MELVILLE EUGENE GIBSON was interviewed at his residence, 314 Prado Norte. The interview was arranged by telephone, and both on the telephone and at the commencement of the interview he advised he was aware that the matter concerned a telephone call made from his home to the United States. However, he claimed he did not make this telephone call and did not know the content of the call. GIBSON advised that to the best of his knowledge the telephone call was made from his home by one of his drunken friends whom he refused to identify. He said he was not at home at the time. His children had informed him that the call was made during the course of the evening, but they were in bed and did not know who made the call or the nature of the call.

GIBSON said he knewabout the call because that morning some of his friends had teased him about it. These included the man who sells him lottery tickets and friends at the Focolare Restaurant. He did not know how they knew about the call. GIBSON stated he himself had been "plastered" for two days.

GIBSON advised he is very well connected in Mexico and knows some of the biggest crooks in Mexico. He produced a metallic credential #43-67 imprinted with his name and "Policia Internacional." It developed that this is a local detective type magazine, and he got the credential from the editor of the magazine, MANUEL VAZQUEZ, who is also supposedly a captain with the Secret Service.

GIBSON said he is well acquainted with Mr. LESLIE in Cincinnati. LESLIE comes to Mexico almost every year for a visit. GIBSON recently arranged reservations for LESLIE at the Motel Acapulco in Acapulco.

GIBSON eventually identified the friends who might have made the call as BOBBIE and EDUARDO. They are Mexican, but both speak perfect English. BOBBIE formerly lived in Culver City, California. Both BOBBIE and EDUARDO are also acquainted with LESLIE. BOBBIE lives with his wife, SUSAN, in a boarding house in Coyoacan, Mexico. GIBSON conjectured that either BOBBIE or EDUARDO had been going through his papers and found the letter from LESLIE and drunkenly decided to call him. However, GIBSON stubbornly refused to furnish the full identity of either of these individuals or where they could be located, claiming they were friends and he wanted to contact them and get their side of the story first.

GIBSON said that, regardless of who made the call, he was the source of the caller's information concerning MARTIN LUTHER KING's assassin being in Guatemala. He was certain that neither BOBBIE nor EDUARDO had any independent information concerning this. He had heard this information in Acapulco and could not specify the source of the information.

During the interview GIBSON made a long distance telephone call to a friend in Acapulco, RICARDO PARIA (phonetic), operator of La Gamba Restaurant on the beach. He discussed this report with the party in Acapulco and advised that the person there had also heard this report but had nothing further to substantiate it. GIBSON said that he and the person called were in agreement that "this was one less black ----" and that they did not know and did not care where the killer was.

GIBSON furnished names of MARIO SOTES and JORGE CAMP (phonetic, not further identified) as persons in Acapulco who would be knowledgeable of such matters.

In summary, the only information GIBSON has is that he had heard that the killer was close to Guatemala City and had gone to Guatemala with the intention of continuing on to Cuba. He had also heard that the killer was paid by Negroes.

It is noted that during a substantial part of the interview GIBSON claimed that the call was made by BOBBIE, whom he would not further identify, and then later indicated it might also have been BOBBIE's cousin, EDUARDO. He claimed

that he had not gotten home until after midnight and that all his friends were gone when he returned. He did not know if the call was made collect.

GIBSON was asked if he had ever referred to himself as Colonel JIM GIBSON. He stated that JIMMY has been his nickname since childhood and that the French made him an honorary Colonel when he was contract teaching cadets at Marana, Arizona.

The following description was obtained by observation and interview:

Following this interview GIBSON made a number of telephone calls to the interviewer, claiming progressively that he had been unable to locate BOBBIE and EDUARDO and that finally he had located them and they denied any responsibility for the call.

Finally, on the following day, April 30, 1968, GIBSON advised his children had finally told him that he had made the call. He said he was too drunk to recall it and was very sorry for having caused this difficulty. He indicated that his drinking had become a problem and he plans to see a doctor.

At 4:30 p.m., 5/5/68, SA JOHN PAGE telephonically furnished the following information from Campeche:

The State Judicial Police, the Campeche State Police, (Public Security and Traffic under General DE LA CRUZ), and the Campeche branch of the Federal Highway Police have all been furnished flyers and IO's which are being fanned out to their stations throughout the state of Campeche.

MEX-34 has left the city of Campeche to check outlying towns and on 5/6 will be going to Cd. Carmen for further checks. MEX-34 will be returning to Mexico City on 5/7 to handle delinquent paper work, replenish his funds, and then go to Cozumel and Isla Mujeres.

