





XVII- 15

Was in MSP from 4/60-6/65. First met Ray in 1963.

Heard Ray curse King after JFK shot. Said JFK was nigger loving SOB.

In Fall of 1963, heard Ray say he was going to get King when he got out. A cooley organization would pay \$10,000.

Ray had sufficient money; gambled in yard with cigarettes or bottle tops. Said got money regularly from outside. Drank whiskey made in MSP. No knowledge of Ray or specific guards in drug traffic. Talked of going to Liberia where brother-in-law worked. Said Ray had caste of guns outside. Ray said B'ham was good town to steal in.

Brown said Ray's friends were Johnny Valenti, "Tick" Wilson, Johnny Johnson and others.

In MSP from 3/60 to 2/64. Met Ray through Valenti, who was in an robbery. Valenti said to have robbed Oil Company, with Ray in Atlanta. Ray and Valenti good friends. Ray made killing long comment to Valenti, talk of JFK. bounty.

- (1) On 10/3:67, received order from Galt at at B'ham address for one Kodak Dual Projector M952, one Kodak super 8 camera model 8, one HPI combination splicer and 20 feet remote control cable for \$337.24 on money order.
- (2) Above equipment sent out 10/3/67 under invoice #179530. Substitution of a Crestline Super 8 camera for Kodak model M8 made on loan as latter not in stock.
- (3) On 10/12/67, Crestline camera returned. Accompany, equipment was letter from Galt dated 10/5/67 acknowledging equipment its return. He also said he was going to Mexico 10/7/67 and would send his address.
- (4) On 10/18/67, the Kodak Super 8, under

invoice \$179530 sent to Galt in B'ham. By a typed letter signed Galt, the company was advised Galt returned the Crestline saying he could not wait for Kodak. He requested refund be sent to him to Puerto Vallarta, Jalisco, Maxi Mexico, Apartado Postal \$23. The Kodak camera was received by company 11/2/67.
