





III-119 Eric Galt enrolled as dancing student first week of Dec. 1967; quit abruptly Feb. 12, 1967. Arvidson talked with Galt on several occasions; once interviewed him for about two hours in attempt to benefit Galt socially through the dance lessons.

Galt said had been in Mexico, believed to be in early 1967. Arvidson thinks Galt said he had restaurant in Mexico. Galt always wore shirt and tie, often wore expensive alligator shoes, believed to be loafer style. Galt said he was Merchant Marine. When he quit, Galt said he wanted to attend bartender school so he could open a restaurant.

Galt backward socially, ill at ease, did not relax in mixed group. Galt drove white car. Galt did not smile readily, but had "crooked" smile, would not look you in eye. Never had associates. Galt always paid cash from roll of bills in trouser pocket.
