Executive Assistant Attorney General ROBERT DWYER (NA) advised that the jury chosen to sit in the JAMES EARL RAY case will be selected from this list of names. He requested that if possible the Bureau search its files to ascertain whether or not there is any information concerning any of these people which would aggravate their use as jurors. Executive Assistant Attorney General DWYER indicated that he was very much interested in any affiliations that might be indicated showing Klan type association or other hategroup affiliations.

Mr. DWYER was informed that his request would be forwarded to the Bureau for an answer.
