After hearing the rifle shot at about 6 p.m. on that same day, other tenants in the rooming house observed a man presumably identical with WILLARD, fleeing from the rooming house carrying a large package which was subsequently abandoned by him on the sidewalk in front of the Canipe Amusement Co., 424 South Main Street, Memphis. A neighborhood investigation in the vicinity of 424 South Main Street disclosed that the subject had fled from the scene in a white Mustang. Investigation at Memphis disclosed that an individual had purchased a set of binoculars at the York Arms Company in Memphis on 4/4/68. These binoculars were among the material abandoned with the rifle and recovered in Memphis. Also recovered was a brown and green herringbone bedspread. The items abandoned in Memphis were all wrapped in this bedspread. The blue bag which was inside the bedspread contained numerous items, among which were the binoculars and a set of underwear consisting of a T-shirt and shorts. The T-shirt and shorts are those on which appears the laundry mark which has been a matter of interest in this case.

A search of motel records in the Memphis area disclosed that an individual using the name ERIC S. GALT had spent the night of 4/3/68 at the Rebel Motel, Memphis, Tennessee, and was driving a 1966 white Mustang bearing Alabama License 1-38993. Investigation at Birmngham disclosed that this automobile had been purchased by ERIC S. GALT on August 30, 1968, from a private person in response to a newspaper ad. He paid a total of \$1995 cash. While in Birmingham he furnished the address of 2608 South Highland Avenue, Birmingham. This is also the address which appeared on a driver's license issued to him by the State of Alabama. The driver's license identifying data listed his birth date as his height as 5'll", his weight as 170 and his eyes blue and hair brown.

The automobile in question, the white Mustang bearing the Alabama tags mentioned above, was recovered in Atlanta on 4/11/68 and determined to have been abandoned there prior to 9 a.m. on 4/5/68.

In connection with the evidence submitted by Atlanta, Birmingham, and Memphis, identifiable latent prints were recovered. It was on the basis of these latents that identification was made of JAMES EARL RAY. In handling future leads, all offices should be particularly interested in securing an identifying number, military, police, or FBI, in connection with suspects so that the necessary check can be made through the Identification Division.

On 4/17/68, AUSA R. MACHY TAYLOR, Birmingham, authorized the filing of a complaint charging ERIC STARVO GALT with a conspiracy to violate Section 241, Title 18, U.S. Code, and







The Unanswered Questions

"HE CAN run, but he can't hide."

This quote, attributed to former heavyweight boxing champion Joe Louis, may very well apply to Eric Starvo Galt or James Earl Ray—the two are said to be identical—sought in connection with the murder of Dr. Martin Luther King.

Starting from the slimmest of facts, the Federal Bureau of Investigation has compiled an impressive dossier on King's alleged assassin. In addition to raising hopes that he will soon be

apprehended, this provides a dramatic demonstration of the effectiveness of law enforcement agencies and may have the effect of discouraging similar crimes of violence.

Galt, whose real name is said to be Ray, has been described as a high school dropout with a lengthy criminal record. He is a prison escapee who has used numerous aliases and has been in trouble with the law since early youth.

His capture is extremely important as a means of understanding the depth of the conspiracy which led to the murder of Dr. King and the wave of rioting which swept the country following his death.

WAS RAY a paid killer, or did he conspire, as the FBI puts it, with "an individual said to be his

brother," out of sheer prejudice to slay the civil rights leader?

that the murder was carefully planned. Ray had to know King's whereabouts, something of his schedule and the best means of establishing his ambush. In addition, all signs suggest that his escape was equally well planned, perhaps with the assistance of others. There is even speculation at the moment that Ray may no longer, be in the country.

Obviously, this was no spur of, the moment murder. It had been thought through completely and was executed with professional finesse. Ray did leave behind a highly visible trail. But this, too, could have been a decoy, pinning the guilt on one Eric Starvo Galt who, in fact, did not exist.

Ray was identified, according to the FBI, following a "systematic and exhaustive" search through its fingerprint files. And when Ray and Galt were determined to be one, certain of Galt's prior activities had to be rejected because Ray was in prison at the time they had been pinpointed.

The discrepancy was attributed, to "investigative error."

THERE IS a temptation to draw a parallel in the murder of TO Bl. Every Control of To Bl. To Br. King and the assassination of To Br. King and the assassination of To Bresident Kennedy. Both Lee Harvey Oswald and Ray were dropouts from society. Both had been failures in almost everything they had undertaken, except in the final and fanatic act of violence.

A dead Oswald leaves behind a mountain of unanswered questions. A live Ray may be able to shed some light on the killing of Dr. King, if Ray can be captured and persuaded to talk — and, of course, assuming his guilt.

We need to know more about the inner — and outer — compulsions which go into the composition of a killer. What were the compelling influences which caused Ray to make what on the surface appears to be a social protest against Dr. King's activities? Why, indeed, should a social outcast such as Ray even want to become involved in such a protest?

These are questions in search of an answer.




