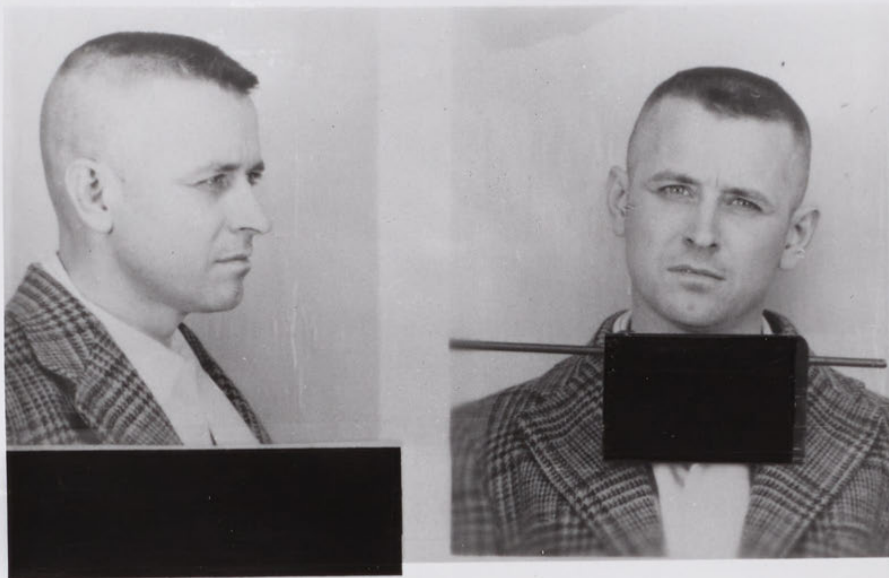

At 12:30 a.m. today, I was telephonically advised by ASAC THEODORE GUNDERSON, New Haven office, that a telephone call had been received from ASAC CLIFF HALTER, Memphis office, requesting that the rifle used in the assassination of the captioned subject be traced through the Remington Company. GUNDERSON advised that leads should be handled telephonically.

GUNDERSON stated that information developed by New Haven revealed that the gun described by ASAC HALTER as a Remington Gamemaster, model 760 rifle, serial number 461476, firing a 30.06 cartridge, was manufactured at Remington's plant at Ilion, New York, and that it would be necessary to check at that plant in order to determine to whom the gun was consigned.

Immediately thereafter I instructed SRA LEW KELLY to make the necessary contact to determine whether records could be checked immediately, and he informed me shortly thereafter that this could be done after 8:00 a.m. same date. I thereupon telephonically informed ASAC CLIFF HALTER at Memphis of the developments in regard to the gun and the fact that the records would be checked at 8:00 a.m. today.

At 8:55 a.m., SRA KELLY advised that he had been telephonically informed by GEORGE ROCKWELL, Manager, National Accounts, Bridgeport, Conn., that the above described rifle had been shipped on Remington invoice from Ilion, New York, dated 3/30/66 to the Wimberly Hardware Company, Birmingham, Alabama, exact address unknown. KELLY also advised that ROCKWELL had informed him there was a remote chance that although the gun was shipped to the Wimberly Hardware Company it might have been dropped off to an individual customer. In order to close the door on this remote chance, the Remington Company was making an additional check.

I immediately telephonically advised SAC JOSEPH GAMBLE of the Birmingham office concerning the foregoing facts and he advised that he would cause the necessary checks to be made immediately to determine whether the gun was received by the Wimberly Hardware Company and to whom the gun was sold and that Memphis would be telephonically advised.

SRA KELLY was instructed to advise the Bureau, Birmingham and Memphis by teletype of the information he had developed.

Immediately subsequent to the above, SRA KELLY telephonically advised that the invoice in regard to the shipment of the gun located by the company revealed that the consignee was correctly named the Wimberly Thomas Hardware Company, 1809 First Avenue South, Birmingham, Alabama. It also revealed that this gun was part of a large shipment consisting of 71 boxes of firearms and the above-mentioned rifle was in a carton containing three guns in all. I furnished the foregoing information to SAC GAMBLE, Birmingham, immediately upon receipt, and he advised that an agent had already been assigned to this case and the Wimberly Company was being contacted.

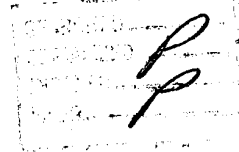

On 4/5/68 DAVID DALY of the Birmingham Office
called and advised the writer that a laundry mark had been
found on a T-shirt and a pair of shorts in the hotel room
from which it is believed Doctor MARTIN LUTHER KING was
assassinated on 4/4/68. He stated this laundry mark is
either "2B-6 or 02B-6" on red tape which is either stick-on
or iron down type and the measurements shown are 1/4 inch
wide by 1 1/16 long. He stated that investigation by
Birmingham had disclosed that much of the material found in
the room was traceable to Birmingham, therefore, they desired
to check on the laundry mark and had determined that this type
of laundry marking was made by Textile Marking Machine Company,
Syracuse, New York.

Mr. DON BROUGHTON, Textile Marking Machine Company,
2204 Erie Blvd., East, Syracuse, New York, advised the writer
that the only company in Birmingham, Alabama using tape which
was 1/4 inch wide and 1 5/16 long was Aladdin Cleaners,
112 55th Place, North Birmingham, and that this same size
was also used by Northington's Laundry, Incorporated,
Tuscaloosa, Alabama. He stated there was no such tape as
1/4 inch wide and 1 1/16 long.

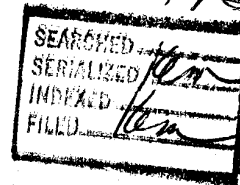

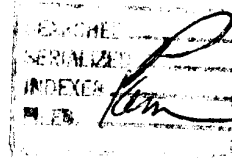
