

Mrs. WILLIATU stated that the O'CONNORS had lived at her trailer park for about two years prior to their leaving, and that she believed they had come there from Lakeland. He said that he was working for Wilmark when he was in Winter Haven, for a time, but left them because they wanted him to travel all over the country. 

A Federal warrant was issued April 17, 1968, at Birmingham, Alabama, charging Ray as Eric Starvo Galt with conspiracy to interfere with the Constitutional rights of a citizen. A Federal warrant was also issued July 20, 1967, at Jefferson City, Missouri, charging Ray with interstate flight to avoid confinement for the crime of robbery. Ray is described as follows:

Age - 40, born \_\_\_\_\_\_\_, 5'10" 163174 lbs., medium build, brown hair (possibly cut short)
blue eyes, medium complexion, nationality - American,
scars and marks - small scar on center of forehead
and small scar on palm of right hand. Miscellaneous noticeably protruding left ear, reportedly is a lone
wolf, allegedly attended dancing school, has reportedly
completed course in bartending.

Ray is sought in connection with a murder wherein the victim was shot and he should be considered armed and extremely dangerous.

We would appreciate any publicity you can give this matter and in so doing, request that anyone having any information concerning this person contact the nearest FBI office.
