Mark 20R 3 on yellow tape issued in week ending July 21, 1968, but ticket No. 658, lot #3, issued to a customer whose name looks like "Brun." Price indicates possibly shirts. This laundry done for Palos Verdes Cleaners. Modernway has not used 20R 3 with gold tape in over a year.

III-27 Laundry uses Thermo-Seal marking machine, manufactured by Textile Marking Machine Co., Syracuse, N.Y., Serial No. 31454, Model No. RH-5k 1. Machine purchased second-hand in Feb. 1968. Names given of persons involved in sale. Mrs. Pinela took over management from bankrupt, Jerome W. Vernon, who has disappeared.

She could not locate record of Code O2B-6. She furnished samples of the code printed on red tape by her machine. She noted machine was defective, and parts of letter "O" were cut off.

Always came in on Saturday afternoon with underwear, T-shirts, and dress shirts. Vernon thinks he would leave a bundle and pick up a bundle. Vernon identified laundry mark as similar to laundry's; photos of underwear could be Galt's.

Entries in laundry book show Galt's first name as Eric.

Galt usually wore Bermuda shorts.

Description: White male, 40-45 yrs., 5'9",
