During 1964 Eric Galt took 5 private dance lessons and about 3 months group lessons at Continental Dance Studios in New Orleans. Paid cash. Galt didn't have much money and had to budget lessons to 5 hrs/week. Galt left owing some money. Galt had years club membership at Continental. Louella Lutz in Calif. may have Continental records. Continental went out of business Oct. 1965.

Sept. 1968, Myers advertised dance lessons in Birmingham. Galt signed

contract Sept. 2, 1967, gave address 2608 Highland Ave. Galt took group lessons Sept. 12 to Oct 3. on Tuesdays 7:30 to 8:30 p.m. Galt attended four, did not attend 5th lesson. Rec'd letter from Galt saying he was leaving town. Lessons cost Galt \$10.

Galt always alone. Myers thought rode bus, thought Galt might be construction worker, Galt never mentioned New Orleans lessons. Galt very interested but poor dancer. Myers thinks Galt would take lessons wherever he went. Galt quiet, weak handshake, wouldn't look you in eye. Galt may have spoken with Doris Ledner.

Dated Vince and Red whom she met at Vegas Club.

Worked as prostitute out of Flikeid's Apt.

Gave sample of handwriting 4/13/68 to SA Stilling. Thinks "Oklahombe" is nickname for Negro guitarist at Vegas Club.

Said Katzwinkel dated a man similar to description of Galt; liked camping; drove VW; mentioned a trip to Mexico; saw him several times at St. Francis Hotel.
