On checking with Supervisor Long, SA Cole was advised they should proceed with their attempts to locate Moore in Memphis and resolve the allegation. He advised a confirmatory teletype will be sent to Memphis and Bureau re this matter.

Telegram received from an individual who identifies himself as Cedric Moore, Assistant non violent education Southern Christian Leadership Conference. Moore states that he is informing us that a serious threat is being made on Reverend James Bevel's life concerning his defense of James Earl Ray. It is noted that in a television interview in Philadelphia on 1-19-69, Bevel made the statement that he communicated with James Earl Ray in Memphis, Tennessee, and has offered to defend Ray at no expense.

We are instructing our Philadelphia Office to interview Moore to determine basis for comment and also determine whether there is a violation of the Extortion Statute.

THE FOLLOWING WAS RECEIVED FROM LEGAT MEXICO IN RESPONSE TO INQUIRY CONCERNING POSSIBLE ARRANGEMENTS FOR REPRESENTATIVES OF MR. PHIL M. CANALE TO VISIT MEXICO FOR PURPOSE OF INTERVIEWING WITNESSES:

AMERICAN CITIZENS TRAVELING IN MEXICO AS TOURISTS MAY NOT LEGALLY ENGAGE IN BUSINESS OR INVESTIGATIVE ACTIVITIES. THROUGH LIAISON WITH MEXICAN MINISTRY OF GOVERNMENT, (GOBERNACION), EFFORTS HAVE BEEN MADE TO OBTAIN INFORMAL WAIVER OF ABOVE FOR SHELBY COUNTY OFFICIALS OR, IN ALTERNATIVE, ARRANGE FOR SOME TYPE OF SPECIAL TRAVEL DOCUMENTATION PERMITTING THEM TO ENTER MEXICO FOR PURPOSES OUTLINED IN RECAB. HIGH LEVEL CONTACTS IN GOBERNACION, WHO HAD PREDICTED SUCCESS FOR THESE EFFORTS, ADVISED ON OCTOBER TWO TWO INSTANT NO WAIVER OR SPECIAL DOCUMENTATION COULD BE OBTAINED INFORMALLY AT THIS TIME.

DECISION IS LARGELY BECAUSE TOP OFFICIALS OF THAT AGENCY AND OTHER HIGH GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS ARE INCENSED ABOUT RECENTLY PUBLICIZED CASE WHICH OCCURRED IN BORDER AREA ALLEGEDLY INVOLVING IMPROPER ACTIVITY ON MEXICAN SIDE BY AGENTS OF U. S. NARCOTICS AND CUSTOMS BUREAUS. BRIEFLY, ONE ALFREDO REYES PRUNEDA, A MEXICAN, WAS SENTENCED TO SIX ZERO YEARS BY FEDERAL COURT AT LAREDO, TEXAS ON OCTOBER ONE EIGHT LAST, ON NARCOTIC CHARGES. MEXICAN PRESS NEXT DAY HIGHLIGHTED CHARGES BY REYES AND ATTORNEYS THAT HE WAS DRUGGED AND KIDNAPED AND BROUGHT ACROSS BORDER TO U. S. CUSTODY. HIS RELATIVES AND LAWYER HAVE REPORTEDLY PROTESTED TO GOVERNACION AND TO PRESIDENT OF MEXICO. GOVERNACION CONTACTS UNDERSTAND PERFECTLY THAT BUREAU WAS NOT INVOLVED IN THIS REPORTED INCIDENT BUT REACTION IS STRONG ENOUGH AND BROAD ENOUGH AMONG MEXICAN OFFICIALDOM TO ENCOMPASS ALL U. S. INVESTIGATIVE AGENCIES, AS IN PAST CASES WHERE MEXICAN SOVEREIGNTY ALLEGEDLY VIOLATED.

AS SECOND CHANNEL, TENNESSEE AUTHORITIES COULD SUBMIT INTERROGATORY TYPE DOCUMENTS TO DEPARTMENT OF STATE WITH REQUEST THAT PROSPECTIVE WITNESSES NAMED IN RECAP BE LOCATED AND QUESTIONED BY VICE - CONSUL OF U. S. CONSULATE AT GUADALAJARA, JALISCO, WHO SPEAKS SPANISH AND IS ACCREDITED TO MEXICAN GOVERNMENT.

THIRDLY, STATE DEPARTMENT COULD BE APPROACHED BY STATE OF TENNESSEE WITH FORMAL REQUEST THAT SPECIAL PERMISSION BE REQUESTED FROM MEXICAN GOVERNMENT FOR VISIT OF PROSECUTOR'S REPRESENTATIVES TO CONDUCT INTERVIEWS.

YOU SHOULD DIPLOMATICALLY ADVISE MR. CANALE THAT IN VIEW OF THE ABOVE, ARRANGEMENTS CANNOT BE MADE BY THIS BUREAU TO HAVE WITNESSES INTERVIEWED PURSUANT TO THEIR REQUEST. MR. CANALE SHOULD BE FURTHER ADVISED THAT IN THE EVENT HE DESIRES TO PURSUE THIS MATTER FURTHER THAT ARRANGEMENTS SHOULD BE MADE BY MR. CANALE THROUGH THE STATE DEPARTMENT AS OUTLINED ABOVE.

NOTE: This is the case involving the murder of Martin Luther King, Jr.

Mr. Phil M. Canale, Jr., State Attorney General, Shelby County, Memphis, Tennessee, desires that his representatives proceed to Mexico and interview witnesses in this case. He requested Bureau assistance in this matter. We directed a cablegram to our legal attache in Mexico City listing witnesses desired to be interviewed by Mr. Canale and requested our legal attache to advise if arrangements can be made for these interviews.

Our legal attache has advised that efforts were made to make arrangements for representatives of Mr. Canale to interview witnesses in this case on an informal basis with Mexican Government officials without success. Our legal attache advises that due to a recent incident involving a case of U. S. Narcotics and Customs Bureaus with the Mexican Government, the reaction is very high with Mexican officials concerning all U.S. investigative agencies. Legat advises that interviewing of these witnesses may be affected through State Department.

SAC, Memphis being instructed to advise Mr. Canale that request to interview witnesses in Mexico with Bureau assistance cannot be completed at this time, and if Mr. Canale desires to pursue this matter further, he should handle through the State Department. This matter coordinated with foreign liaison and they feel that if Memphis authorities pursue this matter of interviewing witnesses through the Bureau, this could very possibly jeopardize the Bureau's operations in Mexico in the future. At 3:20 p.m. 10/20/68 Supervisor Henry Schutz, Division 6, telephonically advised Extra Duty Supervisor A. H. Solomon that the following information is to be relayed to London in response to Minnich's request:

SAC Jensen in Memphis has been unable to contact State Attorney General Canale and as far as Jensen is aware, there have been no developments bearing on questions (1) and (2) above.

Supervisor Schutz also requested that Minnich be asked to diplomatically inform Mr. Dwyer, Beasley and Carlisle that in matters such as those under (3) and (4) above better results might be obtained by direct contact with Memphis on the part of the men now in London.