SA PAGE has established contact with the six Americans who have resided in Campeche for an extended period of time and none of them know of RAY's past or present presence in Campeche. Through the American clergymen in Campeche arrangements have been made to contact all 53 religious congregations in that state to be alert for the arrival of any new American. Inasmuch as all these congregations are made up of Indians, they would be able to spot an American very readily.

The police agencies in Campeche anticipate being able to give PAGE the results of their check throughout the state of Campeche by 5/6/68. Police fingerprint files in Campeche go back to 1955 relating to foreigners who at any time got into trouble or were fingerprinted because of lack of proper identification papers. RAY's fingerprints have been searched against those files with no record having been found.

PAGE also advised that absolutely no records have been found of MATEO LOPEZ GARCIA or MATEO GARCIA LOPEZ and




NEGATIVE EFFORTS TO CONFIRM DEPARTURE OF SUBJECT AS GALT FROM MEXICO IN NOVEMBER 1967.

On 5/2/68 Attorney JORGE VAZQUEZ ROBLES, Chief of the Inspection Service of Mexican Immigration advised that they had caused all records along the U.S.-Mexico border to be searched for all the month of November, 1967, and no record could be located cafirming the departure of subject. This search was made under his true names and aliases and particularly in the name GALT, since this was the name used on his entry document which should have been surrendered upon his departure. They checked every port of entry from thexaxixxxx Gulf of Mexico to the Pacific. Inasmuch as subject as GALT entered with Mexico with an automobile, he could only legally depart by automobile and with the automobile.

On 5/6/68 SERGIO GOYZUETA of the Mexican Federal Automobile Registration Bureau (MFARB) advised that they had been unable to locate any record of the departure from Mexico of the automobile entered under permit #294486 10/7/67, at Laredo. He noted that legally this car r shuld have left Mexico within six months and if the departure recorded both at the point of entry, in this case laredo, and at his office. In this case it had not been so recorded. However he noted that is is not unusual for such cars to depart without surrendering the permit.

Mrs. HELEN PAGE furnished the following information on April 20, 1968:

Mrs. PAGE resides permanently at the Maria Cristina Hotel, Rio Lerma 31, Mexico City, although she has a New York City address of 425 West 57th Street.

Mrs. PAGE advised that the subject claims to be a Frenchman, age 26 (she says he looks more like 32 to 35), has an immigration working permit for the Dallas, Texas, area and plans to open a restaurant in Dallas. He claimed to have entered Mexico through Laredo where he had a camera stolen. He was driving a red sports car, make not known, is "light on his feet," and PAGE feels he may be a dancer. Subject asked PAGE if there are any Negroes in Mexico.

PAGE stated she met the subject when she saw him sitting at the table in the garden which she usually occupies. She walked over to this table and sat down, feeling that she has some rights in view of her permanent residence at the Maria Cristina Hotel. She said the subject introduced himself as BERNARD MALFATSANT, which PAGE advised means evildoer in French, which she yelt was somewhat suspicious.

When subject arrived at the Maria Cristina Hotel on April 16, 1968, he had almost a third degree burn on his left arm

from hanging it out the window of his car while driving. Subject told PAGE the car he was driving had been rented in the United States and told her now that he was in Mexico he was going to buy insurance for the car. On April 18 subject came into the hotel highly excited andwas very rude and abrupt. He asked PAGE to ask the room clerk if anyone had come to visit him, since he speaks no Spanish. PAGE did this, and the room clerk pointed to a person sitting in the lobby who said he had been waiting for the subject. Subject speaks fluent French, according to PAGE who is of French and Russian background and speaks six languages. On April 20 subject told PAGE that he had spent the rest of the afternoon, evening and late into the next morning of the 20th with the so-called insurance man at restaurants and various bars.

PAGE, who observed photographs of JAMES EARL RAY taken in 1960 and 1968 which appear on the IO for RAY, said the subject does not in any way resemble JAMES EARL RAY. However, since she had heard that RAY had an accomplice, she felt that subject may be the accomplice. She stated that at least there was something unusual about the subject inasmuch as he drove a great period of time in order to get a nearly third degree sunburn, he said he wanted to buy insurance on the rented car after he got to Mexico which should have had insurance on it before he left the United States through the car rental agency, and since he was able to spend so much time with an insurance man who should not have had this much free time if he were attending to his job. PAGE said the subject checked out of the hotel on Saturday morning, April 20, 1968, and told her he was returning to Dallas.

PAGE later called and said that the subject had attempted to date one of the female employees in the hotel. On Saturday morning, April 20, 1968, he told this girl that he was going to Guatemala and that the automobile was in reality owned by him.

