




outside car. Does not recall seeing Patrolman Dollahite or other officers near US Fixtures or Canipe Amusement.

Has received 2 shipments of 7 x 35 Banner binoculars since 10/67, one on 1/68, another 4/68. These were wide angle binoculars and more expensive. No serial numbers of binoculars kept. No invoice to reflect snap type case 7 x 35 Banner binoculars shipment since 10/67. A review of stock showed one pair 7 x 35 for \$39.95, which were like those sold by Carpenter to Ray even though they were in zipper case. York stated he often exchanges cases for snap type as customers prefer them.

Lorraine Motel YOUNG, Andrew Drove in car of Jones to hospital T-54 after ambulance.

YOUNG, Andrew Lorraine Motel Seen running upstairs to balcony I-56 after King shot - by Rev. Lee.

I-58

Was in courtyard and saw King on balcony. King spoke to Jones. Heard sound like firecracker, looked up, and saw King lying on back on balcony. Ran to King. Looked across street but saw only police. Checked pulse, which was strong, but King was losing blood rapidly. Thought shot came from bushes on west side of Mulberry.
