light brown hair, light blue eyes, light complexion as if never in sun, looked directly into Manasco's eyes, high-pitched voice, no southern accent, physically weak, manicured nails.

residence. Did not see him again for 2 or 3 weeks but not sure of dates.

In Jan. 1968, he moved to St. Francis Hotel, where she also lived. He once asked her whether she needed money, and gave her a \$20 bill.

About Valentine's Day he said he wanted to trade his console TV because he was going to travel and wanted to carry a TV with him. She traded her TV for his. Description of her TV: small, white portable, possibly G.E.

In Jan. or Feb. 1968, Galt said he was attending bartending school; she gave him a book on how to mix drinks.

Reinterviewed. Met in bar. Galt either took her to Rita's residence to meet Rita, or Rita was in bar and he took them both to Rita's residence to meet Charles Stein. Galt said, concerning the planned trip, "if its a set up, I'll kill him. I have a gun." Marie assured that it wasn't a set-up.

Once Galt said he had trouble driving through a Negro community because of Alabama license and that tomatoes had been thrown at car.

Galt usually drank straight Vodka or an occasional beer. She once played pool with him. Last seen when TV's were traded; Galt gave Marie \$20 as well as his TV.

Her TV was 21", G.E., built in rabbit ears, push-pull on-off button.

Recalls that Galt used Spanish phrases. Recalls seeing Galt after return from New Orleans and that he mentioned friends who lived in Industrial Canal area or in Chef Menteur Highway, New Orleans. Recalls seeing girlie magazine in his room when they exchanged TV sets. Recalls that Galt, in response to a question, said he did not have polaroid camera. At that time, ~~Galt~~ Galt said he was going to travel through

the South, and agreed to take a package of clothing to Martin's mother in New Orleans.

About 2 weeks later Galt left some barbells at her apt. He said he was broke and expecting money from his brother.

Recalls that Galt once mentioned smoking marijuana but said it did nothing for him. Recalls showing Galt an ad in LA Free Press for "hot tempered man." Answered questions about Charles and Rita Stein. Said one was not romantically involved with Galt.

Galt took out new poloroid from ice chest in  
back of car. Took photo of her-was bad-he  
destroyed it. Stopped again-took another  
photo-also bad and destroyed. Galt said it  
was one of the first rolls of film in camera,

and had 2 pictures left. Returned home about 5 pm.-did not stay at Casa Susana.

Returned next day at 9 pm-between believe it to be 10/29. Galt got into argument with Negroes there. Went to car and brought back what she believed a gun. Galt said he hated Negroes and was going to kill them. Negroes left. Galt said he was going after them, but she said cops were due to visit house any minute. Galt left. Galt came back next day; Said he was going to sleep and eat only for next few days. Returned she thinks next Thursday, saying he was going to move to Hotel Tropicana. He spent ~~about~~ 200 pesos (\$16) and left.

Returned next evening between 8-9 p.m.. Manvela was drunk. Galt got mad- Photographer took photo of him. Galt said he was going

to Yelapa Sat and Sunday. Left.  
Returned next Monday between 8-9 p.m. Galt  
still mangry with her re photo and drunk.  
Galt asked her to marry him again. She  
refused. Galt spent evening with Arcella  
(Elisa). Saw Galt following 3 days  
but did not talk.

Said he only smoked marijuana, drank gin.  
Could not dance. Spoke no Spanish. Had an  
old pair of sandals.
