Invoice revealed that there was such a sale made out to cash, but Wood recalled that purchaser was a regular customer named John, a white male, about 25 years, 5'10", 170 lbs., long black hair. Wood recalled selling to this man a Browning pistol about 2 1/2 years ago. Wood's records revealed this man is John Webster DeShazo, 17 Montevallo Lane, Mt. Brook, Ala.

Wood made available 3 weapons identified by DeShazo as having been handled by man who purchased a rifle and scope on 3/29/68.

A review of stock showed one pair 7 x 35 for \$39.95, which were like those sold by Carpenter to Ray even though they were in zipper case. York stated he often exchanges cases for snap type as customers prefer them.