On April 26, 1968, PAGE again contacted the Mexico City Office and advised that the photograph of JAMES EARL RAY taken in 1952 appearing in TIME magazine for April 26, 1968, and the photographs of RAY taken in 1952 which appear at the bottom of page 21 in NEWSWEEK magazine for April 29, 1968, were, she felt, identical with the subject. It is noted that these photographs are not available to the Mexico City Office.

On April 29, 1968, MEX 21, who has furnished reliable information in the past, advised he had checked the records of the Hotel Maria Cristina on April 24 and 25, 1968, and had displayed the 1952 magazine photographs of JAMES EARL RAY to personnel in the hotel without being able to effect an identification that BERNARD MALFAISANT had been a guest at the Maria Cristina.

On April 30, 1968, MEX 21 again caused a check to be made at the Maria Cristina. He talked with the room clerk, Mr. FERNANDO, who had recalled the incident wherein the subject had asked for the "insurance man." It was then determined that this individual, who spoke French and some English and had burned his left arm while driving his automobile, was in reality BERNARD HALFANT. The hotel registration card disclosed the following information concerning BERNARD HALFANT:

He had stayed at the Maria Cristina Hotel from April 16 to April 20, 1968, and paid 75 pesos (\$6 U.S.) a day. He was driving an automobile (make and model not known) bearing license KRY 49 (state not shown but probably Texas). His residence address was shown as 1516 North Peach Street, Dallas, Texas, and his profession was listed as chef.

According to the room clerk, the subject had been recommended to the Maria Cristina Hotel by STANISTAR FLAWIK of 10112 Inwood Road, Dallas, Texas, a long-time customer of the Maria Cristina Hotel.

It is not considered likely that the subject is identical with JAMES EARL RAY inasmuch as PAGE had said the subject did not in any way resemble RAY when viewing the 1960 and 1968 pictures of RAY and because of his age; also, her last identification of the subject as RAY was taken from 1952 magazine photographs of RAY. However, it is felt that the subject should be thoroughly identified for possible future information and use in the MURKIN case.

Bureau was requested by cable, 5/3/68, to have Dallas Office check subject out.

At 5:50 PM, 5/7/68, SA KAISER telephonically furnished the following information from Hermosillo:

MEX-59 has shaken down the entire Guaymas area for Subject RAY. All police and extensively established contacts of MEX-59 have been alerted and furnished flyers and I.O.s. MEX-59 reported that Subject RAY's photograph was readily recognized by all of his contacts and sources from previous extensive newspaper publicity. MEX-59 has made arrangements to be immediately notified if anyone resembling RAY shows up in the Guaymas area.

With regard to the lead in Bucab 5/6/68 relative to the area south of Caborca, SA KAISER is personally acquainted with that area. The road which runs south to Caborca and then turns west to Puerto Libertad is a "truck road" which is very difficult for regular travel. It runs through arroyes and there are isolated ranches scattered throughout the area which is largely desert.

KAISER will arrange for informants, probably MEX-59 and MEX-272, to check into the area 50 miles south of Caborca in an effort to ascertain if any Americans have recently been seen in that area and if possible, spot any fresh graves.

MEX-156 is being sent tomorrow to San Luis to check with the bus station in order to ascertain the date the west coast suspect purchased a ticket on the Tres Estrellas de Oro Bus Line for Guadalajara.

At 5:50 P.M., 5/7/68, SA JOHN PAGE telephonically furnished the following information from Merida, Yucatan, since the telephone lines from Campeche are out and it was necessary for him to go to Merida to contact headquarters.

Investigation has been completed throughout the State of Campeche by the State Police, the Judicial Police, and Highway Police. All three agencies have checked all of the communities throughout their local villages without developing any indication that Subject RAY was previously in Campeche or is there now. As an example of the extent to which this coverage has been established, SA PAGE cited the fact that Chief of the State Police DE LA CRUZ personally checked out information from his force that an American was residing in Escarcega, a small isolated village in the center of the state. DE LA CRUZ, however, by interview ascertained that the American is a Negro and not identical with Subject RAY.

PAGE has made arrangements for the three police agencies effective throughout the State of Campeche to be notified immediately in case any new Americans show up in the state and have immediate checks to be made that such an individual is Subject RAY. In the event RAY comes to Campeche, those authorities will immediately notify this office.

Inasmuch as the check has been made as completely as possible in Campeche, there appears to be no other work for PAGE to do. He desires to return to Mexico City sincechisa assignment is now completed. He was told that the Bureau would be advised tonight, UACB, that he would be returning to Mexico City in order to handle further leads.

Tonight SA PAGE is at the Hotel Colon, Merida, probably Room No. 8.
