DECISION IS LARGELY BECAUSE TOP OFFICIALS OF THAT AGENCY AND OTHER HIGH GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS ARE INCENSED ABOUT RECENTLY PUBLICIZED CASE WHICH OCCURRED IN BORDER AREA ALLEGEDLY INVOLVING IMPROPER ACTIVITY ON MEXICAN SIDE BY AGENTS OF U. S. MARCOTICS AND CUSTOMS BUREAUS. BRIEFLY, ONE ALFREDO REYES PRUNEDA, A MEXICAN, WAS SENTENCED TO SIX EERO YEARS BY FEDERAL COURT AT LAREDO, TEXAS ON OCTOBER ONE RIGHT LAST, ON NARCOTIC CHARGES. MEXICAN PRESS NEXT DAY HIGHLIGHTED CHARGES BY REYES AND ATTORNEYS THAT HE WAS DRUGGED AND KIDNAPED AND BROUGHT ACROSS BORDER TO U. S. CUSTODY. HIS RELATIVES AND LAWYER HAVE REPORTEDLY PROTESTED TO GOBERNACION AND TO PRESIDENT OF MEXICO. YOU SHOULD DIPLOMATICALLY ADVISE MR. CANALE THAT IN VIEW OF THE ABOVE, ARRANGEMENTS CANNOT BE MADE BY THIS BUREAU TO HAVE WITNESSES INTERVIEWED PURSUANT TO THEIR REQUEST. MR. CANALE SHOULD BE FURTHER ADVISED THAT IN THE EVENT HE DESIRES TO PURSUE THIS MATTER FURTHER THAT ARRANGEMENTS SHOULD BE MADE BY MR. CANALE THROUGH THE STATE DEPARTMENT AS OUTLINED ABOVE.

NOTE: This is the case involving the murder of Martin Luther King, Jr.

Mr. Phil M. Canale, Jr., State Attorney General, Shelby County, Memphis, Tennessee, desires that his representatives proceed to Mexico and interview witnesses in this case. He requested Bureau assistance in this matter. We directed a cablegram to our legal attache in Mexico City listing witnesses desired to be interviewed by Mr. Canale and requested our legal attache to advise if arrangements can be made for these interviews.

Our legal attache has advised that efforts were made to make arrangements for representatives of Mr. Canale to interview witnesses in this case on an informal basis with Mexican Government officials without success. Our legal attache advises that due to a recent incident involving a case of U. S. Narcotics and Customs Bureaus with the Mexican Government, the reaction is very high with Mexican officials concerning all U.S. investigative agencies. Legat advises that interviewing of these witnesses may be affected through State Department.

SAC, Memphis being instructed to advise Mr. Canale that request to interview witnesses in Mexico with Bureau assistance cannot be completed at this time, and if Mr. Canale desires to pursue this matter further, he should handle through the State Department. This matter coordinated with foreign liaison and they feel that if Memphis authorities pursue this matter of interviewing witnesses through the Bureau, this could very possibly jeopardize the Bureau's operations in Mexico in the future. Ferris stated he will contact the appropriate authorities on Monday and submit the results by cable.

Moss Innes, Legat, Ontario, telephonically advised SA Kish at 6:30 p.m., 10-19-68, that the three representatives of the Tennessee State Attorney General's Office, namely Robert Dwyer, James Beasley and John Carlisle will depart Montreal, Canada, at 6:50 p.m. (Canada Time), 10-19-68, on Air Canada Flight Number 549, and will arrive London, England, at 7:30 a.m., 10-20-68 (London Time).

SA Richard Long advised of above at 6:45 p.m., 10-19-68.

Extra-Duty Supervisor Leon Smith, Domestic Intelligence Division, at 7:10 p.m., 10-19-68, advised SA Kish that John Minnich, Legat, London, will meet the three representatives from the State Attorney General's Office when they arrive in London.

Mr. Dwyer further asked that General Canale call Mr. Dwyer's "friend" and tell the friend that he is well and that they still plan to return Thursday, 10-24-68.

Concerning Items 1 and 2 above, Legat Minnich asked that he be called at the Embassy about 8:30 p.m., London Time (3:30 a.m., Washington Time).

SAC, Memphis advised that he was unable to get in touch with the State Attorney General; however, to the best of his knowledge, there has been no change in the situation with respect to either Items 1 or 2.

At approximately 5:00 a.m., 10/20/68, John Minnich, Legal Attache, London, called. Call was taken by Extra Duty Supervisor William Neumann. Minnich requested following be relayed to Division 6, which is handling the Murkin case:

- (5) Attorney General Canale is to be requested to call "Mr. Dwyer's friend" to inform the friend that he (Dwyer) is well and that they plan to return on Thursday, 10/24/68.

Legal Attache Minnich requested he be called at the Embassy at about 8:30 a.m. London time. (This will require call being placed from Washington at 3:30 a.m., Monday, 10/21/68)

At 3:20 p.m. 10/20/68 Supervisor Henry Schutz, Division 6, telephonically advised Extra Duty Supervisor A. H. Solomon that the following information is to be relayed to London in response to Minnich's request:

SAC Jensen in Memphis has been unable to contact State Attorney General Canale and as far as Jensen is aware, there have been no developments bearing on questions (1) and (2) above.

Supervisor Schutz also requested that Minnich be asked to diplomatically inform Mr. Dwyer, Beasley and Carlisle that in matters such as those under (3) and (4) above better results might be obtained by direct contact with Memphis on the part of the men now in London.



The earliest that would be available for travel to Mexico would be approximately October 28, 1968, due to the representatives presently traveling in Toronto, Montreal, and Lisbon interviewing witnesses. Mr. Canale is particularly interested in developing information which disclosed that Ray had on one occasion while in Mexico showed strong anti-Negro sentiments. Mr. Canale has listed witnesses in Mexico that he desires to be interviewed and Legat Mexico City is being requested to immediately advise if arrangements can be made to have these witnesses interviewed through Mexican authorities. After response by Legat Mexico, Mr. Canale will be advised accordingly.
