THE ATTORNEY GENERAL HAS ORDERED A REVIEW OF THE FBI'S INVESTIGATION OF MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. ASSIGNED TO CONDUCT THIS REVIEW IS A TASK FORCE WORKING UNDER DIRECTION OF THE OFFICE OF PROFESSIONAL RESPONSIBILITY (OPR) OF THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE. THIS REVIEW IS A CONTINUATION OF A "PARTIAL REVIEW" RECENTLY CONDUCTED BY THE CIVIL RIGHTS DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT. THE REVIEW BEGAN IN MAY 1976, AND A LARGE NUMBER OF KING RELATED FILES HAVE BEEN REVIEWED AT FBIHQ AND IN SELECTED FIELD OFFICES.

THE TASK FORCE PLANS TO REVIEW SERIALS OF ALL KING RELATED FILES AT FBIHQ AND IN THE FIELD. FRED FOLSOM, TASK FORCE LEADER, HAS INQUIRED ABOUT POSSIBLE EXISTENCE OF KING FILES IN THE OFFICES OF FBI LEGAL ATTACHES.

ANY FILES ARE LOCATED YOU ARE TO FOLLOW YOUR TELETYPE WITH AN
AIRTEL ENCLOSING ONE XEROX COPY OF EACH SERIAL. IT WILL BE
NECESSARY ONLY TO XEROX THE FIRST PAGE OF ANY DOCUMENT IN YOUR
FILES IF A COPY OF THAT DOCUMENT HAS BEEN SUBMITTED TO FBIHQ.
