployment, etc.

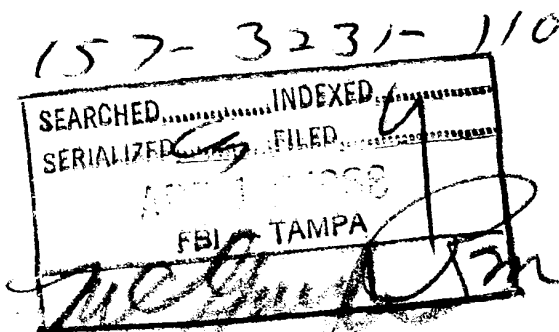

On 4/9/68 contact was made with Ass't COP NORM LASSETER, Lake Wales PD concerning the whereabouts of BILL BOWMAN, GENE MC LEAN and MILES HEADON, on the evening of 4/4/68. LASSETER made telephone calls to the Lake Wales Water Department and Bok Tower at Lake Wales. MC LEAN is employed by the city water department and it was established by LASSETER that he was on the job all day 4/4 and 4/5/68. It was also determined by LASSETER, through his employer, that BOWMAN was also at work all day 4/4 and 4/5/68. LASSETER stated that HEADON is currently working at the new Standard Service Station, on Highway 60, across from the new shopping center and he did not feel he would give any information regarding HEADON.

On 4/10/68, TP 242-R telephonically advised that he had received a telephone call from HEADON and JOHN ROGERS on the evening of 4/4/68, relative to the proposed appearance of the UKA in Tampa, Florida which had been scheduled for 4/6/68. He said he would make efforts to verify this. In view of the distance from Lakeland, Fla. to Memphis, Tennessee, it is felt that this sufficiently accounts for the whereabouts of the bombing suspects assigned to writer to eliminate them as suspects.

King Probers Seize Atlanta Car, Says Paper

ATLANTA (AP) — Federal agents yesterday impounded a white Mustang fitting the description of a car sought in connection with the assassination of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., the Atlanta Constitution reported in today's editions.

The automobile, bearing an Alabama license plate, had been parked since last Friday at a public housing project near the State Capitol, the newspaper reported.

Residents of the housing project who had previously joked about the car's similarity with the wanted vehicle were questioned closely by agents from the Federal Bureau of Investigation, the newspaper said.

The FBI would not immediately comment on the report. Agent Frank V. Hitt said, "I cannot give you any comment."
